Joining us in our senior year, Miss Doris Gavron also gave her time and energy to see us through our remaining year.

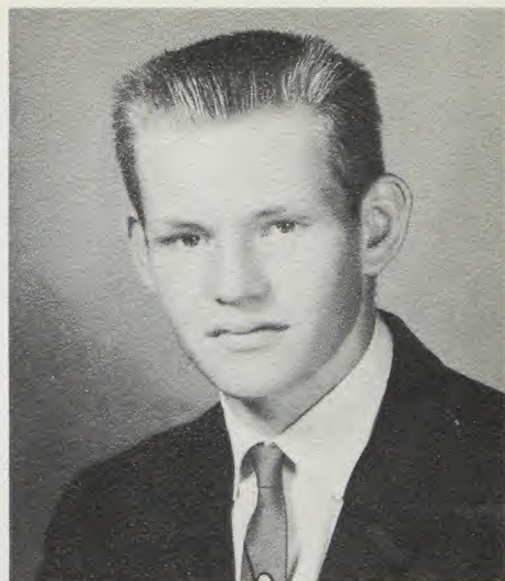
You have worked hard with us; we know the job was not an easy one. Without your steady, patient guidance the many projects undertaken by our Class of '60 would have never been realities.

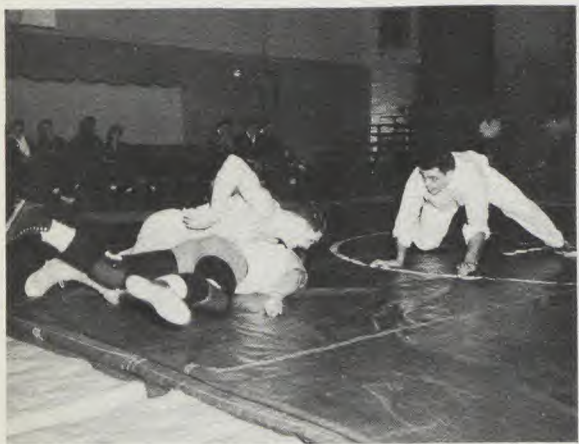
