










Picture Perfect Junior Prom







Powderpuff Football








Homecoming







BASEBALL
























BOYS' TENNIS
















GIRLS' TENNIS










Mu Alpha Theta














Science Honor Society





















ACT











Odyssey of the Mind














Peer Leadership










EDGE















SAVE














Red Cross Club











TIGS














Chess Club

























Concert Band/Jazz Band















Marching Band/Winterguard

























Platinum Soundz
