Owner views rationing

With the new rationing system presently in effect, both the long lines of cars and flaring tempers of patrons should be reduced at gas stations. According to Mr. Al Robal, owner of the Sunoco station on the corner of Central Avenue and South Avenue, the rationing plan has caused a great deal of problems.

Under the new policy, drivers must have a numbered license plate purchase gas on odd-numbered days and on even-numbered days. The even-numbered ones purchase gas on the odd-numbered days of the month. To control tank topping, (buying gas when it is not necessary), which Mr. Robal believes to be a major problem, dealers are now required to check the gas level of every car. Any car with half a tank or more

worth to a full tank, depending on his supply. He had to close down the pumps at least once a week, forcing workers to be laid off, and a 25% decrease in the number of working hours, due to lack of gas.

The long lines not only caused financial problems, but also caused a great deal of pride and a sense of accomplishment when I see my work in print. But more importantly, being on the Hi's business because they were in trouble, so I had to close because of problems with customers.

To enforce the rationing plan, it is now illegal to refuse to serve a customer who is not a "regular customer." A \$5,000 fine can be imposed on those dealers neglecting the law.
