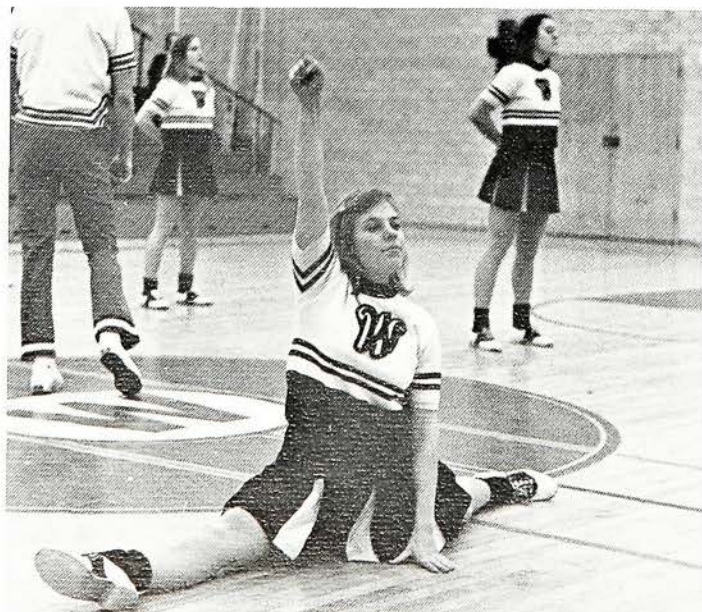
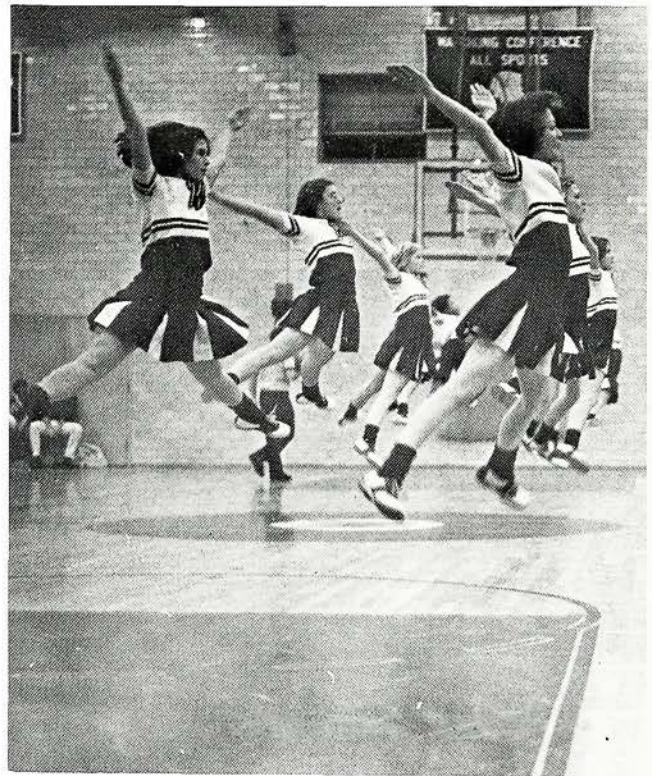
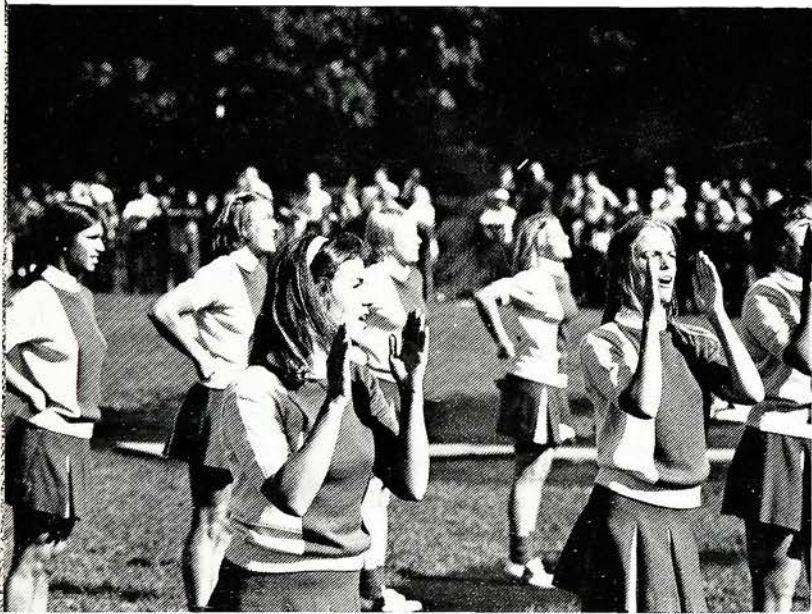


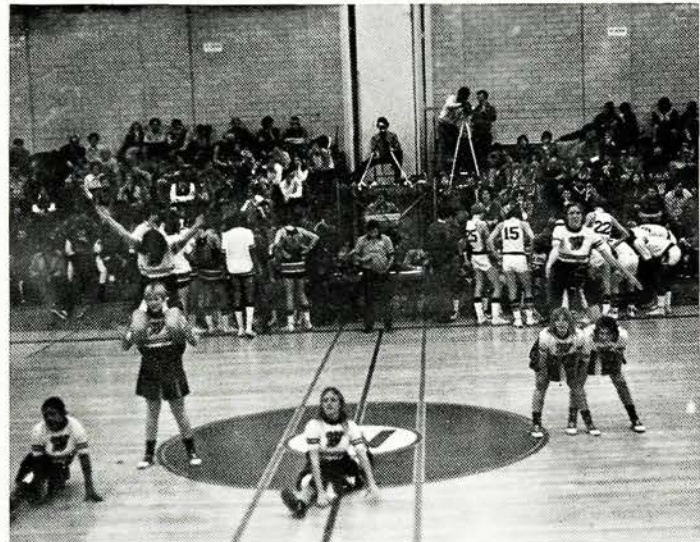
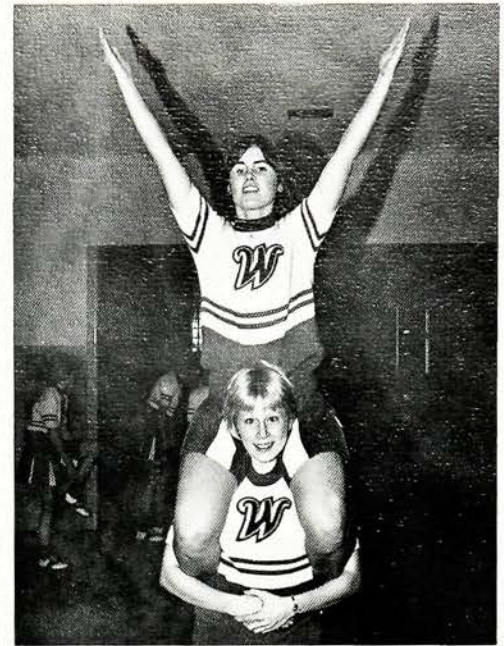
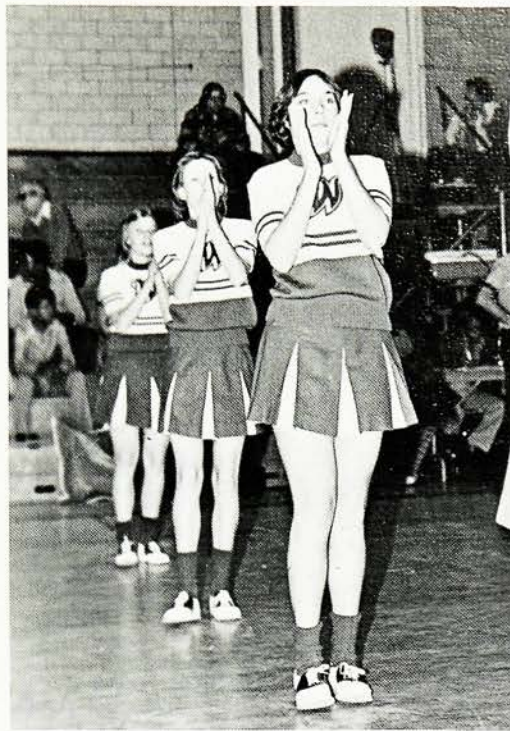


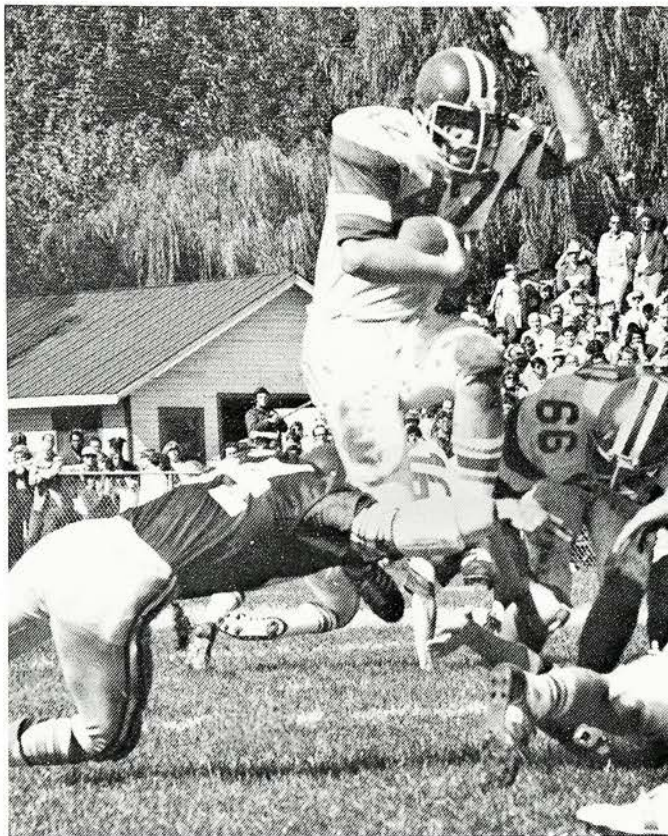


SPORTS

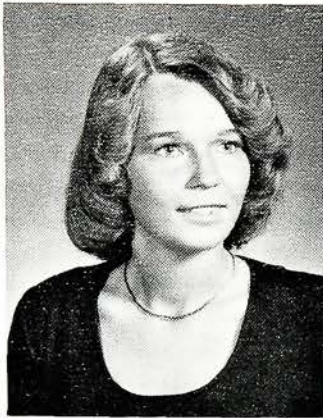






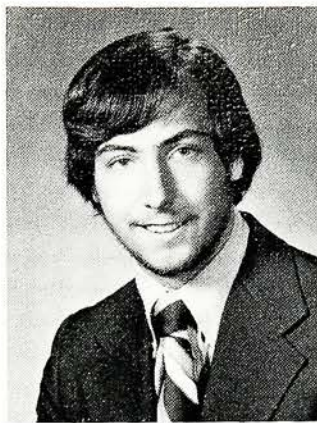
SENIORS
