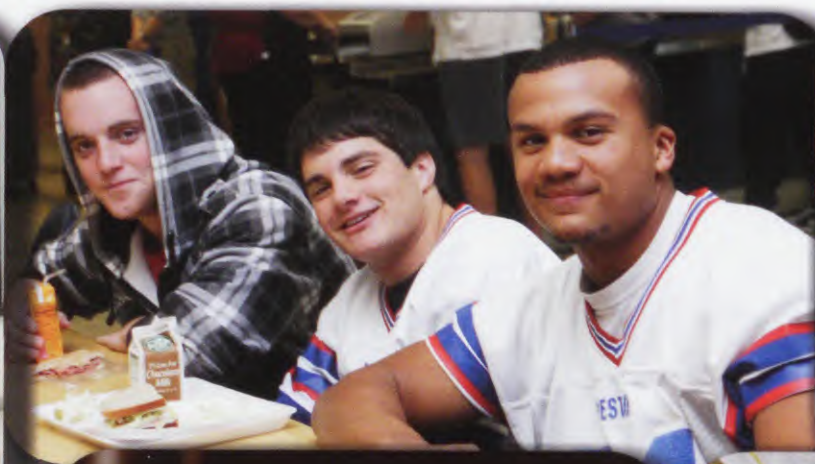


SENIORS

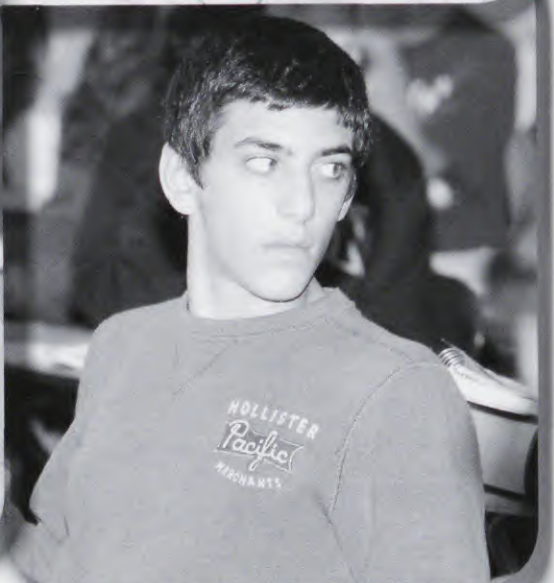
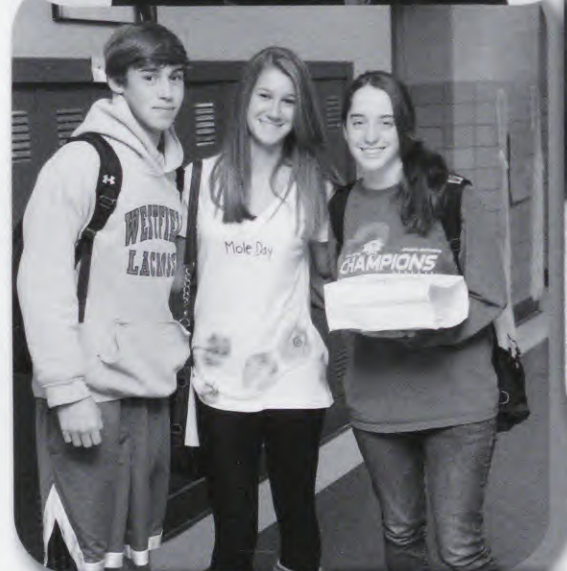


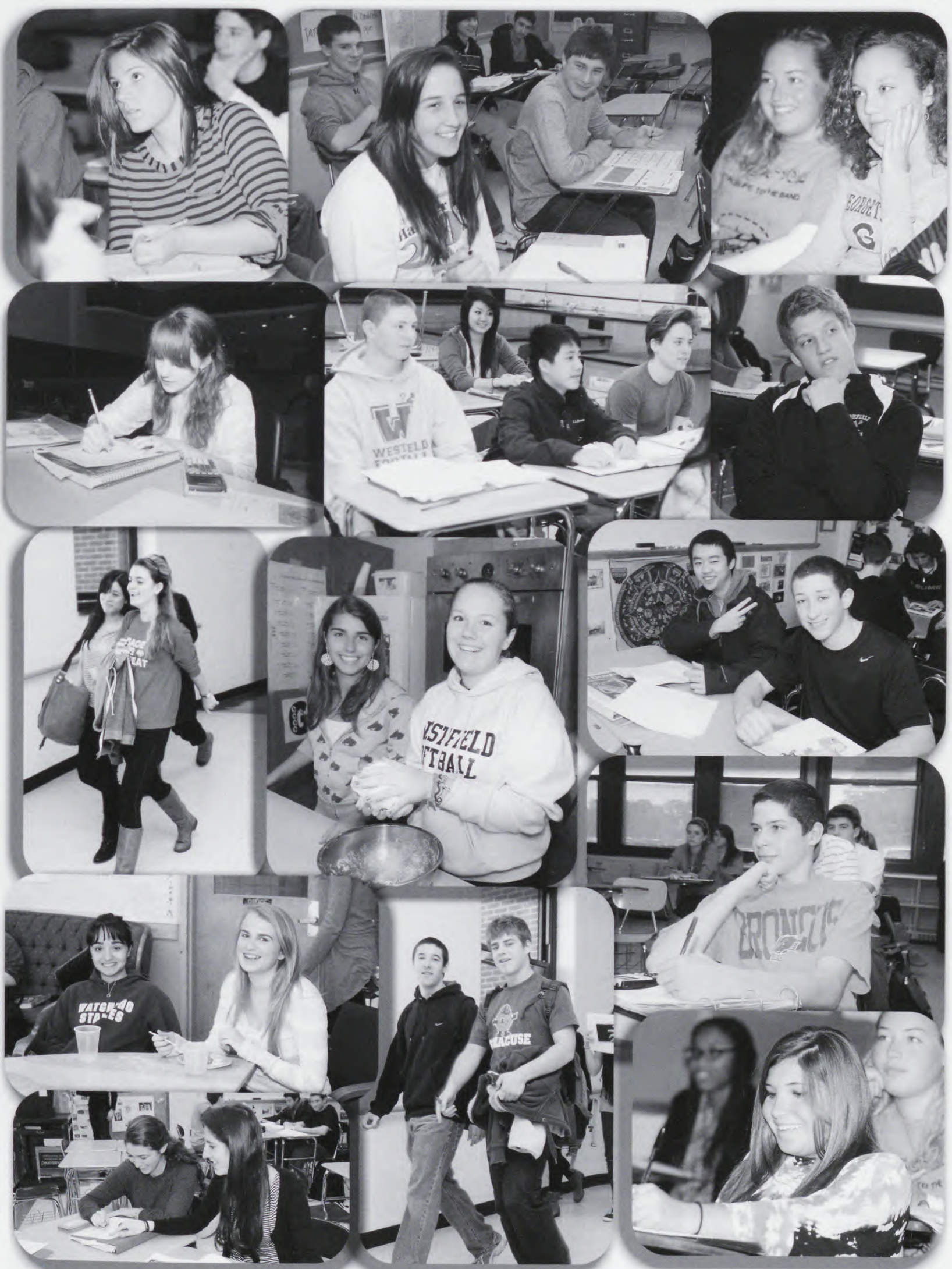
JUNIORS

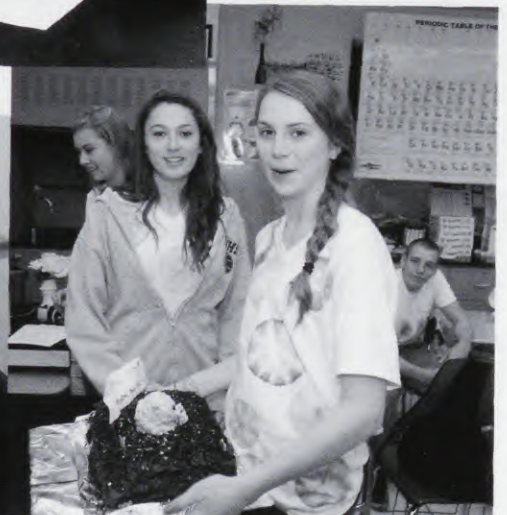


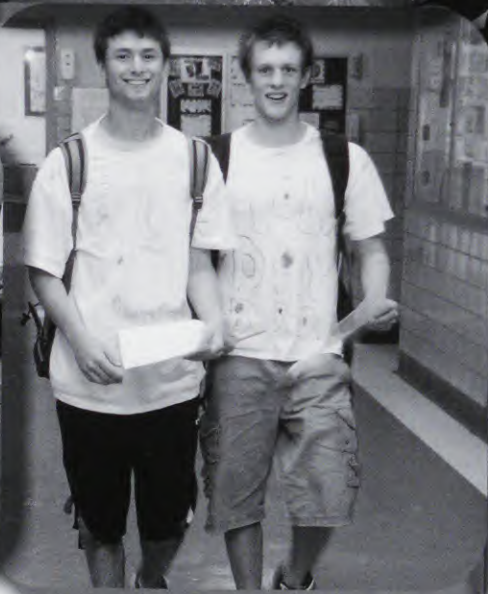
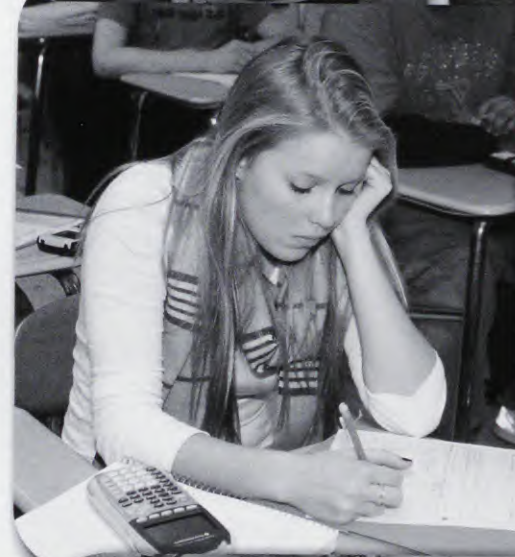


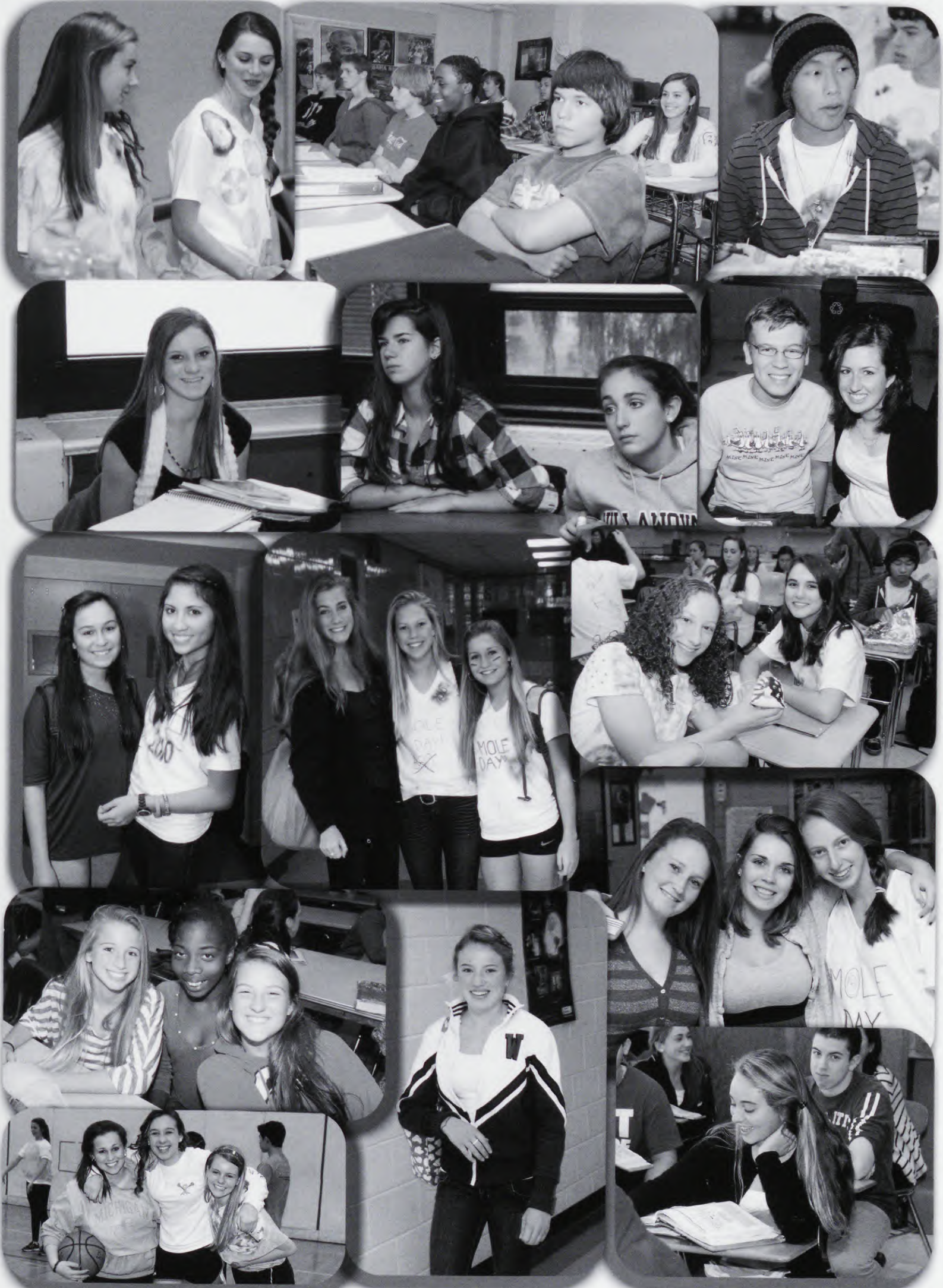
SOPHOMORES

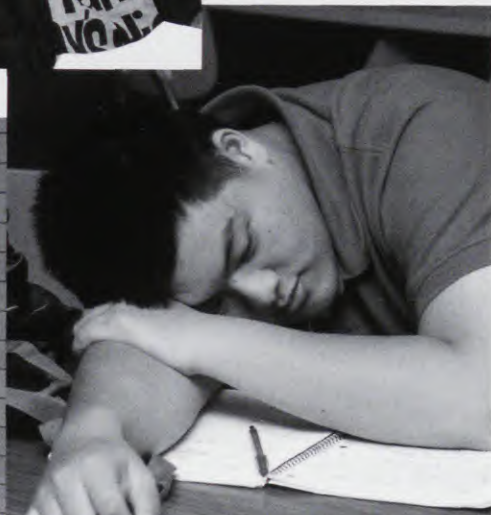




ACADEMICS

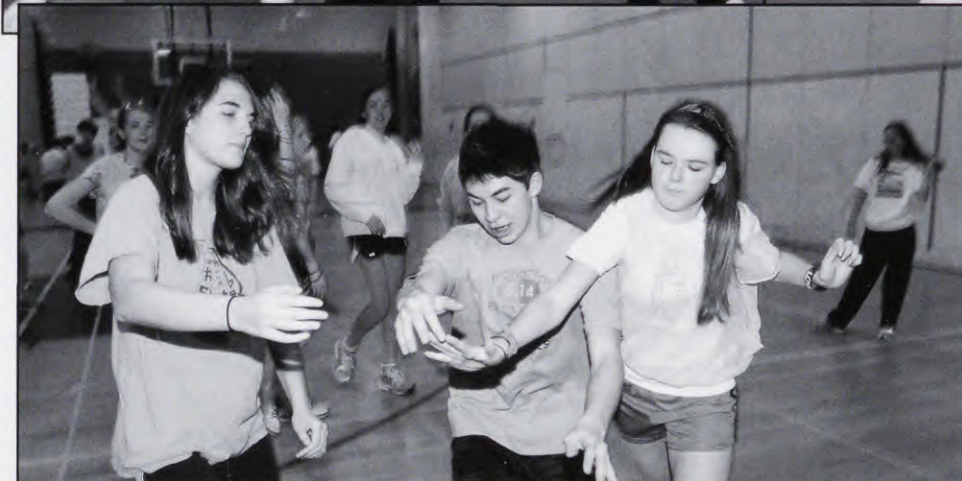

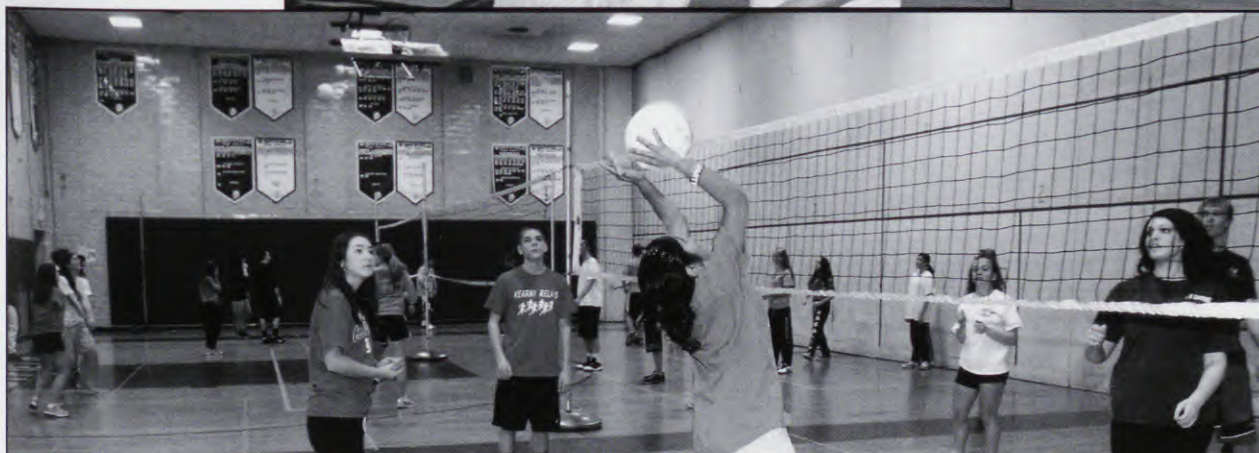

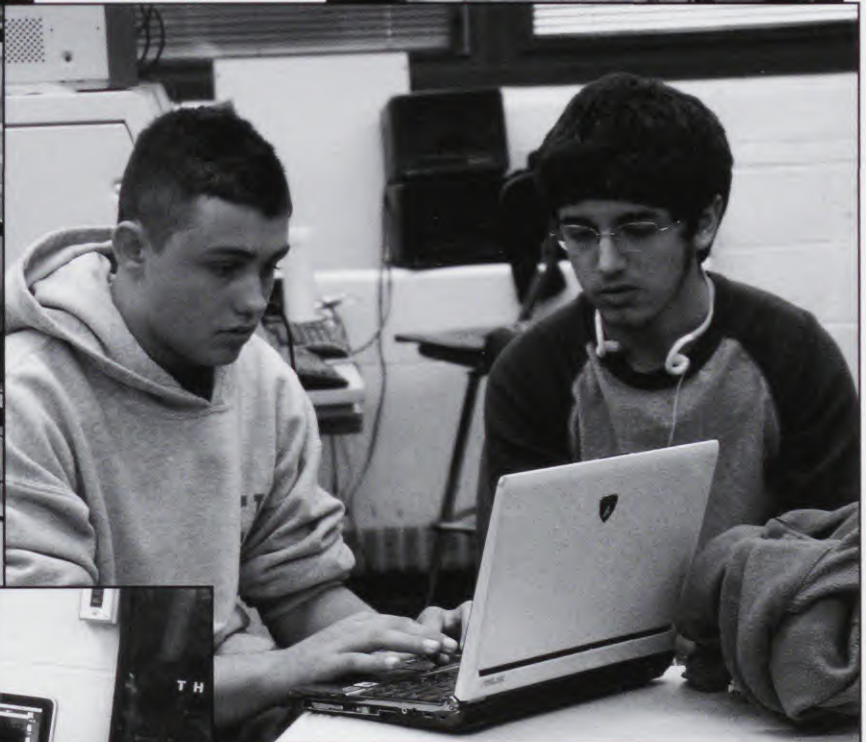

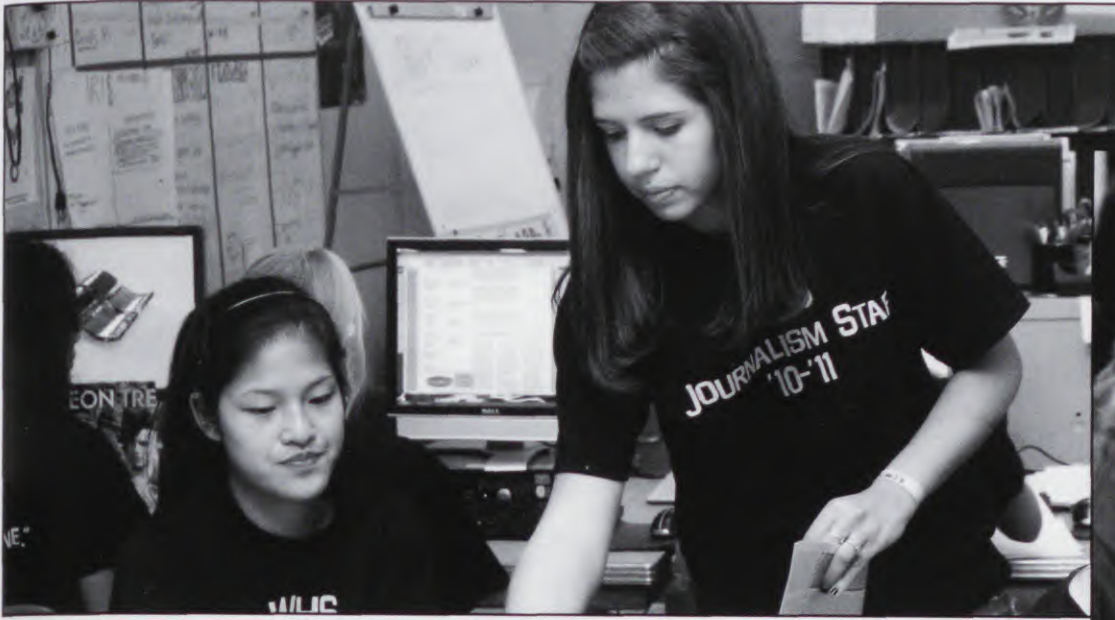

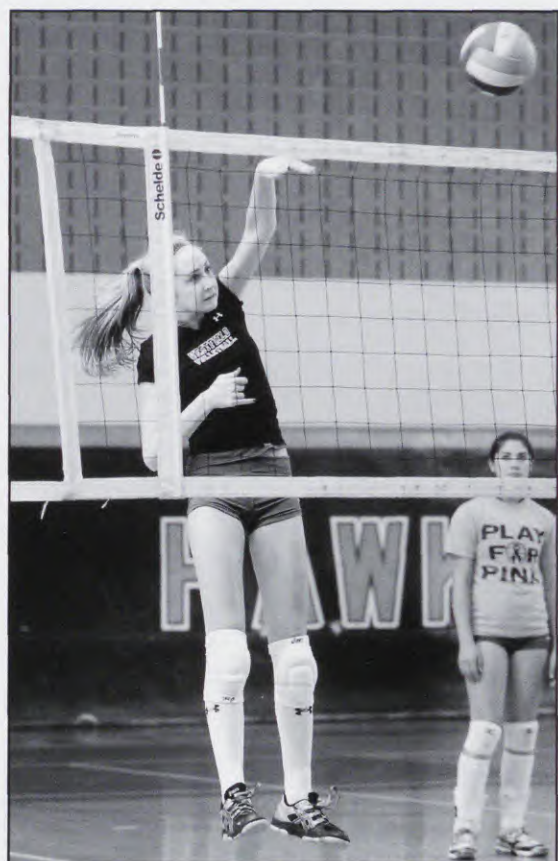

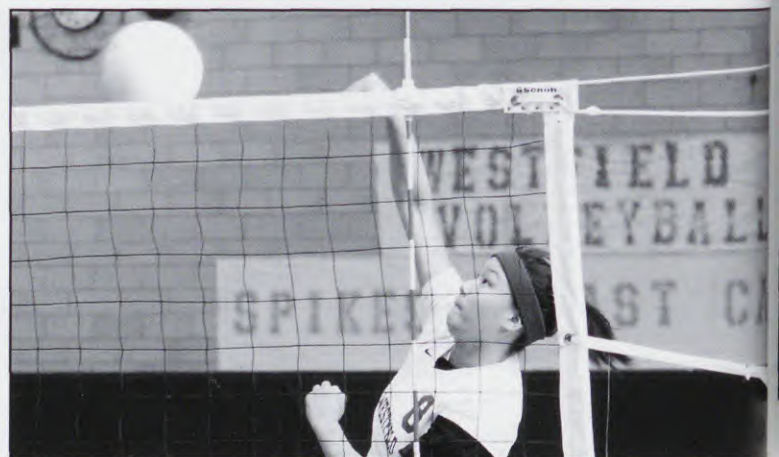

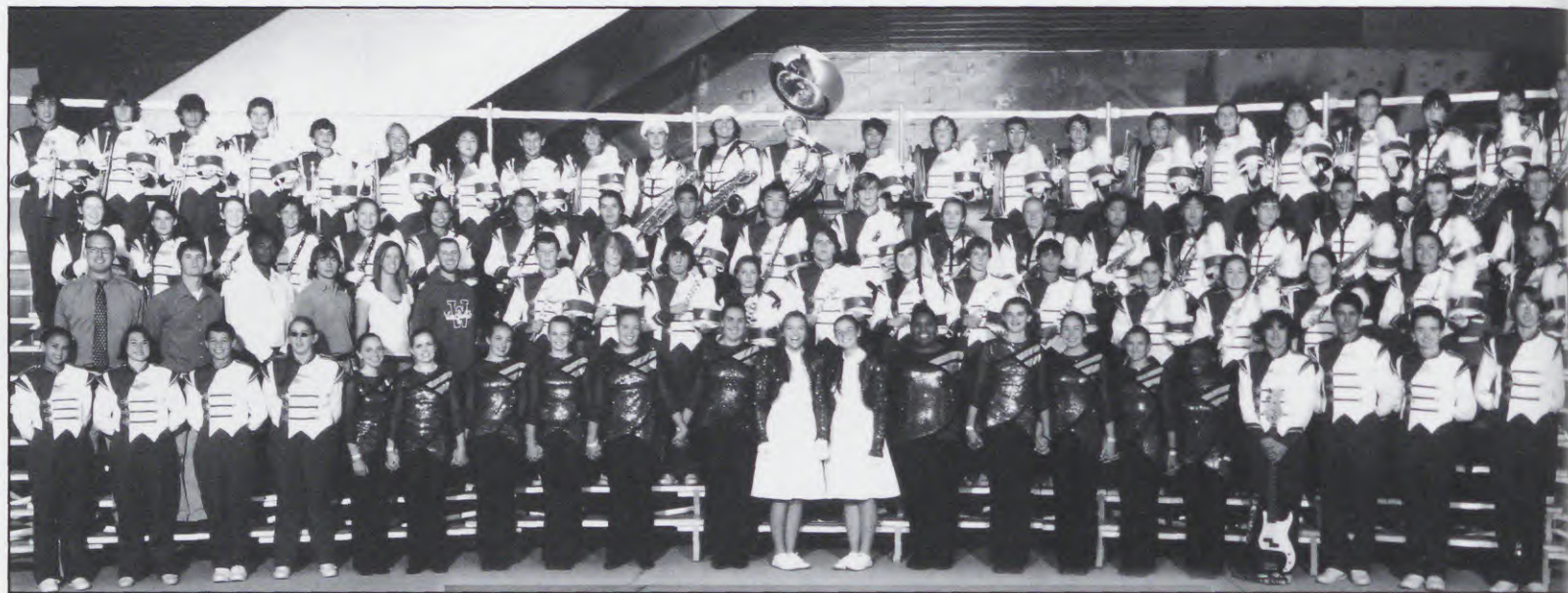

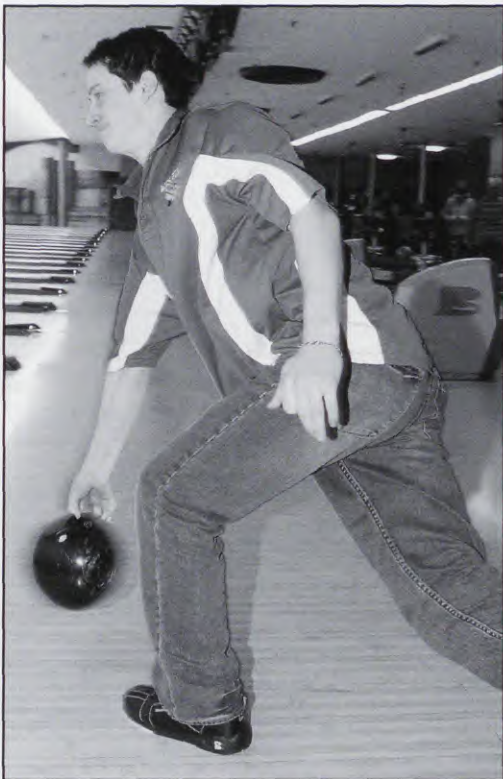

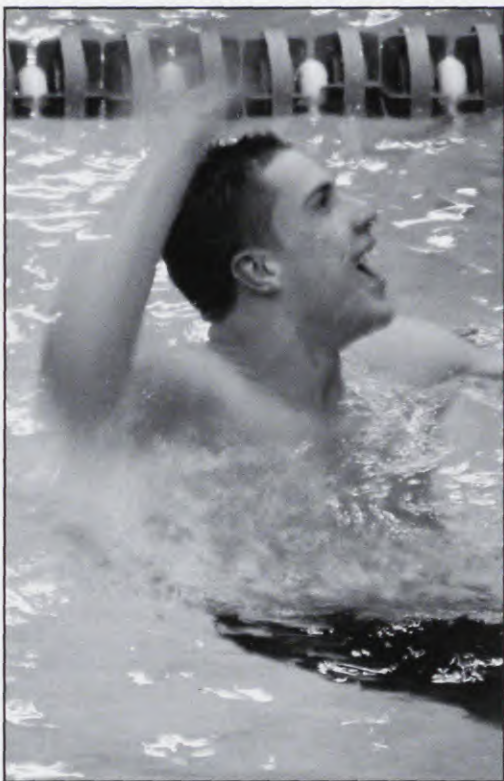

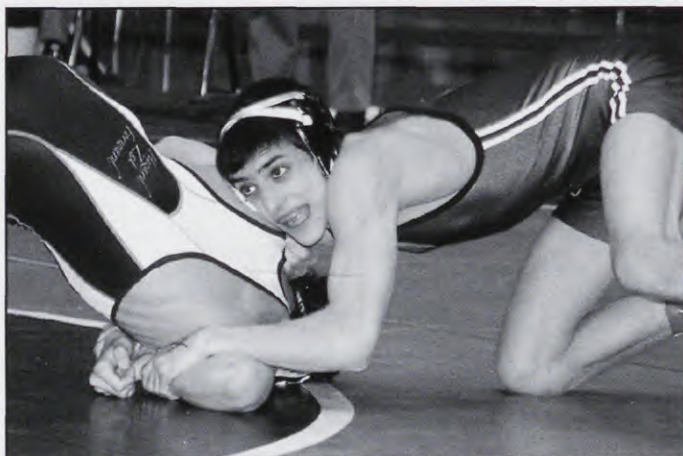

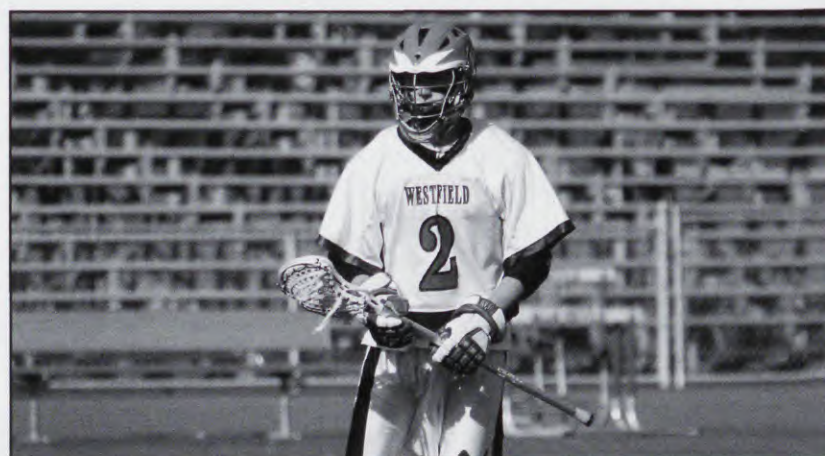

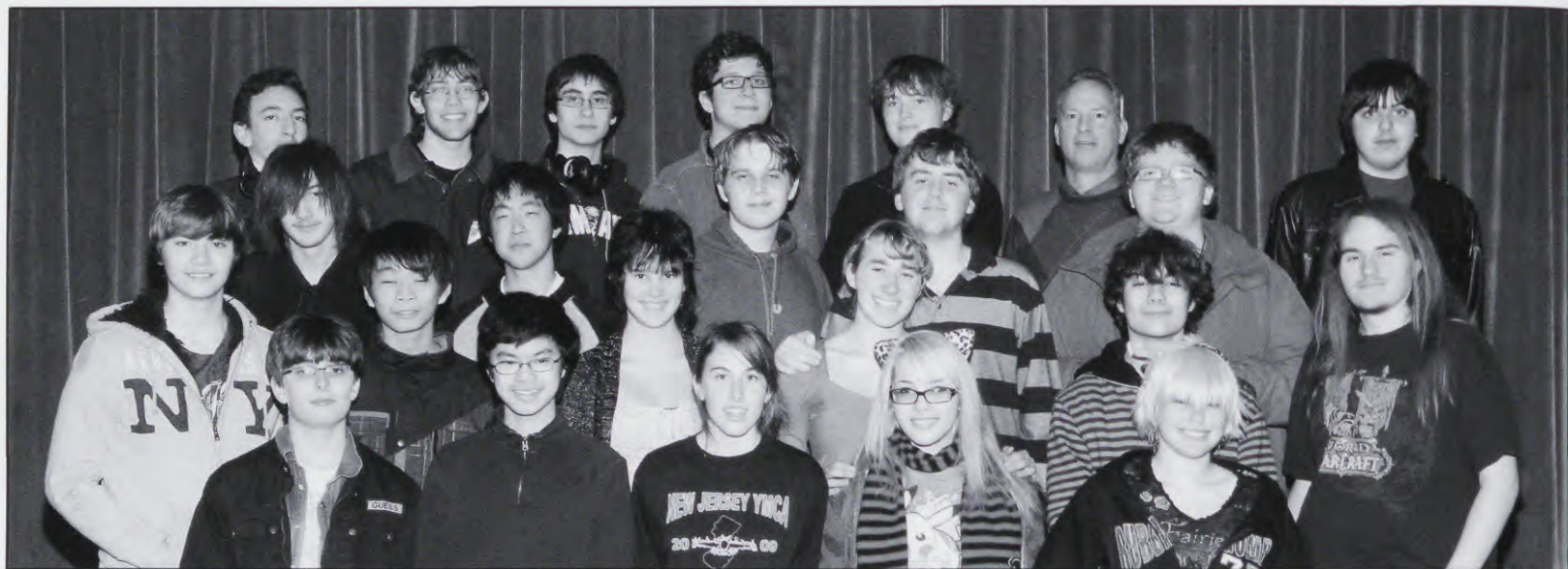


EXTRACURRICULAR

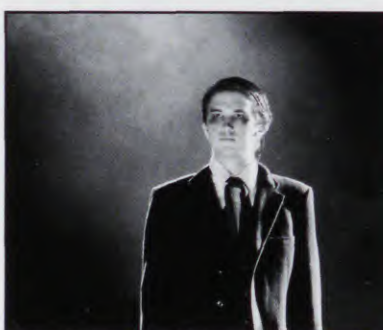

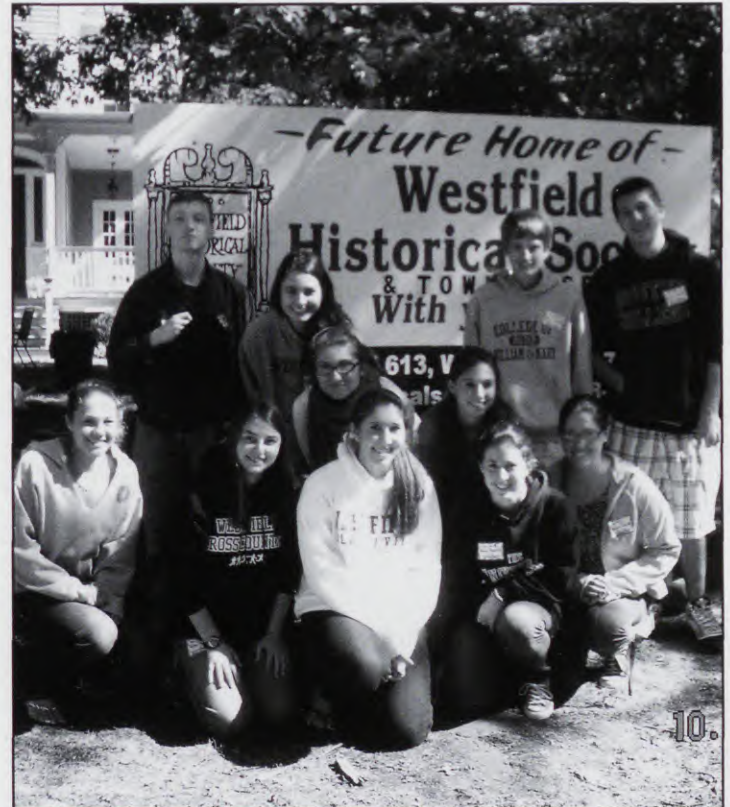

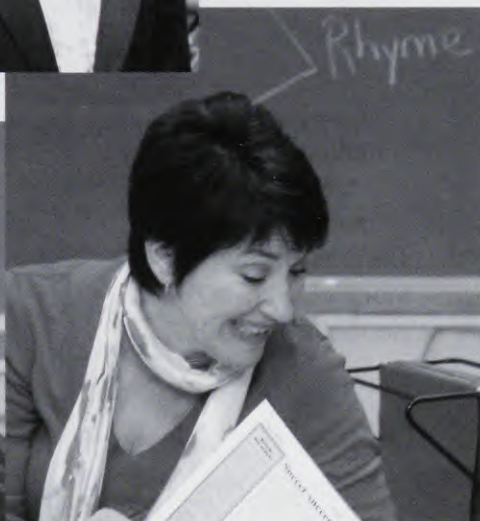


FACULTY
