These Mountain squads outshone their opponents until the last final buzzer.


Their achievements we shouldn't forget; the brief surge of praise which so outweighs the tedious hours of practice.

Those who partook, those who described, those who watched — Mountain High School cannot and will not leave us though we have left it.








