
Watergate and the Arab-Oil embargo certainly colored our junior year.

Those who partook, those who described, those who watched — Mountain High School cannot and will not leave us though we have left it.





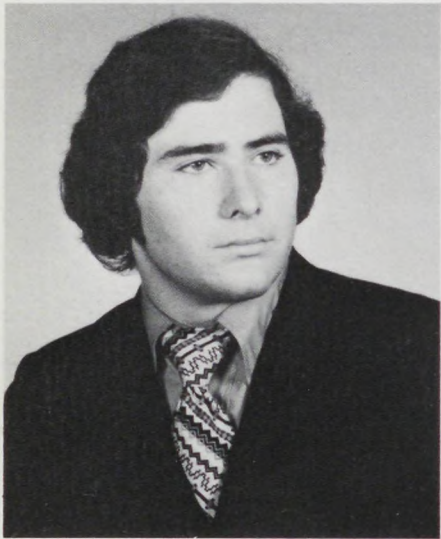
