If we human beings deserve at all the epithet "successful", it is because we are the earth-dwellers who have fought a better fight than other species on our planet against the destructive forces of time and distance. Our victories have been won (and our defeats assuaged) largely through our powers of communication. The most conclusive evidence of our triumphs over time and space: civilization itself - with its Tokyos and New Yorks, its Voyager I's and II's, its Picassos and its Shakespeares is a testimony to the power of our communication to transcend the centuries and the miles that separate one human from another. The study of English is the study of the power of words to draw people together and multiply their force. The precision and logic of expository prose enable us to share technical knowledge and to organize our social endeavors so that roads, cities, and laws may come into being. 


The mathematics teacher is to the beginning mathematics student as the seasoned guide is to the tenderfoot in the woods. Neither the beginning mathematics student nor the tenderfoot can interpret the signs that are readily available until the teacher or guide points them out. An important part of mathematical training is to make one aware of the clues that are present, their significance, and finally, their interpretation as applied to that particular situation.

The ability to apply one's knowledge requires that all necessary information has been carefully filed in one's mind, in an orderly fashion, so that it can be carefully called upon. It also implies that information must be arranged so that one knows what tasks the various mathematical tools are designed to perform. Finally, the procedures must have been practiced until they become mastered and hence can be done reasonably free of careless errors.

In conclusion, as part of a student's study habits, he ought to ask himself, "What was it that I didn't see, but that was really there to be seen, or what was it that I didn't know, but that I ought to have known?" Thoreau stated we must keep in mind "the discipline of looking always at what is to be seen."

1981 RETROSPECT

Young blacks grew up in fear in Atlanta - in the shadow of a wave of murders which claimed the lives of more than twenty youngsters. When the Atlanta police force found it couldn't handle the chore alone, government agencies were called in to help, and hundreds of volunteers from surrounding communities also joined. After 18 months, the murders still remain unsolved, and Atlantans still search.





THE REAGAN LANDSLIDE



Ronald Reagan, septegenarian, politician and former actor, made good a bid for the presidency, sweeping into the White House with a whopping 51% of the popular vote. Despite predictions that the 1980 elections would be too close to call, Reagan garnered 440 more electoral votes than the Democratic incumbent Jimmy Carter. The voters' apparent enthusiasm for the Californian was manifested in the numbers who turned out to cast their ballots. Voting was so one sided that NBC television declared Reagan the victor even before the western polls had closed. America was ready for a change.





EX-BEATLE LENNON SLAIN

John Lennon, the self - styled leader of the Beatles, was gunned down in front of his posh Dakota Apartment residence on Monday, Dec. 8, 1980. The tragic loss of this oft times enigmatic musician was felt worldwide. Lennon's compositions, the anthems of the peace movement of the early seventies, were sung by followers as a tribute to this great man.

In addition to the return of the hostages, Americans saw the return of patriotism which boosted our sagging morale and helped the country unite in the same manner as when the U.S. Hockey team won the gold medal in the 1980 Winter Olympics.




