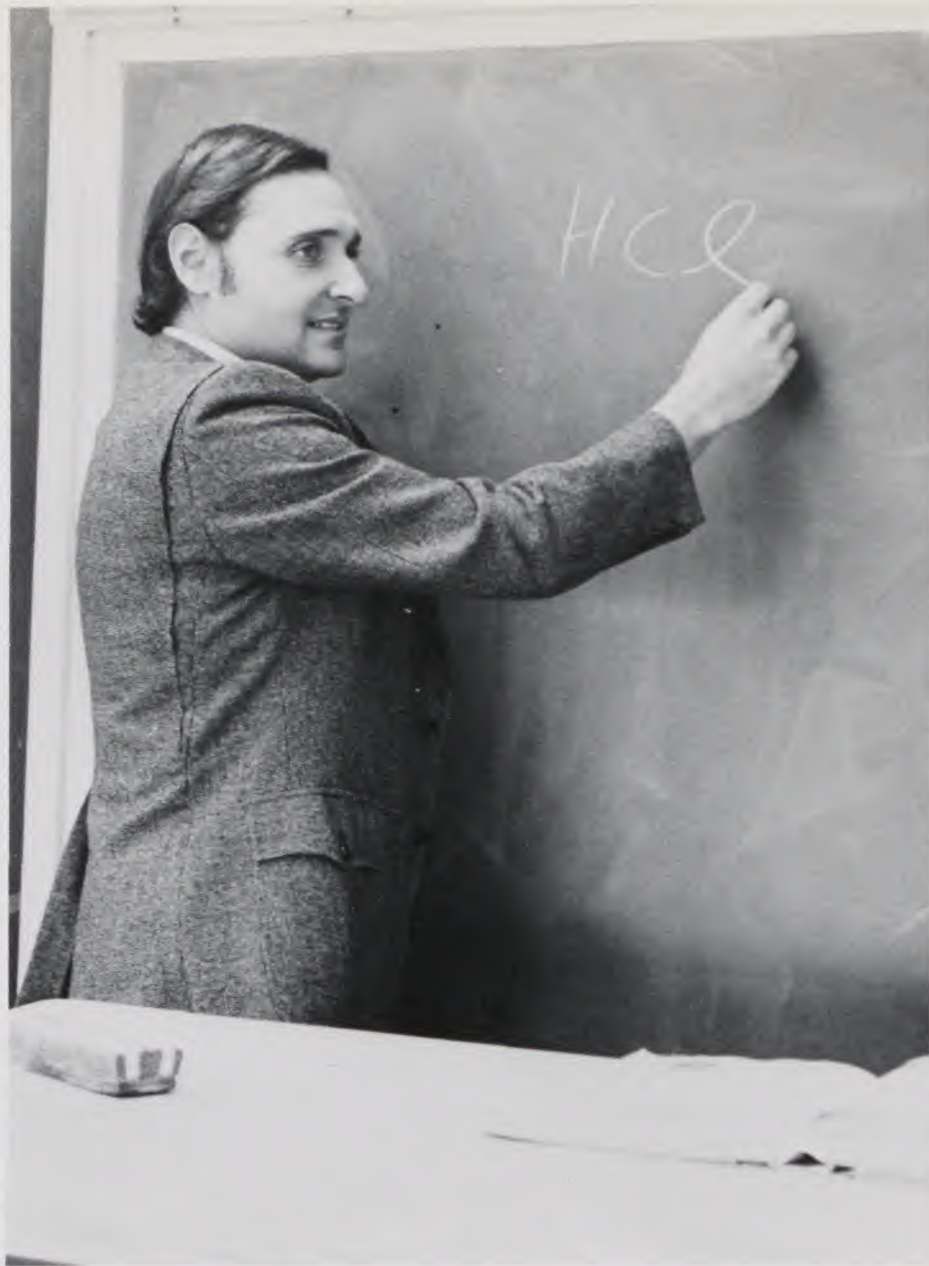
Q: Explain in molecular terms why hot air rises.
