


Short History:

In the fall of 1928, West Orange High School was opened. In 1931, it graduated its first class. This class produced a yearbook which was called "The West-O-Ranger."

Even if you could care less about the history of our school, look at the next five pages and laugh at the previous classes that are pictured. And remember, fifty years from now we'll look just as strange.



In the 1970's, high school students often appeared to be "rebellious." From 1931 on, the Yearbook was known as "The West-O-Ranger." The 1971 edition marked the last time the name "West-O-Ranger" was used. The 1972 staff decided not to use the traditional name. The theme of the 1971 Yearbook was "Reflecting on Values."
