Project Adventure was implemented into the Physical Education curriculum in the Fall of 1996. The program is designed to offer the students of West Orange High School an added opportunity to experience an experimental approach to Physical Education.

The program combines non-competitive games, trust exercises, problem solving through constructed elements, an elevated rope course and a 50-foot climbing tower for rock climbing and rappelling. Each segment of the curriculum gives students opportunities to work with one another toward common goals, while learning the value of taking positive risks in a supportive atmosphere.

Ms. Welter, Project Adventure coordinator, states, "The class of 2000 has been instrumental to the success of our WOHS Project Adventure program. They were the first to participate in each phase giving the Project Adventure staff an opportunity to improve and establish one of the best Project Adventure programs in the state."






Yours to Keep





NHS is also offered to students who excel at a language. All three languages offered at the high school (French, Italian, and Spanish) have a National Honor Society. Ms. Timmins is in charge of the French NHS, Ms. Massari runs the Italian NHS, and Mrs. Kalemba organizes the Spanish NHS. The requirements for each honor society include obtaining an 'A' in the third and fourth honors levels of the language and no more than one 'B' in the AP level. Continuation with the language to the highest level possible is also part of the requirement. Students must participate in three types of activities, two that have to be sponsored by the West Orange High School Language Department, which include the language club or the S.A.L.E. program.



With over twenty-five academically and socially oriented clubs, there is truly something for everyone at WOHS.










setting the record straight

















Once the team followed Garguilo's system, they began winning more games. Garguilo commented, "The players were excitable, always prac-





For the first time, we switched classes and had our own lockers. We changed clothes for gym and ate lunch without recess afterwards.






