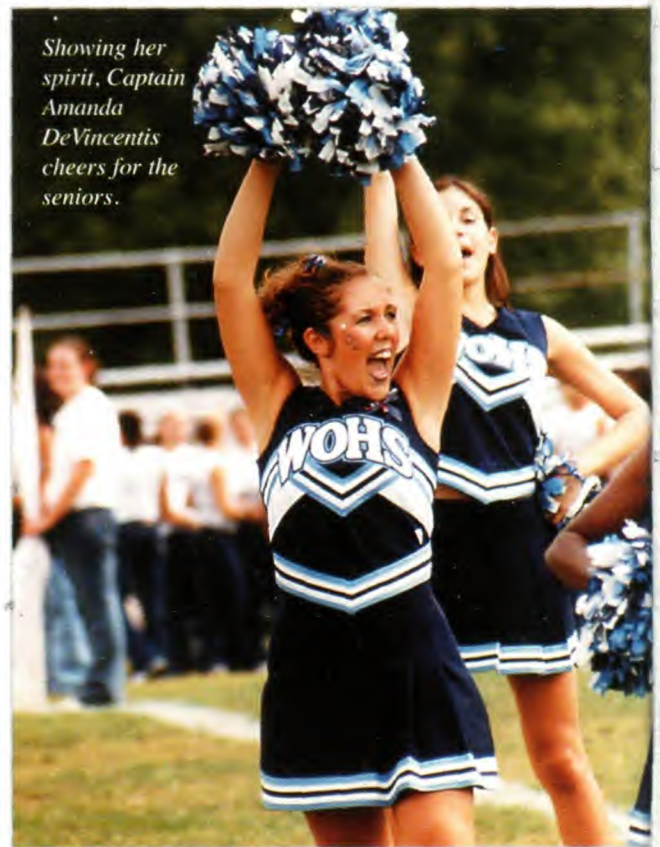

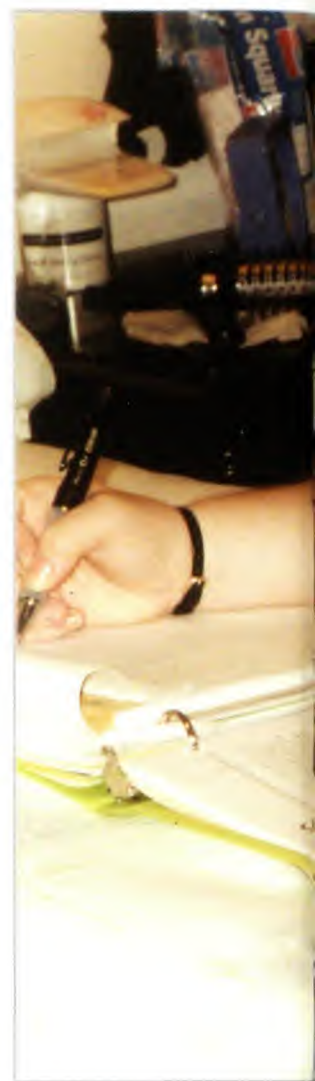
Never the Same & Always Unique

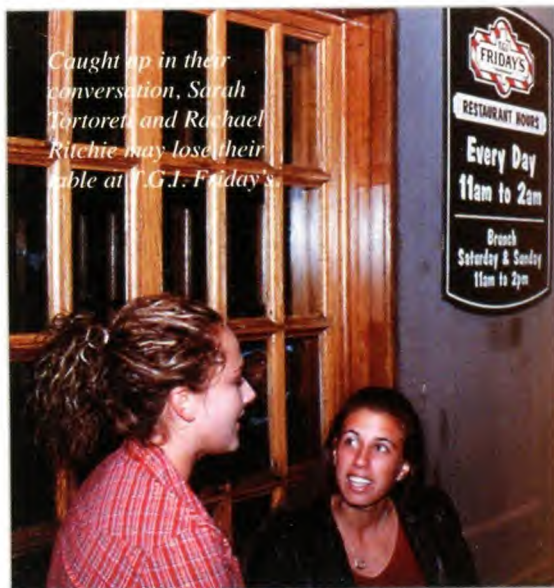

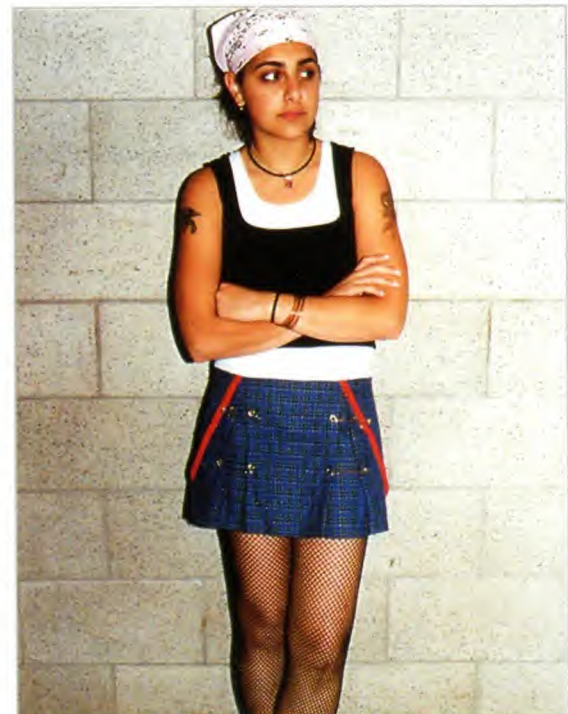
Comfy Casual & Charmingly Trendy

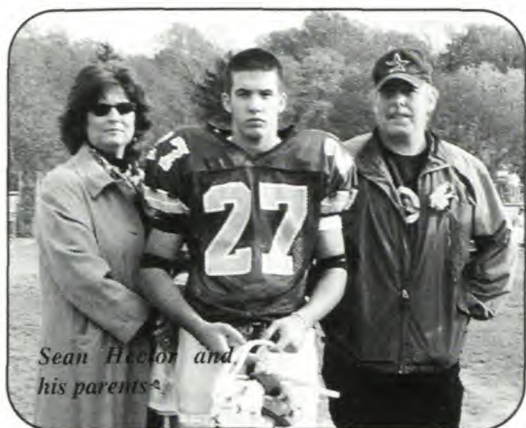

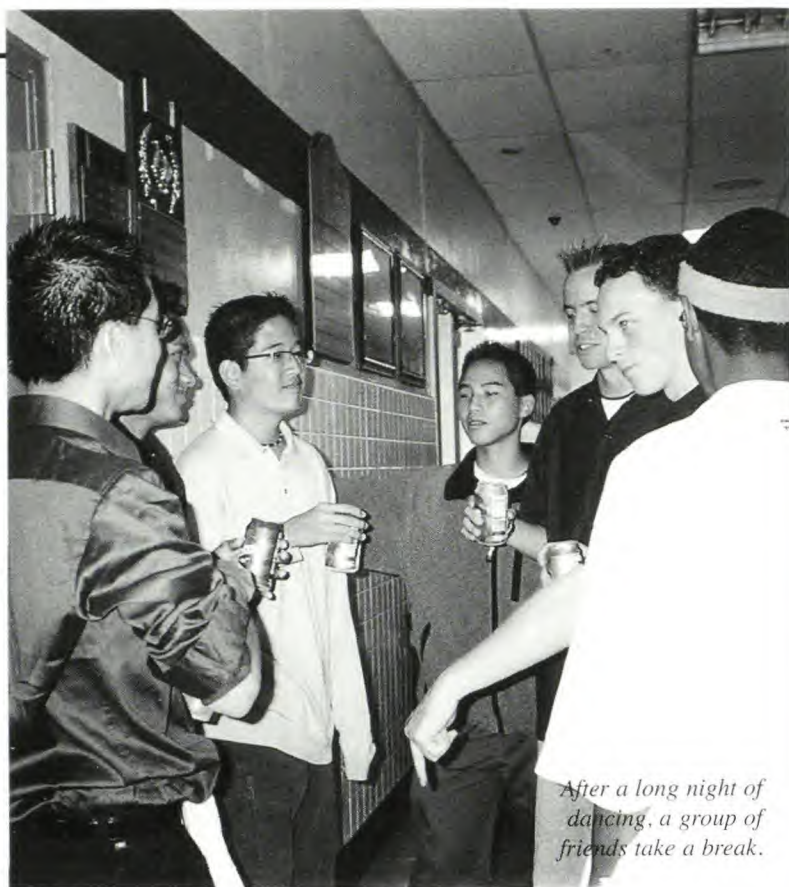

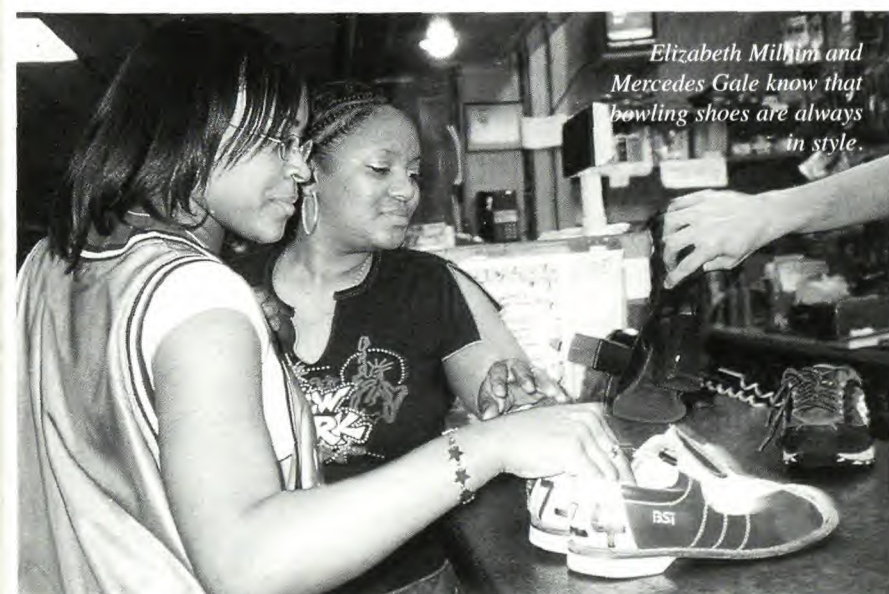

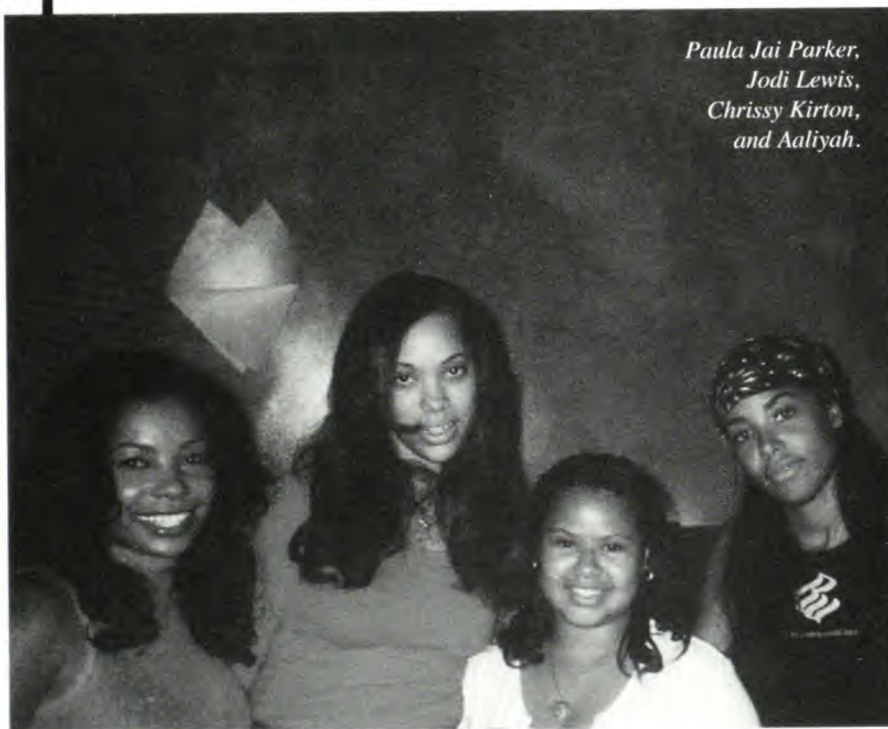

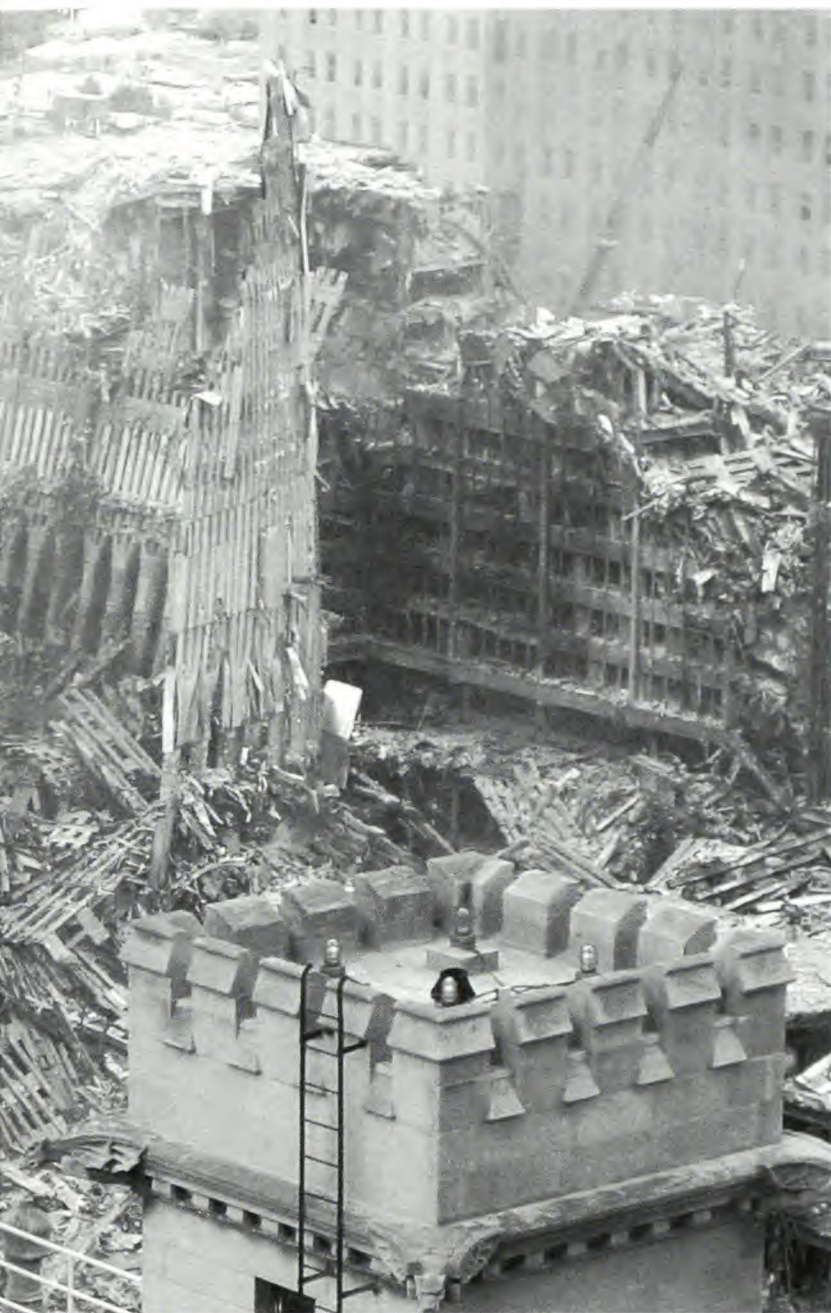

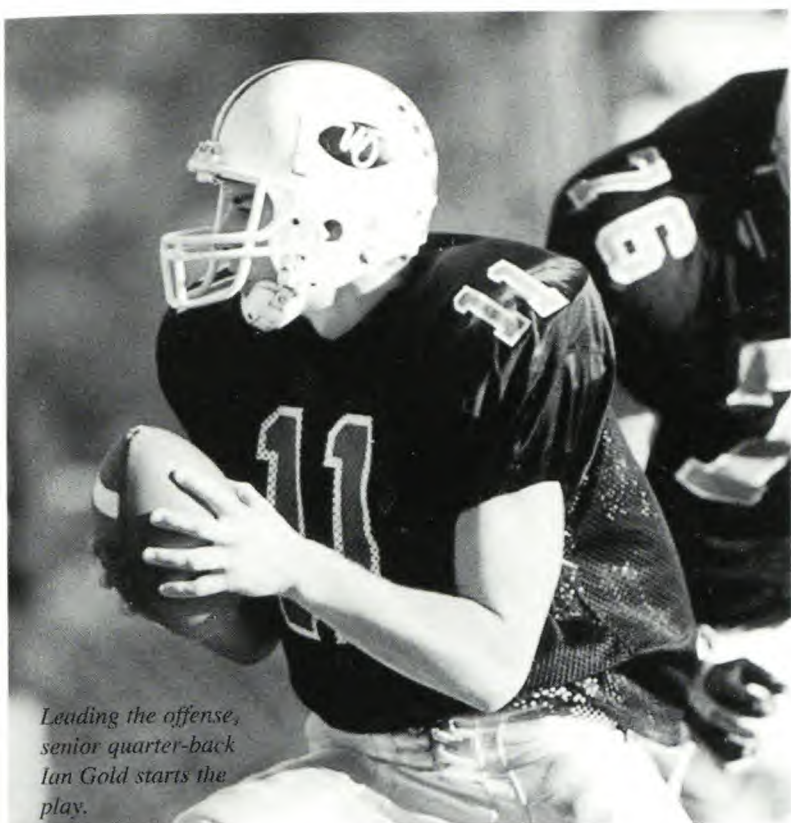

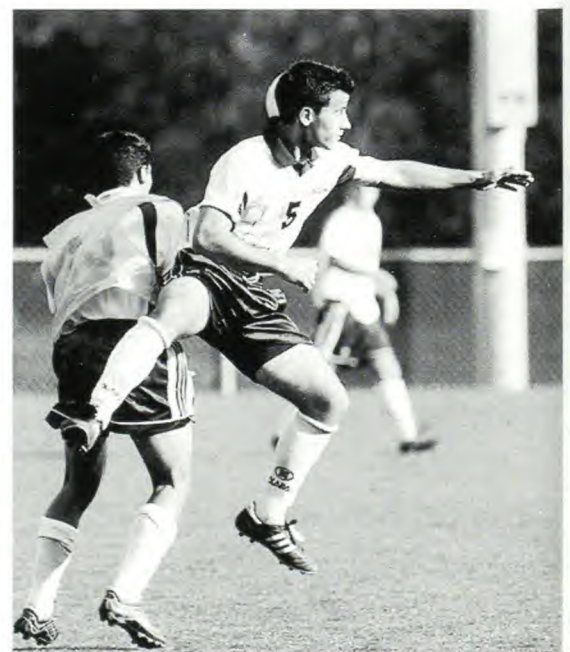

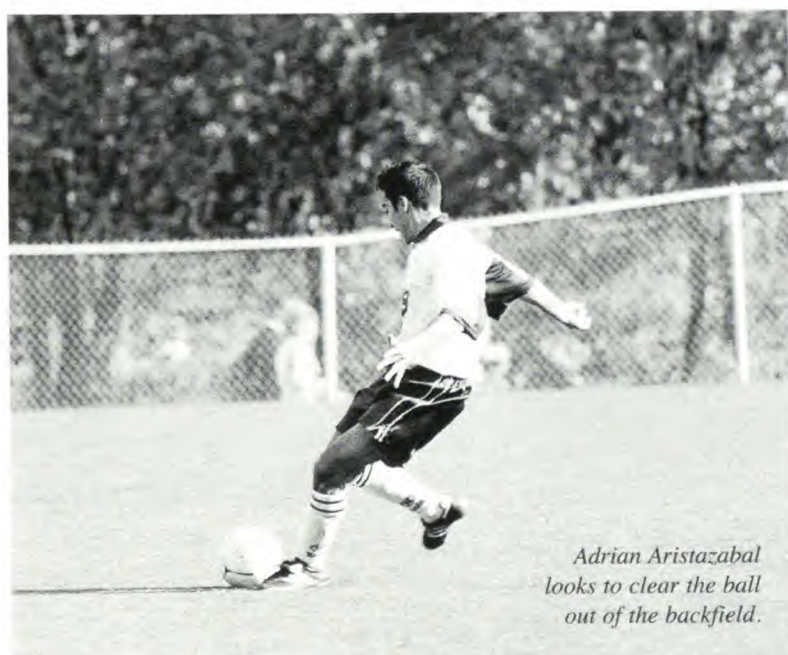

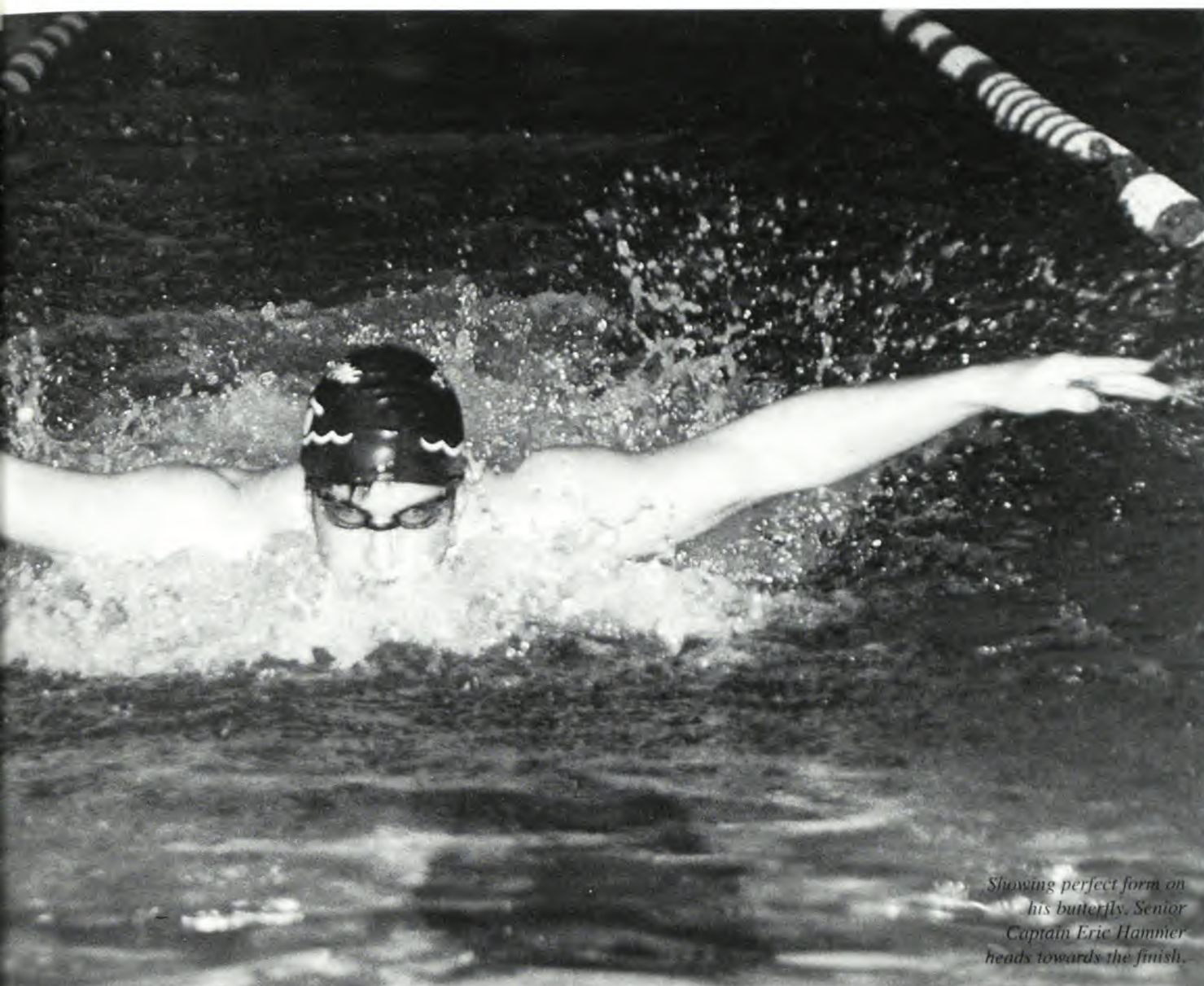

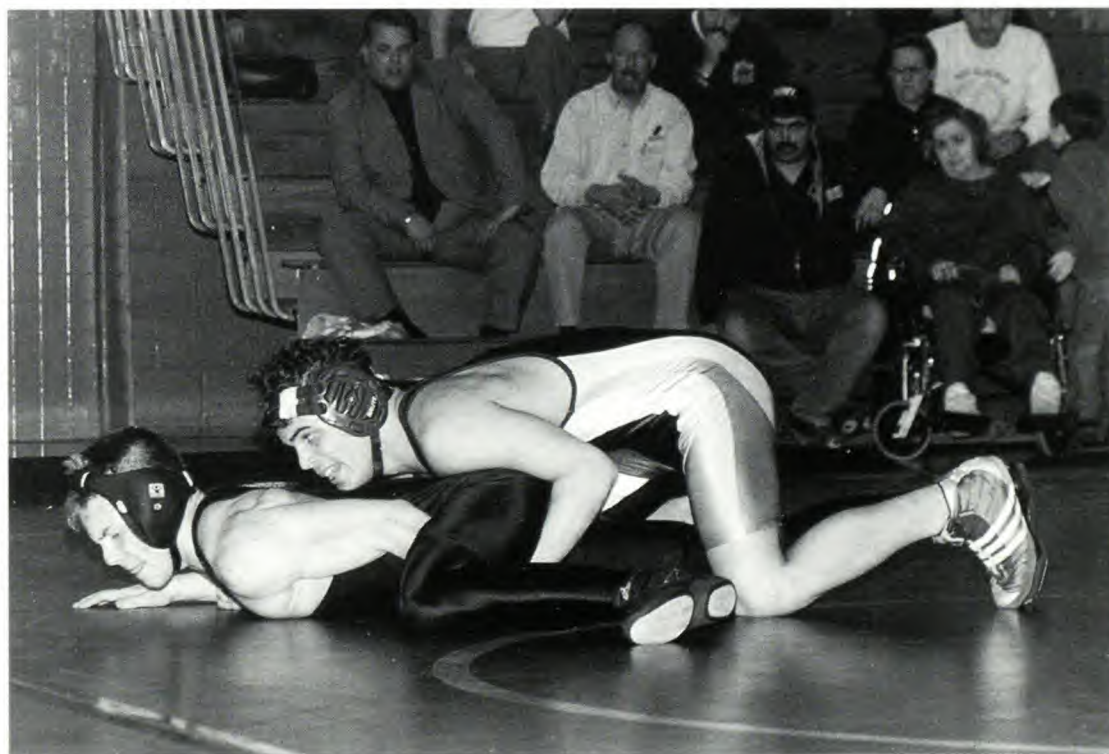

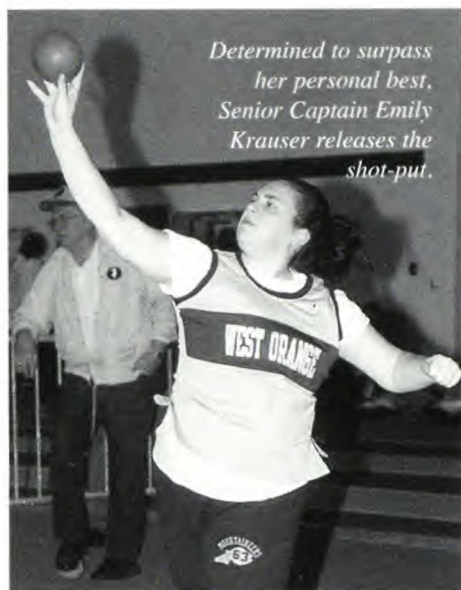

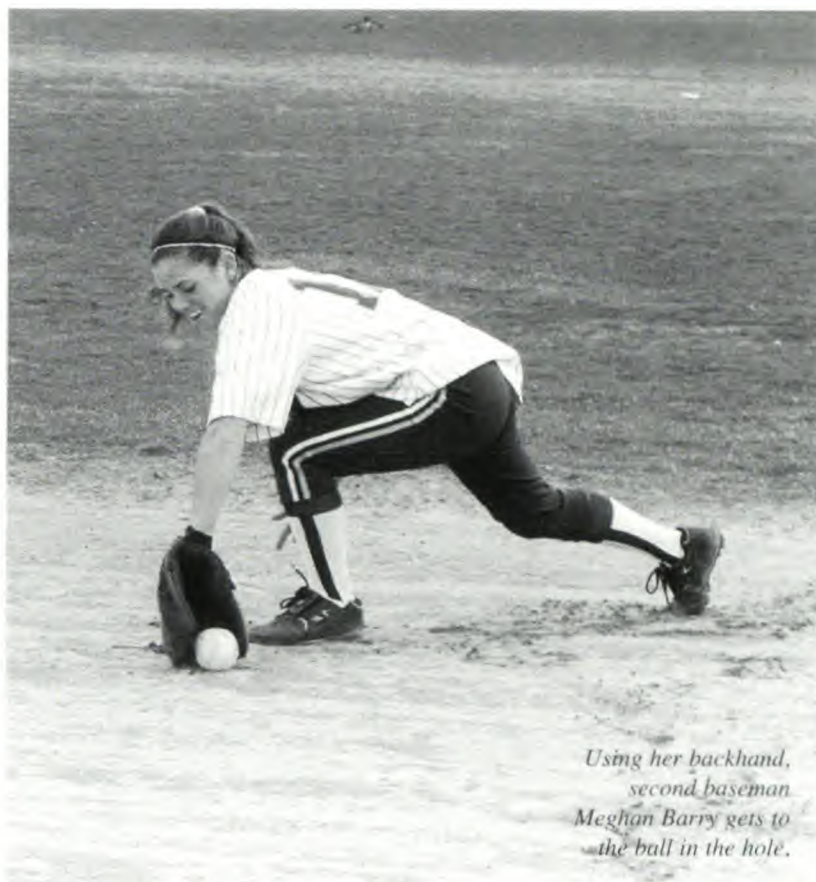

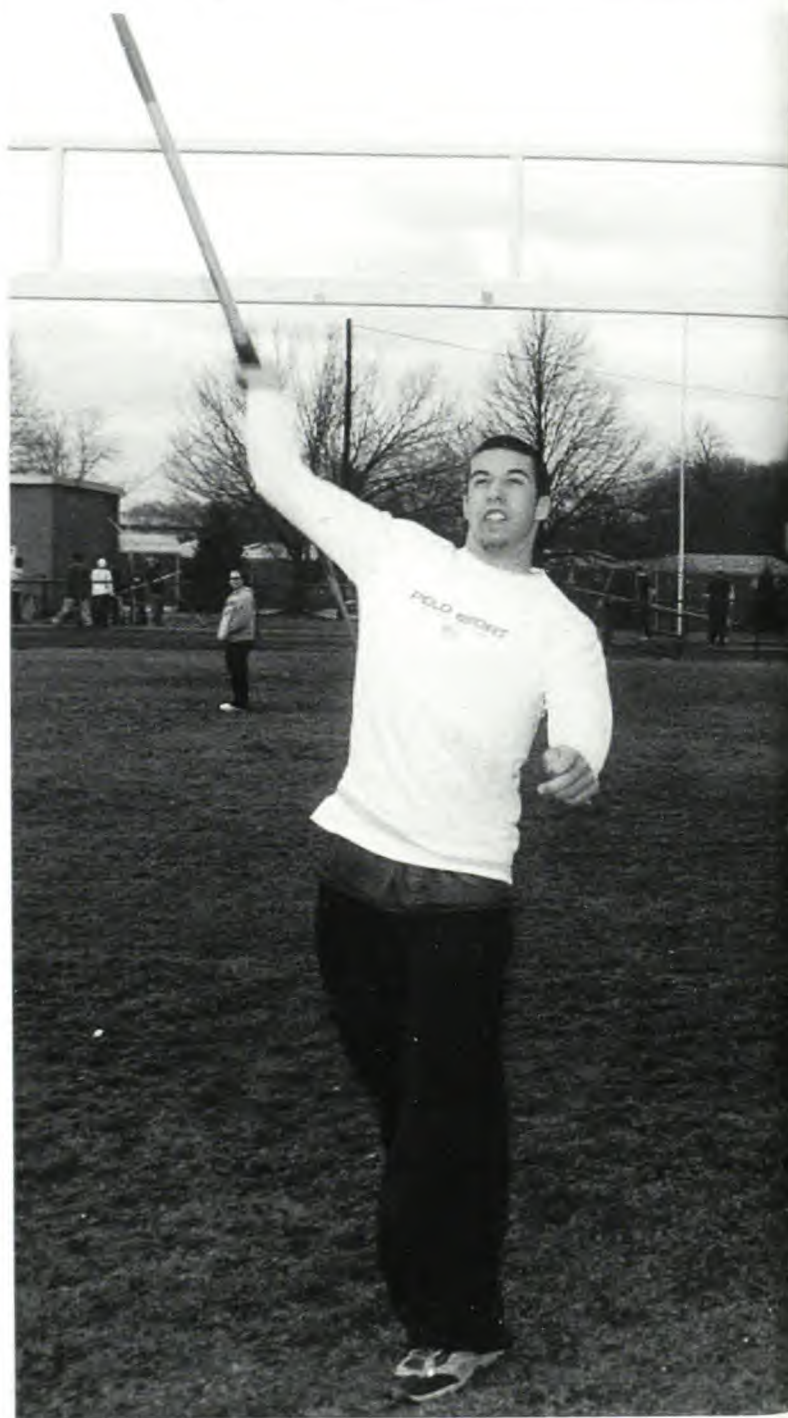

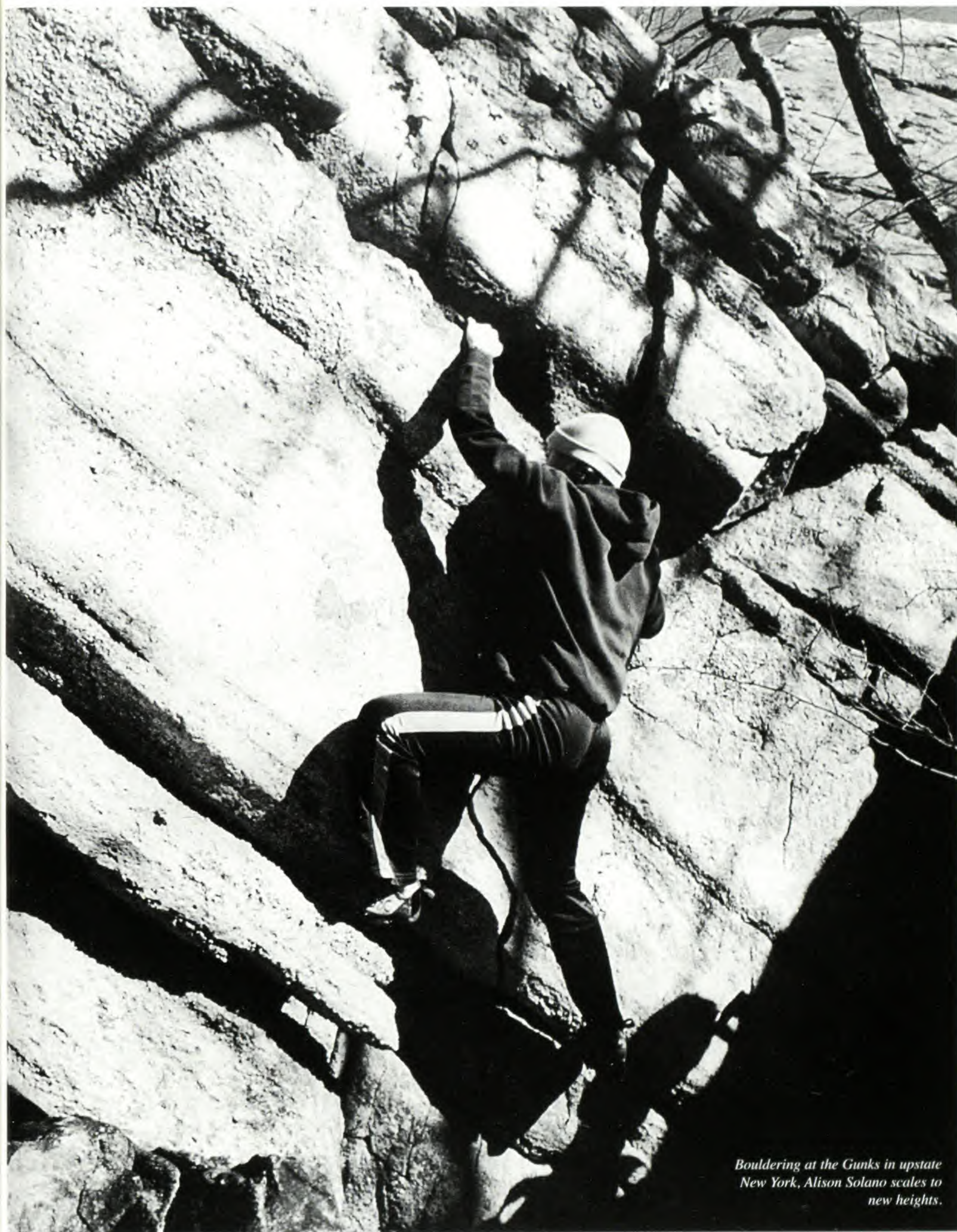
Pushing Limits & Craving Action
