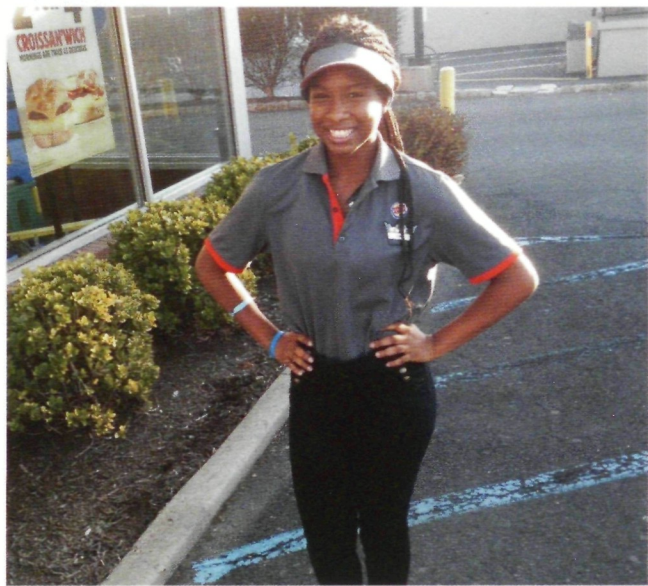

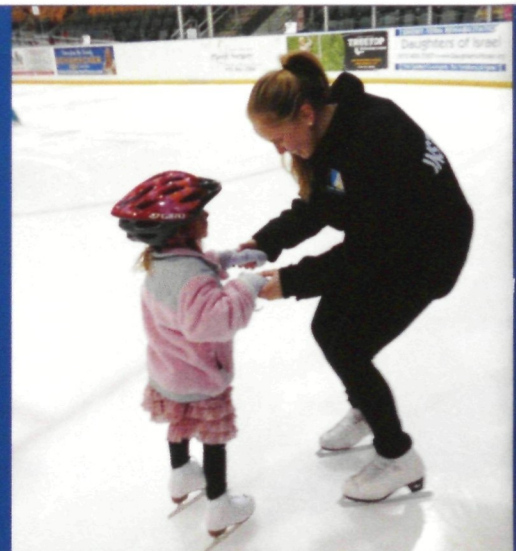

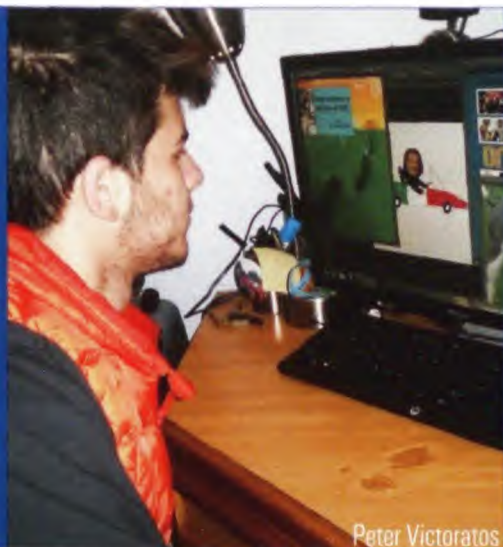

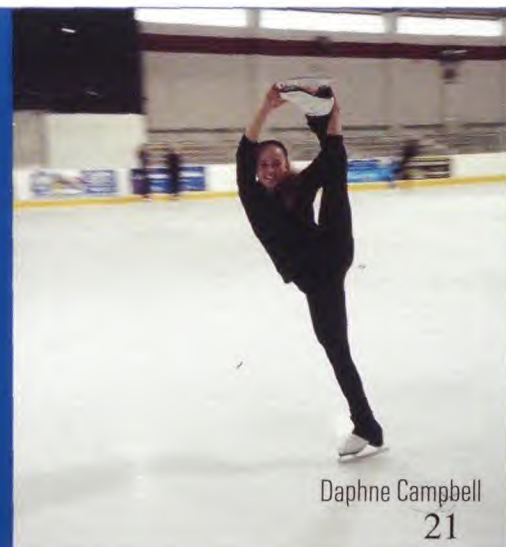

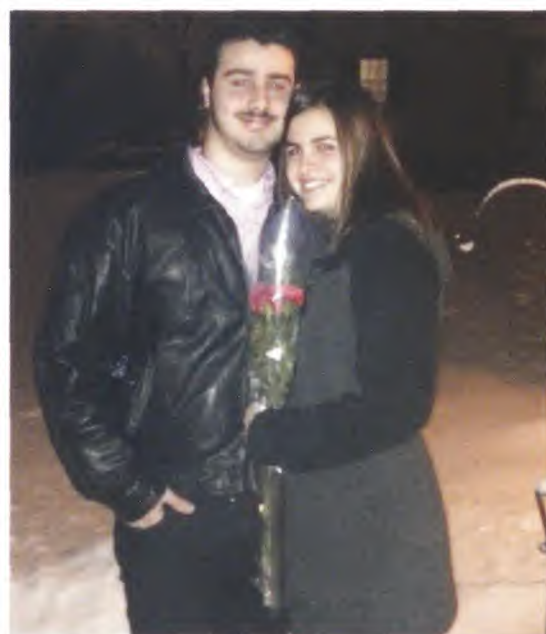


Promposals

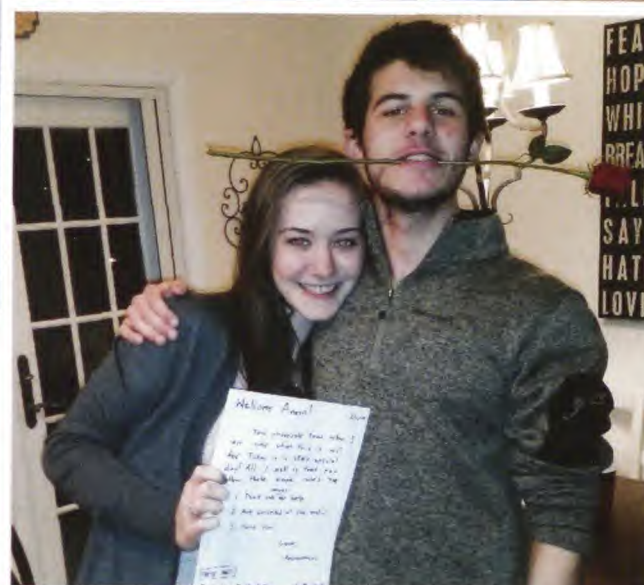

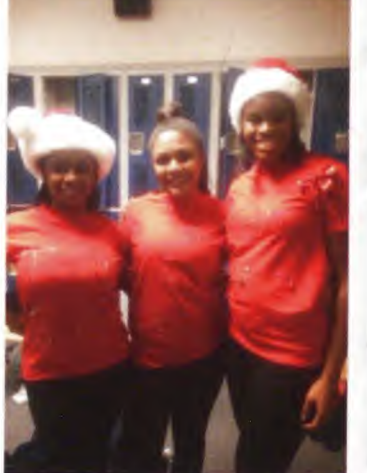

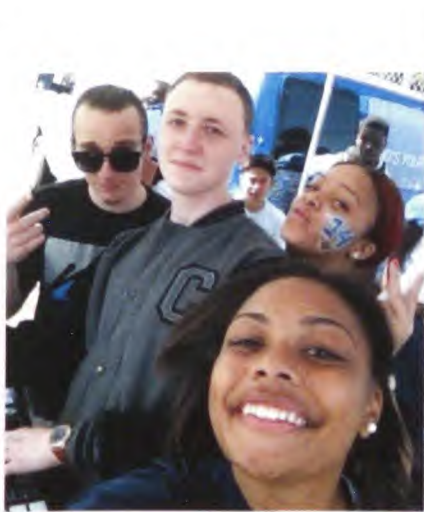

Bump in the Road

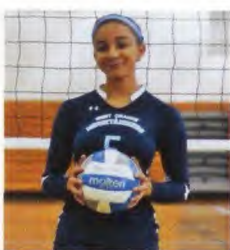

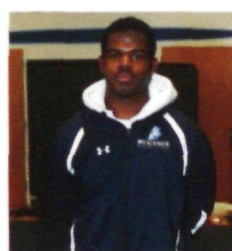

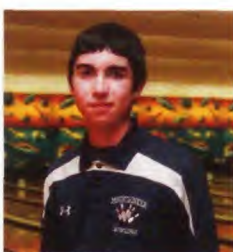

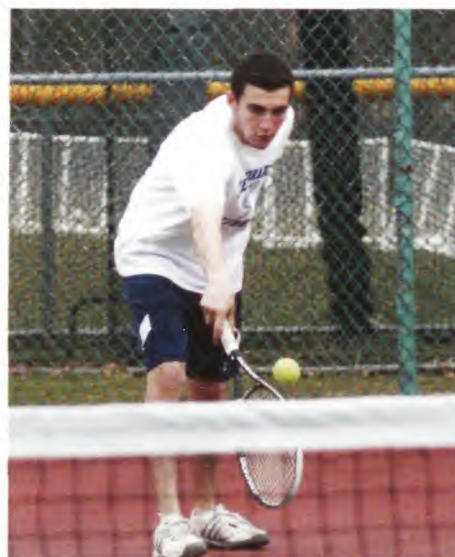
The King's Court

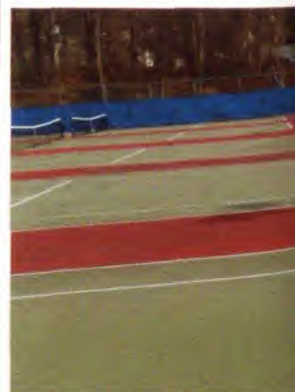
