

Services Planned For Thursday To Observe Memorial Day Here

Town-Wide Commemoration Will Be Jointly Sponsored By Veteran's Organizations In Services At War Memorial, Rutgers Bridge

Town-wide Memorial Day services will be held here on Thursday at the War Memorial on Union Avenue opposite Tiona Avenue. The services, sponsored jointly by the veteran's organization in town through the Veterans Council, will begin at 10 a.m.

A second service will be held at 11 a.m. at the Rutgers Street Bridge in honor of Navy men killed in battle. This service is also jointly sponsored by the veteran's groups.

In previous years, special Memorial Day services were held in town churches the Sunday before Memorial Day, but these have been dispensed with this year because of small attendance.

This year's services are being headed by a joint Memorial Day Committee composed of members from the various posts participating. Chairman is Patrick Tomassulo, who is serving as head of the Veterans Council. Other committee members helping to plan the event are Mrs. P. J. Tomassulo, Mrs. Vincent Vecchione, Arthur Sharrock, Henry Flagg, and John F. Casey, all past commanders of American Legion Post No. 1057.

Other committee members include Mrs. Francis MacKinnon, secretary of the Veterans Council; Richard Fodor, James Lee, and Casper Siciliano, all of VFW Post No. 275; Vincent Vecchione, of the Barbone-Mosco Post, No. 1057; and John F. Casey, all past commanders of American Legion Post No. 1057.

Residents serving on the re-arranging committee are Mrs. Fred Singer, Mrs. Arthur Sharrock, Mrs. W. Weiss, Mrs. Doris May Rose, and Mrs. Elizabeth Landy. The program at the Union Avenue Memorial will begin with singing by the Mothering Choir from St. Peter's Church, and the Rutgers Street service will be headed by the Rutgers Street Band.

posite directions on the freeway. From opposite Holmes Street to the end of the project, the freeway will be bordered on its outer edges by 10-foot wide hard surfaced shoulders and the center mail will be widened to 10 feet for a major portion of the total distance.

The mainline roadway pavement throughout the project will be reinforced concrete, 9 inches thick, constructed on a 12-inch granular subgrade. The roadway shoulders will be bituminous treated.

Where existing streets are reconstructed or relocated, the pavement will consist of a 7-inch base of broken stone surfaced with bituminous concrete, all constructed on a 12-inch thick subgrade base.

There will be ramp connections between Main Street and the southbound freeway roadway opposite Terry Street. Another ramp will connect the northbound freeway lanes with Main Street at the foot of Little Street.

man's Club, he said he hoped to see many improvements in all facets of town government in the coming year, especially the establishment of a Planning Board for better immediate development and for long range re-development. Belleville can only expand so far, then we must re-develop and only a Planning Board composed of high caliber, uncommitted citizens can do this very important task, he had stated.

In a later talk to the Lion's Club, Padula also mentioned the establishment of a Planning Board, pointing out to the men that just as no business concern can reach its highest potential without a pattern of planned operation, so a city must have agencies to synchronize, rather than collide, so must the operation of any town-agency be synchronized to a pattern of planning.

Rev. Menegus was born on May 13, 1904 in Passaic, the son of

John Menegus and Frances Julianna Menegus. At the time he was four years old, together with his father, mother, brothers and sisters, they travelled to Italy and resided at 3 a. m. Vito di Cadore, Provincia Belluno. They remained there for three years and during this time the young boy received his first Holy Communion and received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The family returned to America when Rev. Menegus was a seven years old and he entered the public schools of Clifton, where the family was then residing. He graduated from public school in 1919. In 1920, he matriculated at Seton Hall College. In September of 1927, he entered the newly opened diocesan seminary of the Immaculate Conception at Darlington.

On June 13, 1928 the degree of Bachelor of Arts was conferred upon him and in 1930 the degree of Master of Arts, both by Seton Hall College.

He was ordained a priest by his bishop, the late Rev. Thomas Joseph Walsh, then Bishop of Newark, on May 21, 1932 at St. Patrick's Cathedral.

Father Menegus celebrated his first solemn mass at the Church of the Sacred Heart, his parish church, where he was baptized and later served as an altar boy for many years.

His first assignment was at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish in Newark. He remained there for five years.

In 1937, Father Menegus was sent to Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in Jersey City, as an ad-

ministrator for three months, during the illness of the Pastor, the Late Right Reverend Monsignor Ernest Monteleone. After the recovery of the Pastor, Father Menegus remained in that parish as an assistant.

On May 26, 1940, Archbishop Walsh appointed Father Menegus administrator to the St. Anthony of Padua Parish, Belleville, to be the successor of Father Cataldo Alessi. Father Menegus assumed the duties of his new assignment on June 1, 1940. On his arrival, he found the parish had a beautiful new church which was opened not quite a year. Little did he know that it was totally unprepared for the registration of the ticket. On May 11, 1944 his Excellency Archbishop Walsh, raised him from administrator to Pastor of the St. Anthony parish. During the years from 1940 to 1952, Father Menegus paid the total debt of \$115,000 of the parish, besides paying for the improvements made, such as interior decoration of the church, installation of public address system in church, installation of chimes in the church tower, electrification of the church bells, erection of new stations of the Cross, complete change of church lights and fixtures, and many more constructive changes. He purchased with a loan for \$10,000 a three and one-half acre tract of land for the parochial school and also purchased six lots for the church parking area.
