

■ An attempted burglary of a garage was reported on Saturday, Dec. 4 at 9 p.m. A resident of Gerardo Street reported that he found that someone was tampering with his garage door, especially around the lock area. Entry was not gained.

■ An investigation of burglary and theft took place on Saturday, Dec. 4 after a resident at Branch Brook Apartments reported that

He was charged with aggravated assault, possession of weapon and possession of weapon for unlawful purposes. Bail was set for \$250,000. Suspect was transferred to Essex County Jail.

■ Police arrested a driver for DWI and possession of marijuana on Tuesday, Nov. 30 at 11 p.m. Someone reported a motor vehicle accident involving a dark colored station wagon at the corner of Hornblower Avenue and Holm Street. Police stopped the green Ford Taurus station wagon and found that the driver was under the influence and struck two parked cars at the intersection. Police also

found a bag of marijuana on him. Daniel Terrault, 19, of Boonton was charged with DWI, leaving the scene of an accident, and careless driving. He was held on a \$250,000 bail bond, which he made.

■ A Belleville High School student was found in possession of marijuana on the school premises on Tuesday, Nov. 30 at 9 a.m. He was attending class and asked to use the bathroom, as he walked past the teacher, he dropped a bag of marijuana on the floor. The school resource officer is handling the case internally. Michael Armstrong, 18, was charged with possession of a controlled substance, released on his own recognizance and is awaiting a court date.
