Nutley man admits to string of robberies

A former Essex County Sheriff's officer and longtime Nutley resident was arrested two weeks ago for a string of area bank robberies over the past year.

Livingston police, with the assistance of the Essex County Sheriff's office and the FBI arrested Harry E. Schnitzer, 61, on the evening of Jan. 26, at his Nutley home after he robbed a Livingston bank earlier that morning.

Livingston Police Lt. Craig Handschuch recognized Schnitzer from the still photos taken from all angles by the surveillance camera while he was robbing the bank in Livingston.

Schnitzer appeared at U.S. District Court in Newark Jan. 28 before U.S. Magistrate Madeline Cox Arleo after the FBI signed a complaint charging him with four bank robberies and one attempted robbery.

In a statement to authorities, Schnitzer admitted to entering a

Clifton Savings Bank on June 17 2004 wearing a fisherman's cap and dark sunglasses and demanding money from the teller saying he had a gun in his pocket. The teller complied and handed over \$3,800. About six minutes later, he replaced his fisherman's hat with a white baseball cap, crossed the street to PNC Bank, demanded money from a teller, and walked out with \$4,842, according to the United States Attorney's office which is handling the case.

He resurfaced on Jan. 10 at Valley National Bank on Route 46 in Clifton, walking up to a teller who told him she was closed for lunch and he should go to another window. Schnitzer exited the bank empty-handed.

On Jan. 18, Schnitzer entered another Valley National Bank in North Arlington wearing a baseball hat and sunglasses and carrying a white plastic bag. He told the teller at the window, "I have a gun. Give me all your money." He walked out of the bank with \$5,077 in cash inside the white bag,

according to federal authorities.

On the morning of Jan. 26, Schnitzer robbed a Valley National Bank in Livingston, going away with about \$500. Moments later, a Livingston police officer bumped into him at an office building across the street from the bank. It was later revealed that he had hidden the stolen cash and clothing he wore during the robbery in an unused bathroom shower stall, said Handschuch.

Authorities are also still investigating the robbery of a bank in Rutherford that occurred in May, said FBI special agent John Conway.

Schnitzer started out at the Essex County Sheriff's Department in 1981. He was suspended in 2002 for stealing a radio at Bradlees and threatening to shoot the security guard who stopped him in the store. When he left the sheriff's department, he was a lieutenant in charge of auto theft, a position to which Essex County Sheriff Armando Fontoura had promoted him.

"Up until that time he was a model employee, a good worker," said Fontoura. "And then Harry lost it. We don't know what happened."

Fontoura said he thinks difficul-

ties at home contributed to Schnitzer's erratic behavior. He and his wife signed complaints against each other for domestic violence before they finally divorced.

Schnitzer posed no resistance when authorities came to get him at his house last week.

"I think that he knew he was in trouble this time and he was expecting it," said Handschuch.

After his court appearance on Friday, Schnitzer was remanded to U.S. Marshals and put into federal custody.

There is usually some jail time involved with bank robberies, the maximum penalty being 25 years, said Conway.

"Bank robbery is considered a violent crime. There is a threat that was taken there," he said, adding that one of the Clifton tellers sustained a minor heart attack afterwards from fright.

But Conway surmises that due to no prior criminal record, there will probably be a plea agreement worked out and everything will be wrapped up in one charge.

Some local authorities who

knew Schnitzer are still in shock after learning about his cop-turned-bank-robber story.

"It's very painful for me to hear—it's such dramatic and erratic behavior, I can't believe it," said Nutley Commissioner Carmen Orechio who knew Schnitzer for about a dozen years. "Ever since the incident at Bradlees, that to me was a sign that something went haywire with him."

Orechio had known Schnitzer from when he was president of the Nutley Democrats and from going to the same church, Holy Family.

"It's sad and tragic that something like this has happened," added Police Chief John Holland.

Holland knew Schnitzer from his visits to the police station and taking part in local functions. He remembers him as a very quiet, mild mannered and reserved individual, the total opposite of what his recent actions revealed.

"It leads you to wonder what's really going on here," said Holland.

ASPIRIN TO THE RESCUE, AGAIN

Aspirin, once again, comes up a winner when it comes to treating a serious cardiovascular problem. 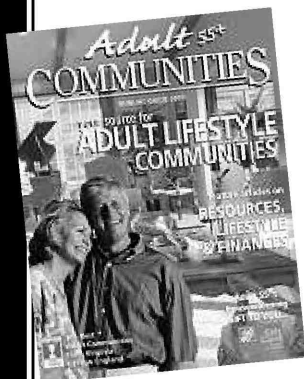

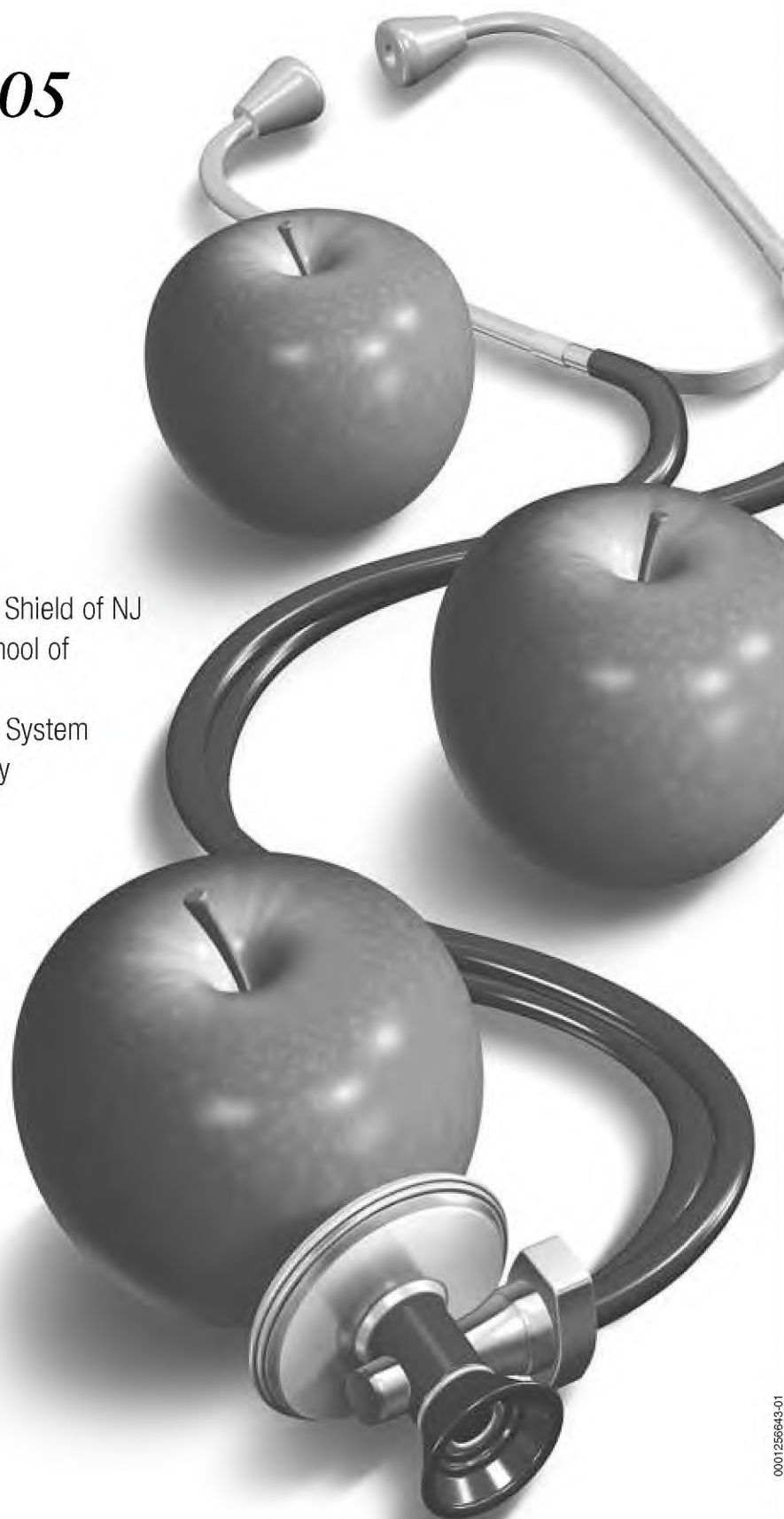
