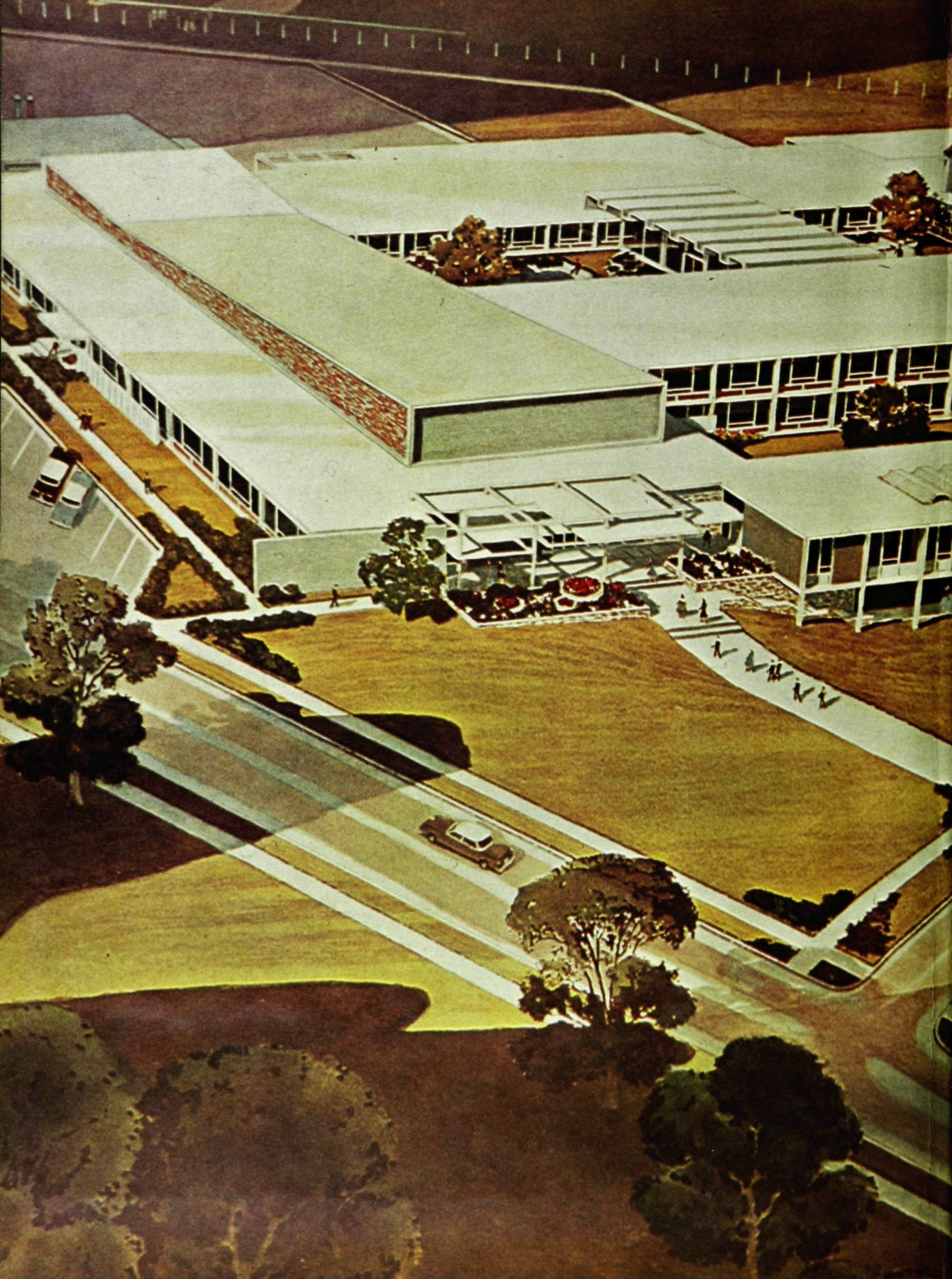

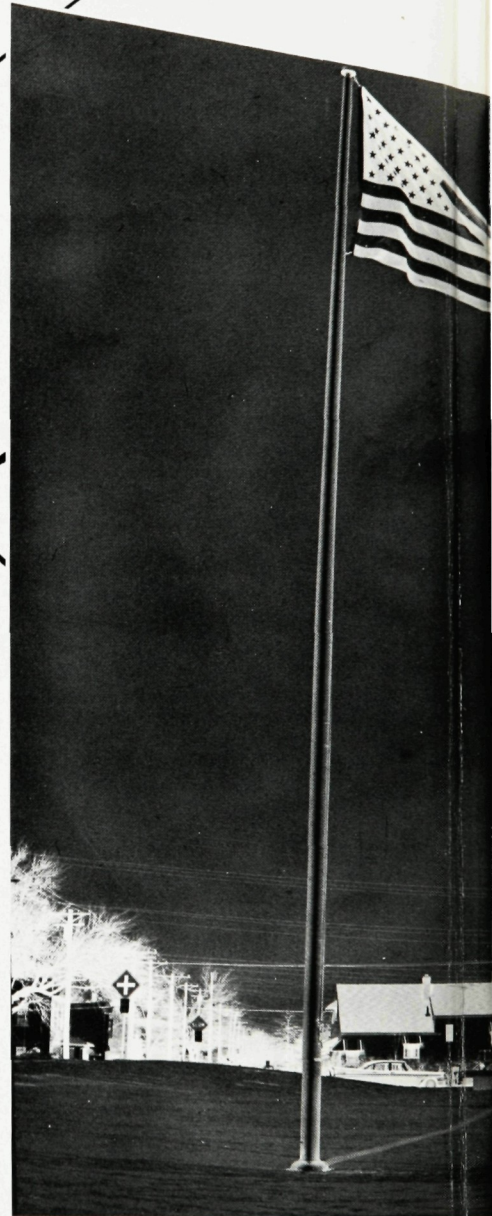

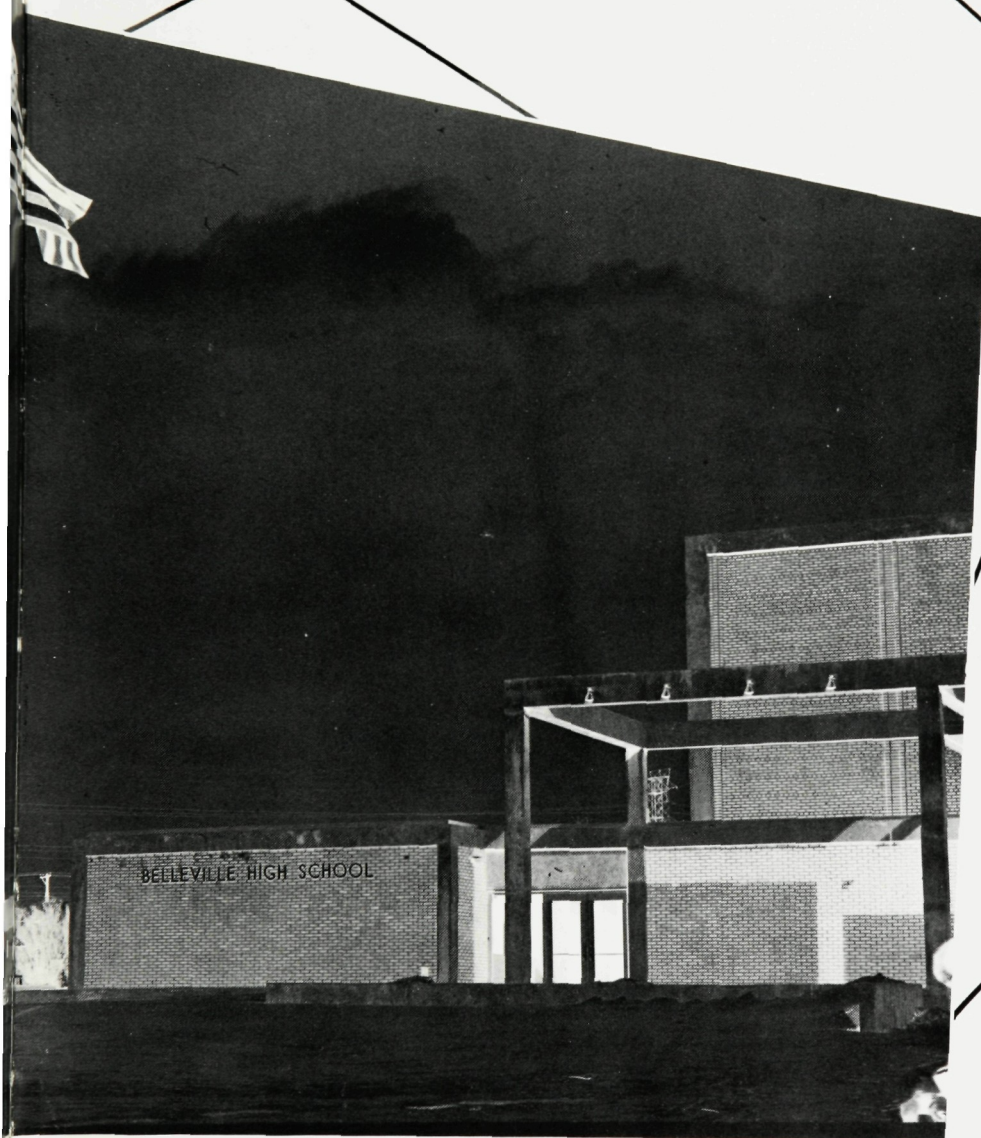

After Years of Service



MR. P. WEBSTER DIEHL

After thirty-three years of service in the Belleville school system, Mr. P. Webster Diehl, head of the Art Department, retired this year. Coming to Belleville in 1932 as art supervisor, Mr. Diehl organized the entire art curriculum for all Belleville schools.

Mr. Diehl attended the Academy of Fine Arts in Philadelphia and received a Bachelor and Master's degrees in art and administration at the Pennsylvania State College. Afterwards, he went on to the University of Pittsburgh for extra courses.

Mr. Diehl now holds a supervising principal certificate in Pennsylvania, an eligibility certificate as superintendent of schools in Pennsylvania, and a general supervisor certificate in New Jersey. He spent four years as an art supervisor in the suburbs of Pittsburgh and six years as principal of schools in Maryland and Pennsylvania.

Mr. Diehl's paintings have been exhibited in places such as the Kaufman Gallery in Pittsburgh and Radio City in

New York. He has also been invited to exhibit his works at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. The governor of New Jersey requested that he send some of his paintings to an exchange exhibit between the United States and Europe.

Mr. Diehl has won many awards for his works including first prize in oils at the Bedford Exhibit, first and second prize at the California Art Institute, and he has been selected by the assistant state superintendent of schools as a member of the state scholastic committee on art. In 1938, Mr. Diehl was honored with the Waterman Award for redesigning their fountain pens.

In addition to these various awards and positions he has received, Mr. Diehl is a member of the National NEA Art Association and other state and local associations.

After retiring, Mr. Diehl will move to Pennsylvania, where he will be art consultant for two national manufacturing companies. The Class of 1965 wishes him as much luck in his future as he has had in the past.



Introduction

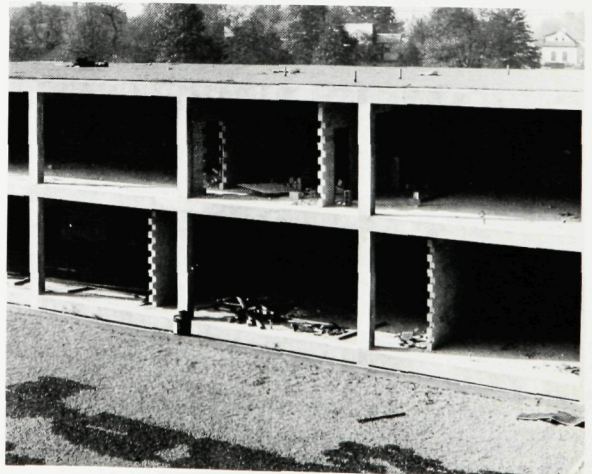
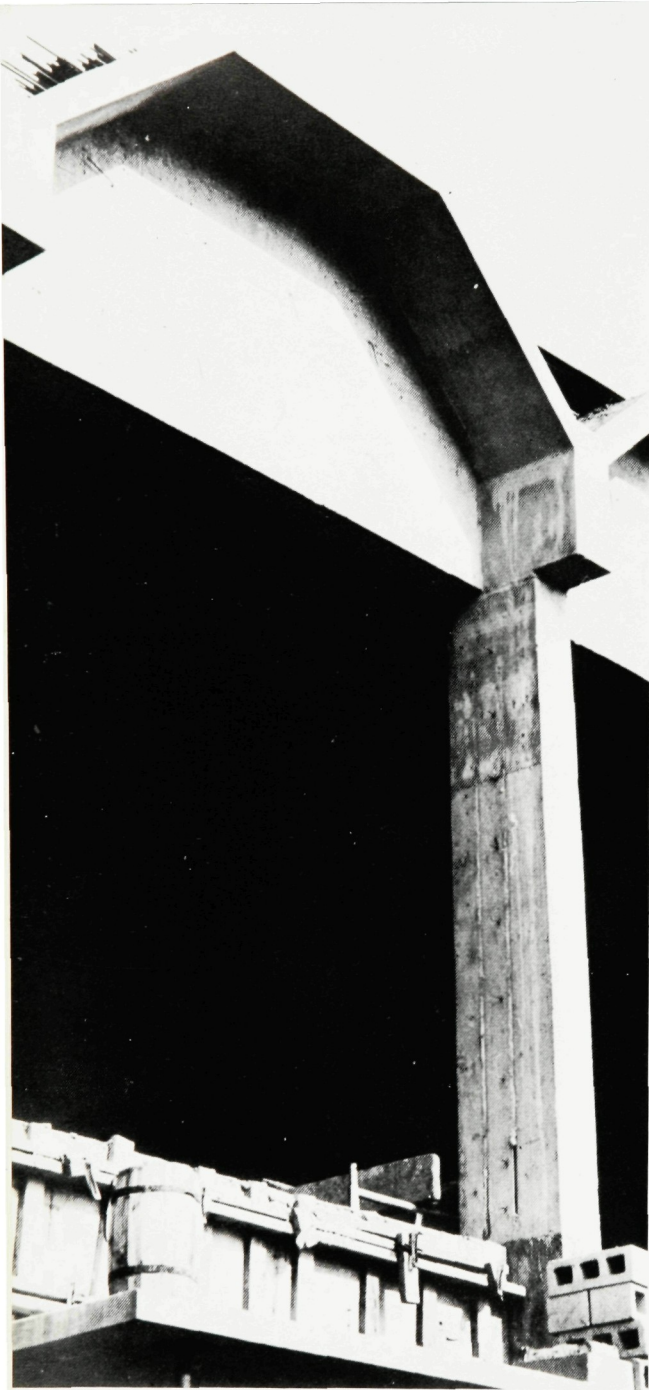

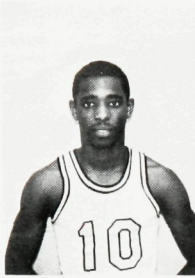

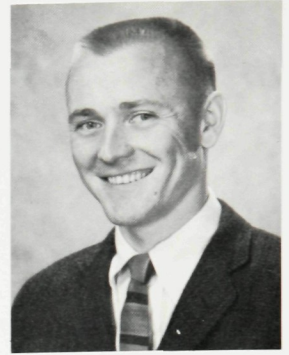
The various musical groups have performed in the grammar schools, the junior high school, and in various assemblies in our own school. This year, a series of monthly musicales have been initiated by the Music Department.
