CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION

Co-Operative Education combines in-school training with on-the-job experience. Students are supervised by teacher-coordinators and evaluated by both their coordinator and employer. Three credits are received for the on-the-job training and the work-related class in school.

The Cooperative Education Department is divided into three programs: distributive education, industrial education and office education. These programs enable students to gain experience and earn money at the same time.



ENGLISH

New courses were added to the English Department's curriculum in nineteen seventy-five. Creative Writing, Contemporary Periodicals, Everyday English, Development of Drama and Survey in Mass Communications were offered for the first time as mini courses. The Student Publications class produced the Monad, while the Journalism and Creative Writing Classes combined to create the Emanon, a collection of student literary works.

The English Department, headed by Mr. Leonard Marciano, was involved in many programs, including a committee evaluation of the department itself. Reading Fundamentals were taught as the New Approach Program began. Members of the English staff wrote a circular curriculum for grades ten through twelve, helped evaluate state reading assessment tests and supervised plays.

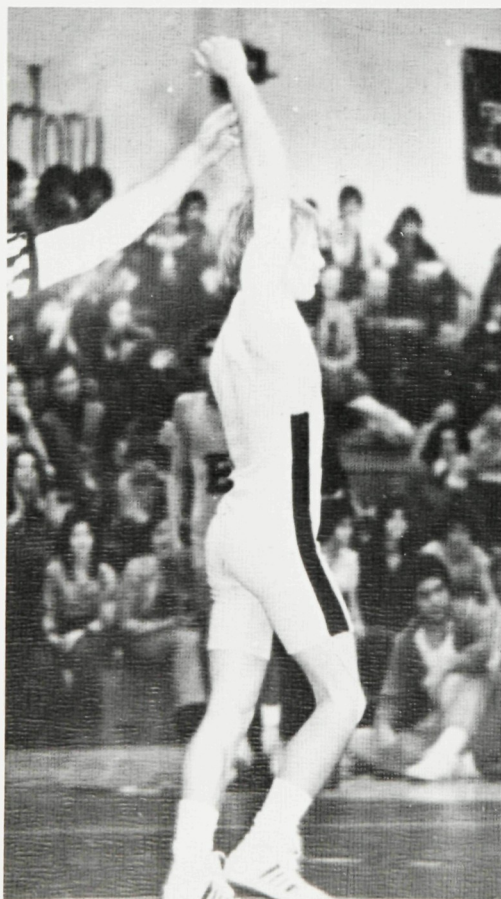

A SEASON OF HONOR

The 1974-75 Wrestling Team closed their season with an excellent record of 13 wins and 2 losses. Although they opened with a loss to Becton (20-24), the Matmen captured outstanding victories over some of top teams in the area; one being a win over Essex Catholic, which had remained unbeaten by Belleville for many years. Rated first in the region, Belleville took on Pascack Hills, also rated first in their respective region. The grapplers season came to a close with this loss, 21-28.

Belleville has received almost every possible title available this year. In December they placed second in the Bloomfield Holiday Tournament. The Matmen also took second in the Essex County Coaches Tournament, in which sixteen other teams participated. The Wrestling Team captured the Big Ten Championship and were again District Champs by defeating a second place Essex Catholic and third place Lyndhurst. Eight wrestlers qualified for the N.J. Regional Championship. There, Belleville achieved the honor of Regional Champs. Coach Jim Silvestri received the well-deserved honor of "Coach of the Year." Regional winners, Carl Arlt and Vinny Mustacchio, traveled to the State Championships in Princeton. Belleville High School Wrestling Team has been rated 15th in the 340 schools in New Jersey.

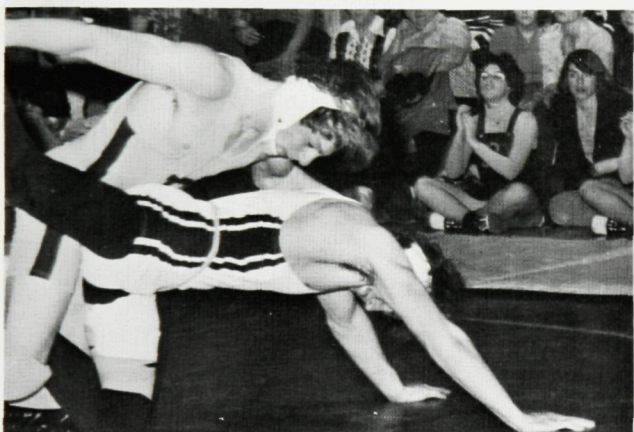

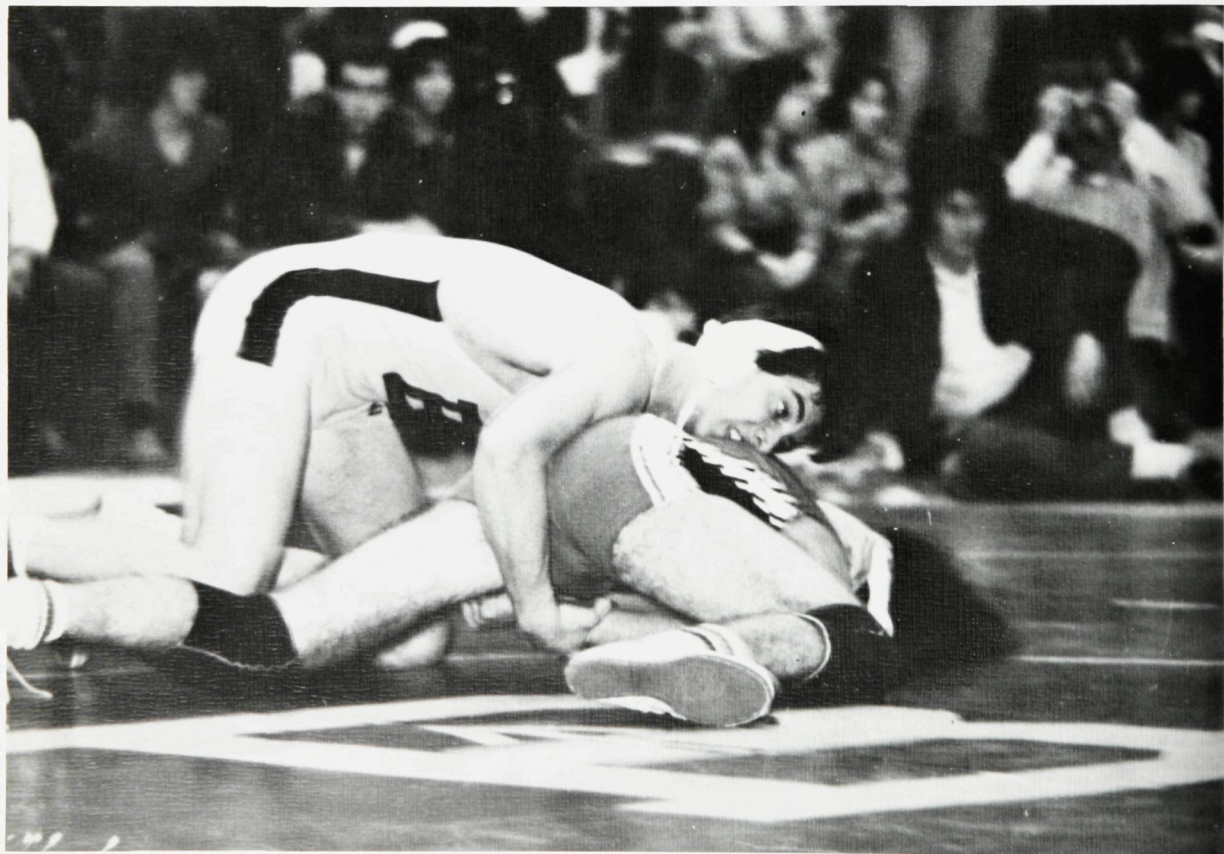

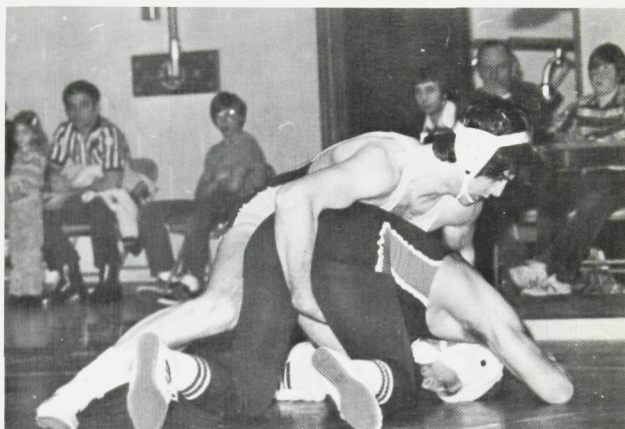

Again, congratulations to you, your parents, and your school on the distinction you have gained. You may well find that the honor of being selected will have a lasting value in the years ahead.

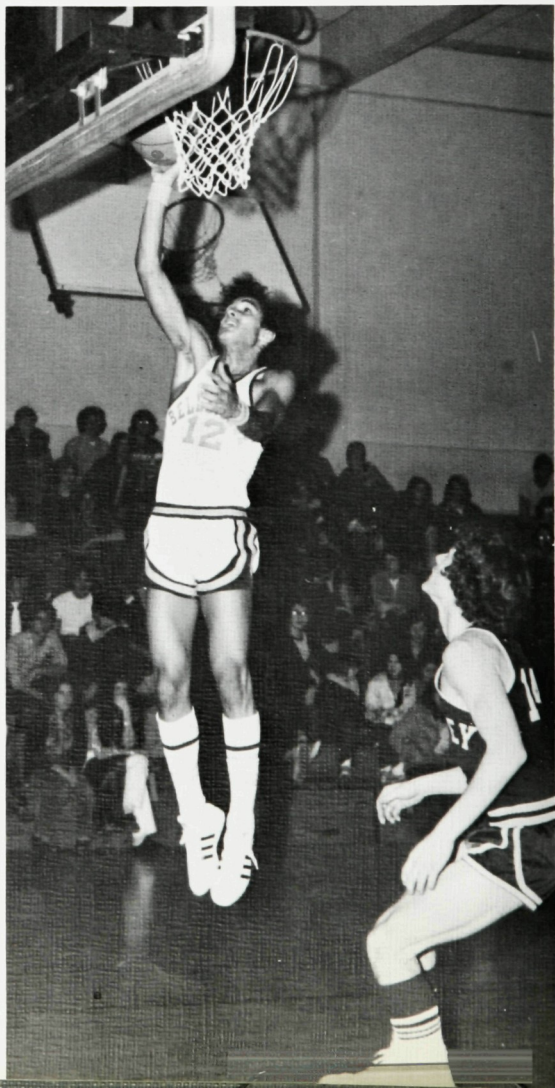

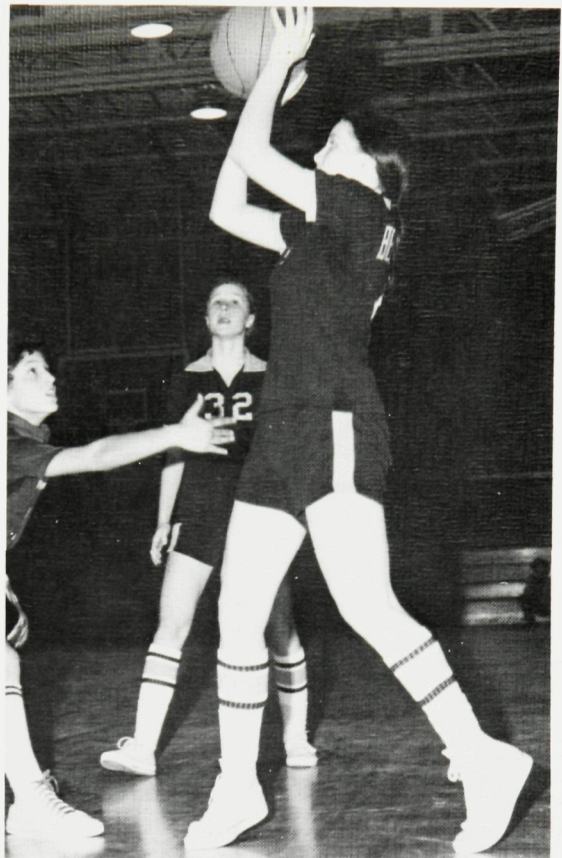

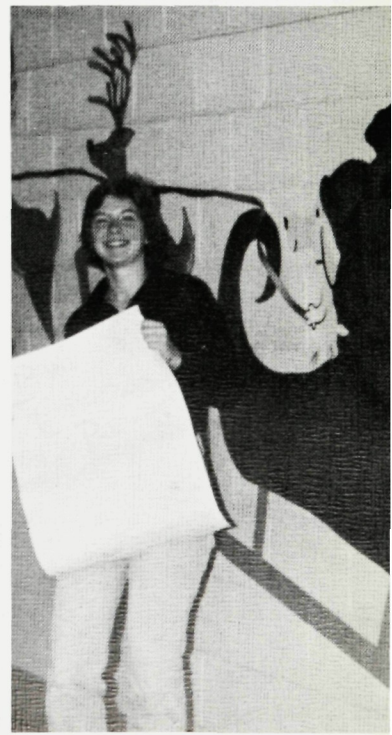
“THE PARTY’S OVER” JUST BEGUN . . .

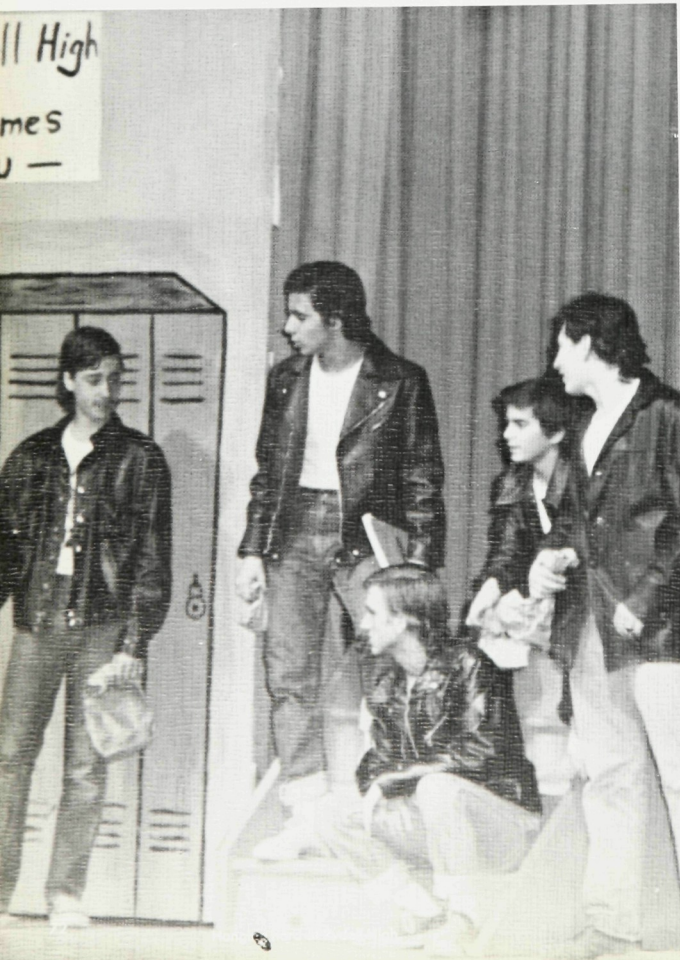

SKI CLUB

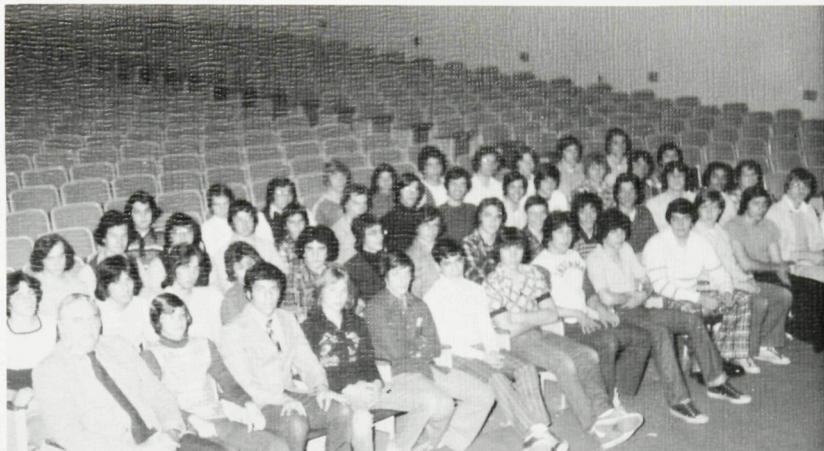

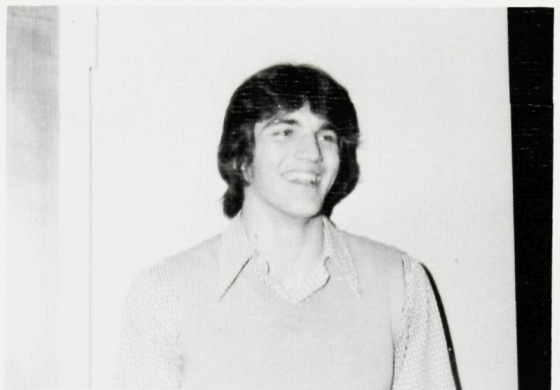

The staff participated in some diversified activities such as jaunts to the Palisades and graveyards at the crack of dawn to capture a sunrise shot.

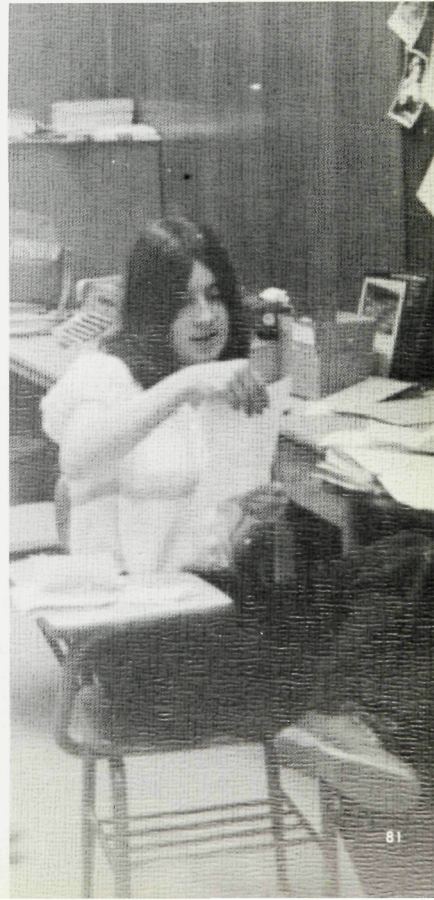
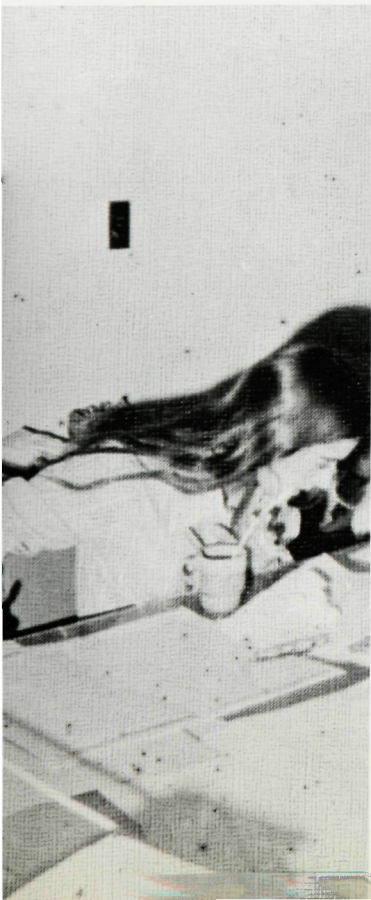
