MISTURA GLYCYRRHIZÆ COMPOSITA.

W. L. Stephen says (*Am. Jr. Ph.*) a preparation affording no sediment whatever may be made by thoroughly mixing $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. each of powdered acacia, powd. extract of licorice, and powd. sugar; rub up to a paste with 6 ozs water, and heat in an evaporating dish till perfectly fluid. Then add $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. spirits of nitrous ether, 1 oz. wine of antimony, 2 ozs. paregoric, and enough water to make 12 fl. ozs.

And he who is unfortunate at first must persevere, and will doubtless be as thoroughly successful at the end of his probationary period, as he was unsuccessful at the beginning. J. H. C.—By "tasteless" castor oil is usually understood a castor oil which has been sweetened, or rendered more palatable by the aid of some such substance as garantose. A suitable formula for a preparation would be as follows:

Alcohol	4	fl. dr.
Garantose	12	grn.
Oil Peppermint (or Cassia)	20	min.
Castor Oil	1	pint

Spermaceti	2¼	ozs.
Camphor	4	drs.
Expr. Oil Almond.....	13	fl. drs.
Benzoic Acid	5	grs.
Lanum	4	drs.

Melt the fats together, and add the oil, in which the camphor has previously been dissolved by the aid of gentle heat. Add the benzoic acid, keeping the mixture at all times as cool as practicable to prevent volatilization. Perfume according to taste.

Boroglycerin Cream.

2—Boric Acid	30	grs.
Glycerin	2½	fl. drs.
Water	75	min.
Expr. Oil Almond	3	fl. drs.
Lanum	9	drs.
Oil Rose.....	to perfume.	

Carbolic Ointment.

3—Carbolic Acid	15	grs.
Distilled Water	5	fl. drs.
Ungt. Mollæ (Form. 34)....	5	ozs.

Dissolve the acid in the water and incorporate with the ointment-base.

(A yellowish-white, smooth ointment.)

Cold-Cream.

4—Borax	110	grs.
Powdered Soap	4	drs.
Cocoanut Oil.....	6	drs.
Rose Water	20	fl. ozs.
Lanum	14	drs.
Oil Bergamot	8	drops
Oil Neroli	8	drops

Oil Orris	1	drop

Triturate the first four ingredients together until well mixed, then gradually add the rose-water, which has been previously warmed, stirring constantly, and add the oils.

Toilet Milk (Dieterich).

30—Soap (medicinal)	4	grs.

Tincture Benzoin	15	min.
Lanum	1¼	drs.

Dissolve the soap with the aid of heat in about 3 drs. of the distilled water, and incorporate with the lanum, previously rubbed up with about 2 drs. of the water; then gradually add the remainder of the water, and finally the tincture of benzoin.

Toothache Wax.

31—Yellow Wax	24	grs.
Powd. Opium.....	15	grs.

Powd. Pyrethrum.....	15	grs.
Lanum	8	grs.
Oil Cajeput.....	3	drops

Make into 100 pills, and dust with powdered cloves.

Turpentine Liniment.

32—Oil Turpentine.....	2	fl. ozs.
Distilled Water.....	7	fl. ozs.
Lanum	1	oz.

Dissolve the lanum in an emulsion mortar in half the turpentine oil, gradually add the water, and then admix the remainder of the oil in small quantities at a time,

(A homogeneous, thick, milky liniment.)

Unguentum Durum (Hard Ointment-base).

33—Paraffin	10	drs.
Liquid Paraffin	12½	fl. drs.
Lanum	2½	drs.

Melt the paraffins together at a gentle heat, add the lanum, and run the cooled product through an ointment milk. In default of the latter, the warm ointment should be stirred uninterruptedly until completely cooled.

DIRECTIONS for PEPTONISING MILK

WITH

EXTRACTUM PANCREATIS.

PRECISE DIRECTIONS.

Into a clean quart bottle put the peptonising powder (of 2 grains of Extractum Pancreatis and 15 grains of the carbonate of Soda), and a gill of cool water. Shake; then add a pint of fresh cool milk.

Place the bottle in water so hot that the whole hand can be held in it without discomfort for a minute, and keep the bottle there for exactly 30 minutes. At the end of that time put the bottle *on ice*, to check further digestion and keep the milk from spoiling.

EXPLANATORY.

The degree of digestion is very simply regulated by the length of time in which the milk is kept warm.

When the milk is digested so long that it acquires a slightly bitter taste, it is because the caseine has been entirely digested into peptone. It is the taste of the peptone.

It is very rarely necessary to carry the peptonising to the bitter point, and should not be done unless so ordered by the physician.

PARTIALLY peptonised milk has no bitter taste—has, indeed, little apparent evidence of any change.

After the contents of the bottle get warm, then every moment lessens the amount of the caseine—the ingredient which is the obstacle to the use of the milk.

The degree of peptonising necessary in each case, is best determined by the readiness with which it is assimilated by the patient.

Great heat destroys, or cold stops, the digestive action.

It must be borne in mind that this is not a cooking or chemical process. The object is to subject the milk to the action of the digestive principle (the Extract Pancreatis) at a temperature similar to that of the body.

Always use *fresh sweet* milk.

Peptonised milk may be sweetened to taste, or used for *rum*, etc., or made into jelly; also in the *most* such foods as ordinarily require the use of *the* to the instructions of the physician.

Sodium bicarbonate.....	oz. 20
Chlorinated lime.....	oz. 1
Common salt.....	oz. 1

Mix well and apply with a soft brush. A very small quantity of the solution is sufficient for effecting the desired purpose, and it may be used either cold or lukewarm. Plain articles may be brightened equal to new by putting a spot or two of the liquid upon them from the stopper of the bottle, and lightly brushing over the surface with fine tissue paper until sufficiently dried off to accomplish the object intended.
