


X-Country . . . Crossing



Although only three starting positions are returning next year, the team has a lot of potential and is expected to have another great season next year.










The Junior Varsity team, led by Scott Friedman, finished nicely with a First Place in the Counties.










The swim team swam their way to a winning season with the record of 9-7.
























































































Colophon
