Housing Proposal Delayed

The planning board has decided to take more time to study the new townhouses that have been proposed for 30 Springfield Ave. The board's site plan review advisory committee will meet with applicants for the eight townhouse units to clarify differences of opinion over cartlines between the plan and zoning ordinances. The review board consists of the township engineer, Gregory Sgroi, tax assessor, John Duray, and consultant Harvey Moskowitz. Planning board chairman, Dinah Stevens is not a member of the review board as reported in the Chronicle last week. Discussions almost ended abruptly when the applicants presented a revised site plan to the full board April 19 after being told the board could not waive certain requirements. The smaller advisory committee had questioned a dozen aspects of the proposal, but the three major ones were the amount of front yard setbacks on the townhouses that extend into the backyard, and parking plans in the backyard of each of the townhouses.
