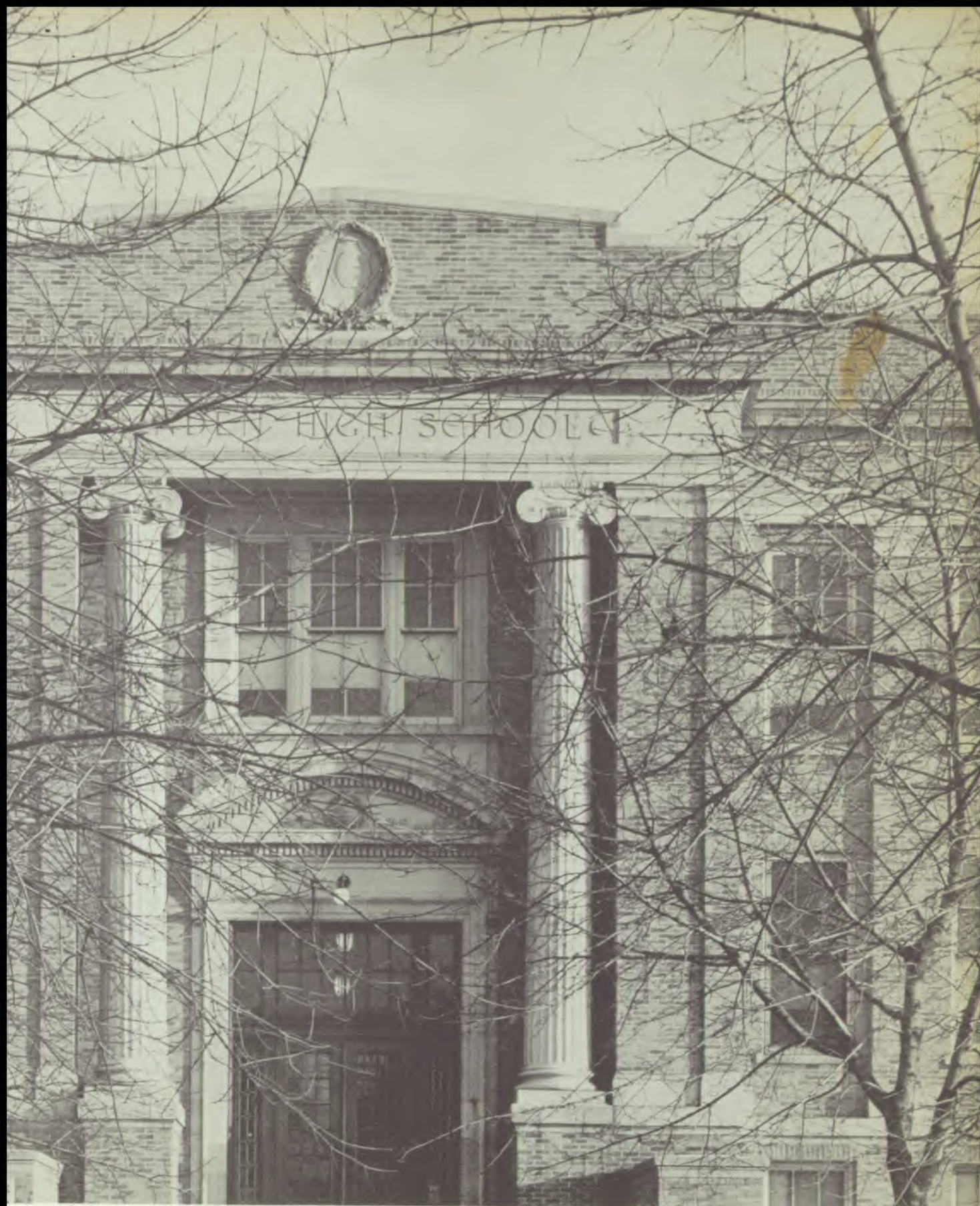
Preface

In 1910, when Linden was a small and peaceful community, its forward-looking citizens applied to the state for a high school. The school opened the following year with a total enrollment of thirty pupils. As the years passed, Linden grew and changed to a large industrial town, and Linden High School expanded and adapted itself to the new changes. The curriculum was enlarged, the staff augmented, a physical plant built and enlarged, equipment provided, and a fine library developed to meet the needs of each new generation of students. Today there are approximately 1500 students in Linden High School. There are still many changes taking place. A new wing is in the midst of construction at the rear of the school. New clubs are constantly being admitted to our already wide selection of extra-curricular activities. The future promises still more renovations to face the demands of an ever-thriving, ever-interested community.

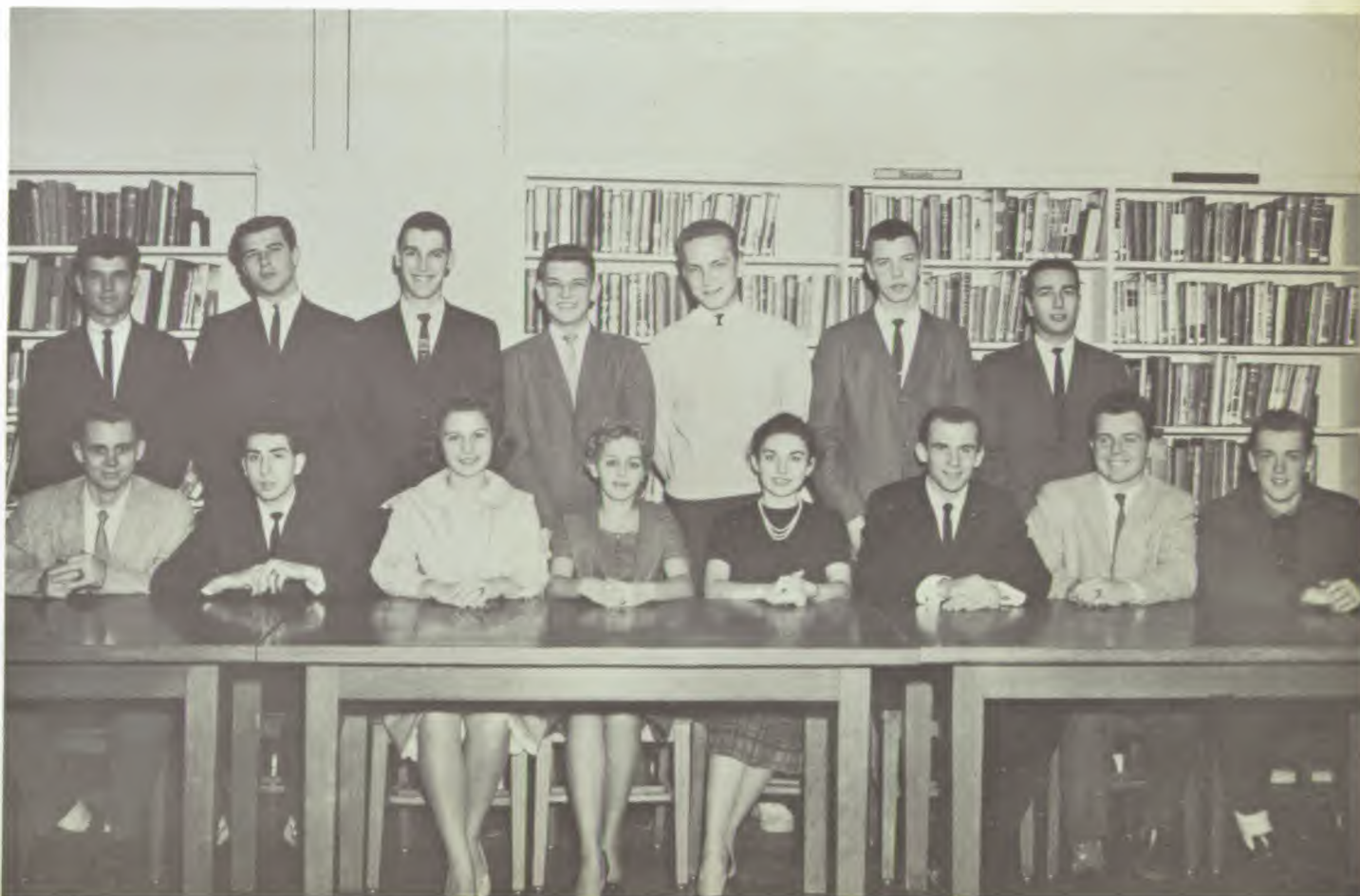

An Open Letter From Our First Principal

It was in September, 1910, that I came to Linden as the principal of a new four-year high school, and its approval by the New Jersey Department of Education came in February, 1911. The first class of three members was graduated in June, 1911.

Our first building was a temporary one and took care of an elementary school as well as the high school. The elementary school and the high school then moved to the Number 1 school building. It was in September, 1925, that the high school moved to its present building and the first class to be graduated from there was the Class of 1926. The enrollment of the high school increased so rapidly that the classes were on part time during 1931-1932, and two wings had to be added to the building.

I have always been proud of the traditions that we built. Our school spirit was remarkable. Our assemblies were of the best because our students used their talents, and people from the outside gave us unusual programs of world affairs, music, art, and drama. Gift Day became a part of the assembly at the end of the school year. At that time students showed their appreciation to the school by giving pictures, books, and many other things, and the school awarded medals and letters to those who had represented the school in various activities. Very early the library was recognized as one of the best in New Jersey, and our picture collection was outstanding among all the high schools in the United States. Our clubs took care of and developed hobbies of the students. Our publications—**Chronicle** and **Cynosure**—gave us a record of each year's important and interesting happenings at the school.

Linden High School was a pioneer in the formation of new courses in the curricula. This was done so that the courses would be adapted best to students' future needs. This would not have been possible without the work of an intelligent and devoted faculty. They spent many hours in working with committees both locally and in the state.

Linden High School was one of the first high schools in New Jersey to become a member of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. It has been approved by that accrediting agency ever since.

The Alumni and their work always have been a source of great pride to me. It is my wish and hope that they will continue to be outstanding in their homes, in the colleges, in their communities, and in the Nation.

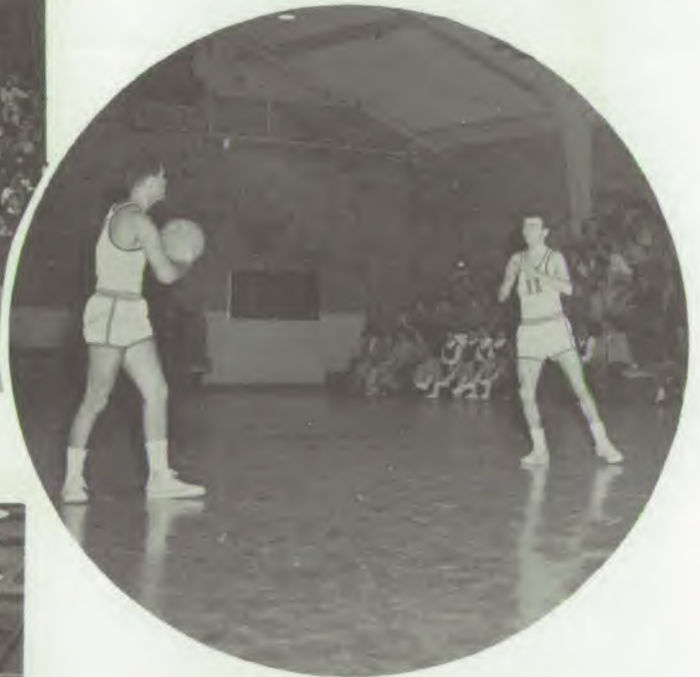

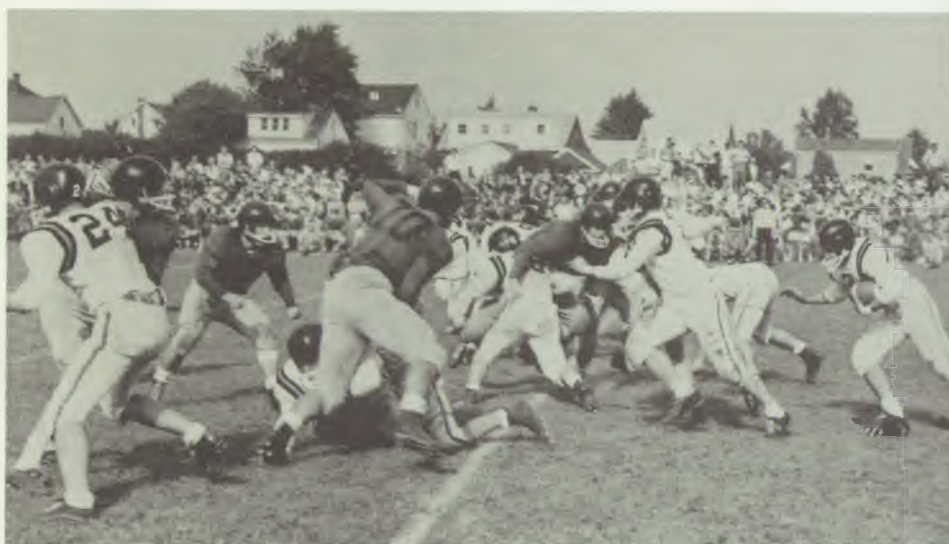

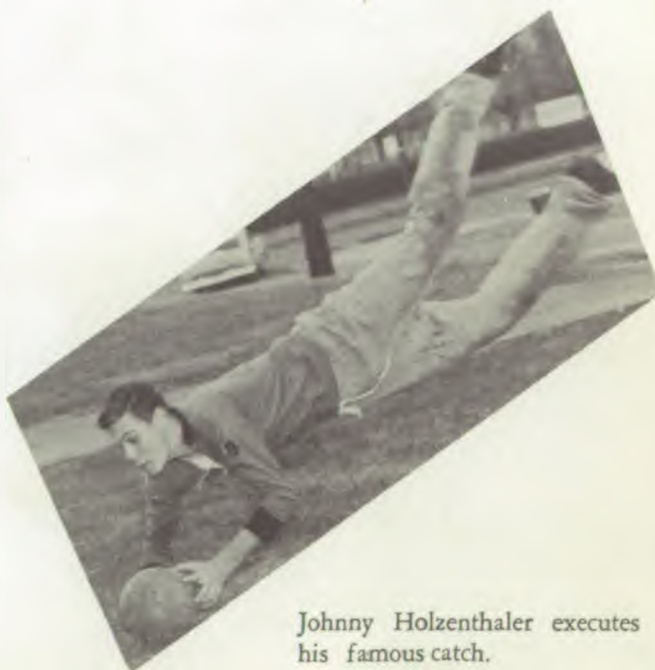
