COLOPHON — CYNOSURE

The 1987 edition of the Linden High School CYNOSURE was printed by Herff Jones Publishing Company in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, using the offset lithographic process.

Advised by Mr. Frank Foley. Volume 67 had a limited press run of 600 copies featuring 248 pages printed in black ink. A 100 lb. premium coated gloss enamel paper stock is used in the first sixty-four pages of the book. The remaining pages are 80 lb. matte finish paper stock. The endsheets are blind embossed on Vibra Color #14. In addition to the black ink used throughout, four color was utilized in eight flats.

The book is Smyth-sewn in sixteen pages signatures, trimmed to 9x12 inches, rounded and backed, and bounded on 160 point binder's board.

The Vista Custom Embossed cover design features a four color tip-on of the school mascot as well as an embossed spine which is silkscreened in Page Gold #16. The base cover material is black Vibra Tex #41075. A whirlpool grain pattern is also applied to the entire cover area. The name stampings are done in gold foil.

All captions and body copy are done in eight and ten point Garamond type. Headlines, subheads, and division pages are set in various point sizes using Garamond and Garamond Italic type faces.

Dear Graduates of the Class of '87:


