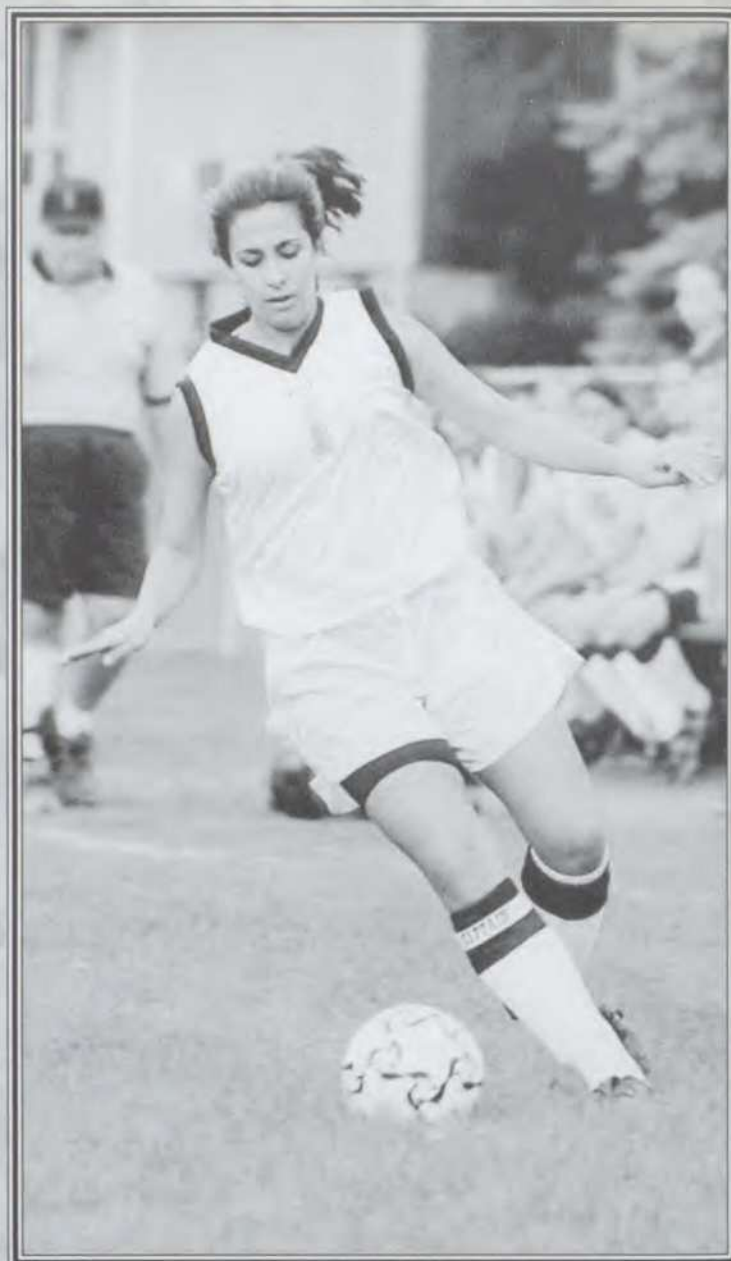

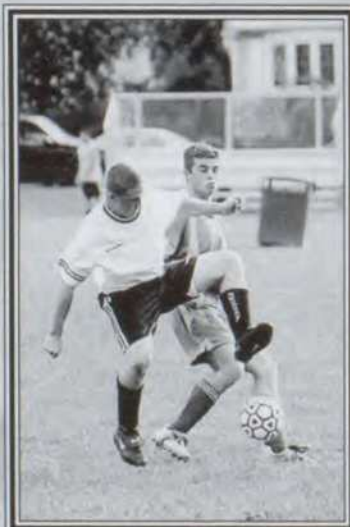

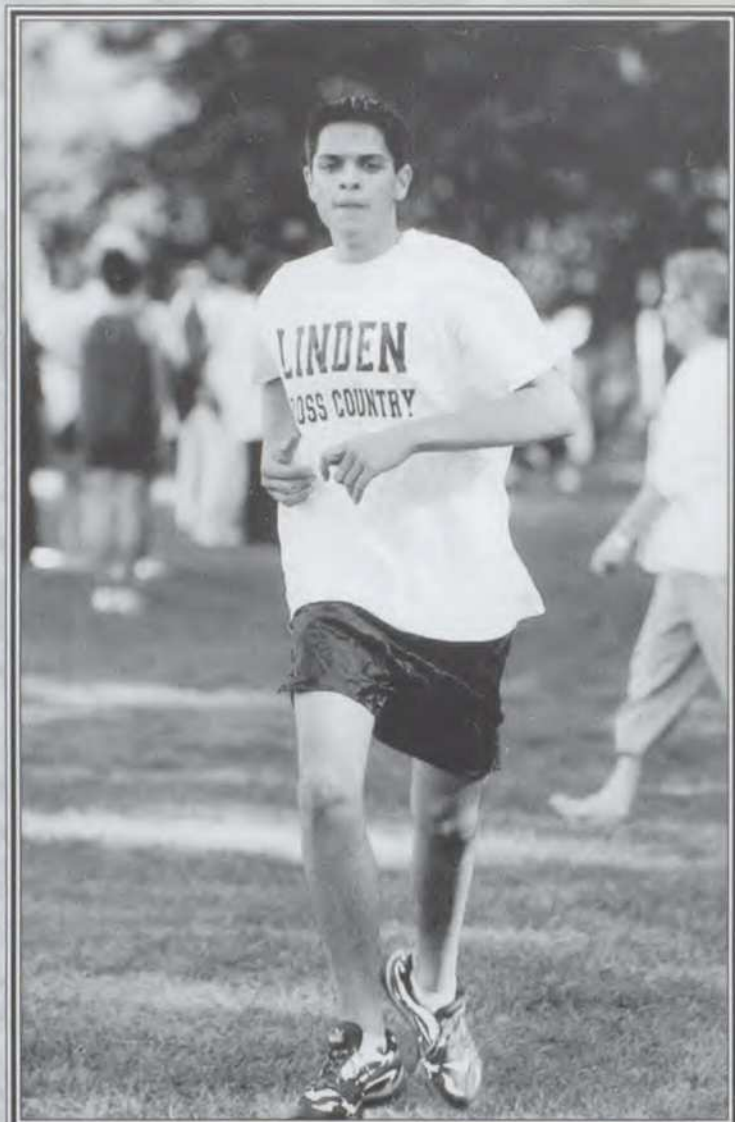

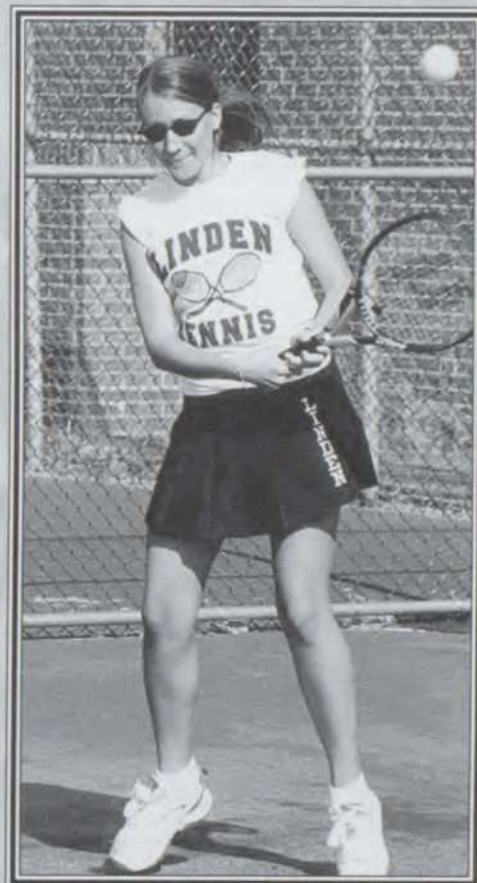

2002-2003 was a big year for girls volleyball. After playing an intramural schedule last year, the girls were ready to tackle a real varsity season this year.

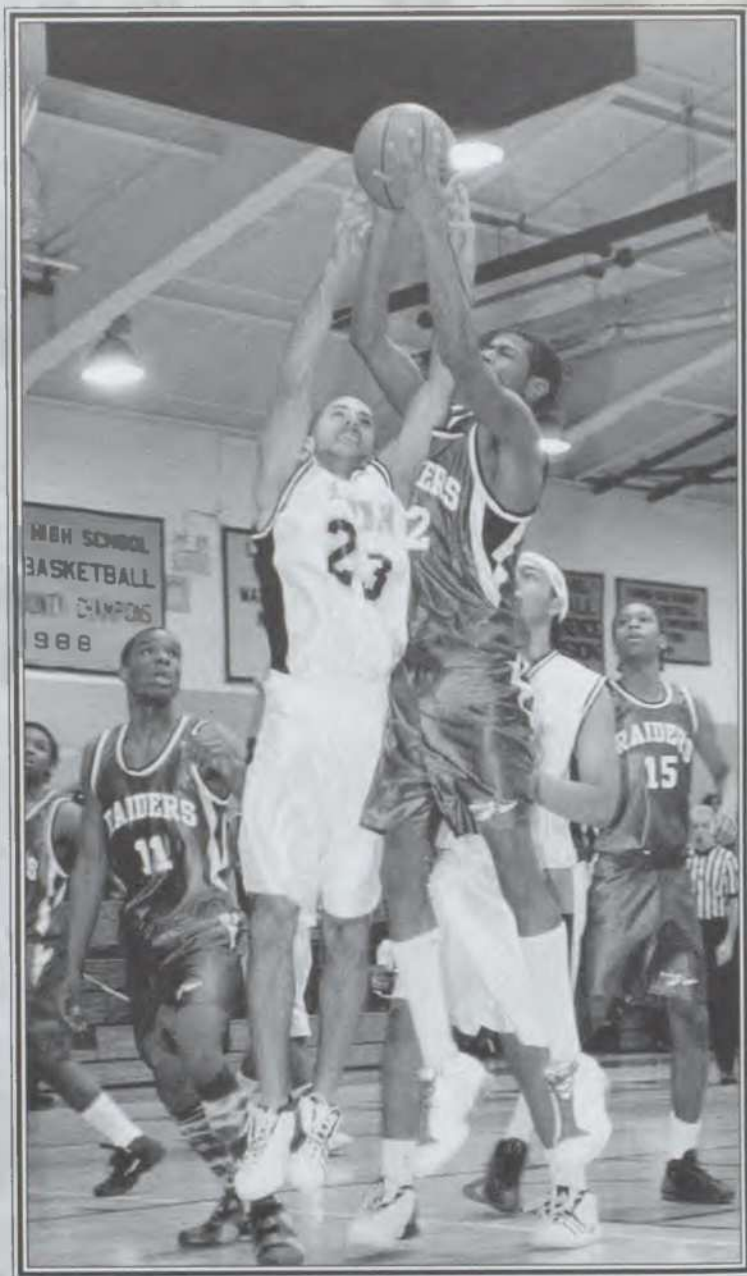

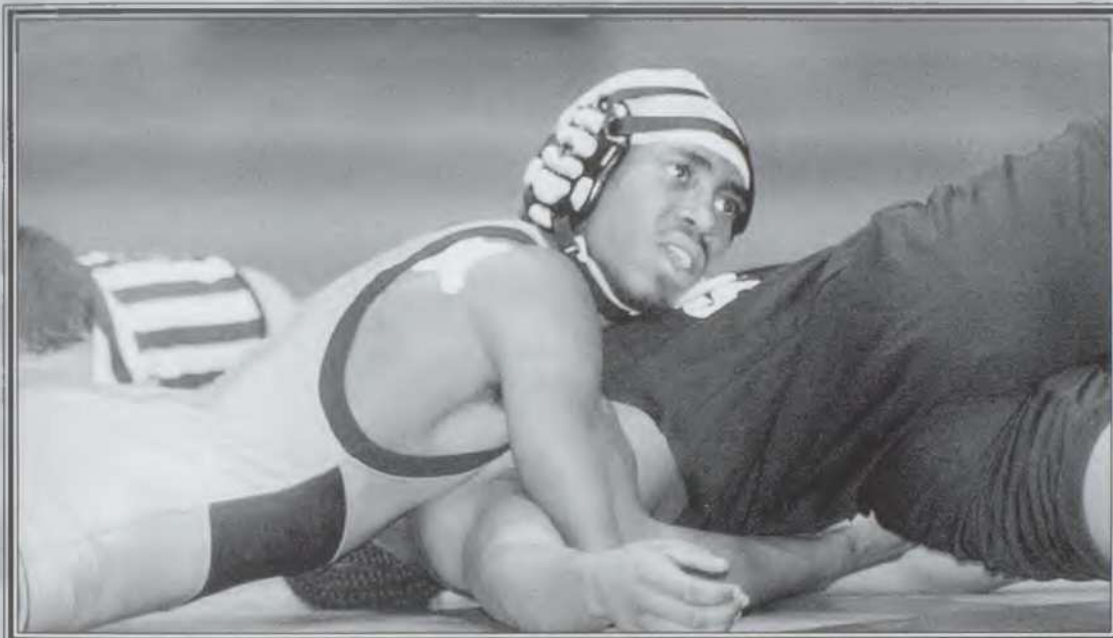


# Tiger Matmen Stalk a Title

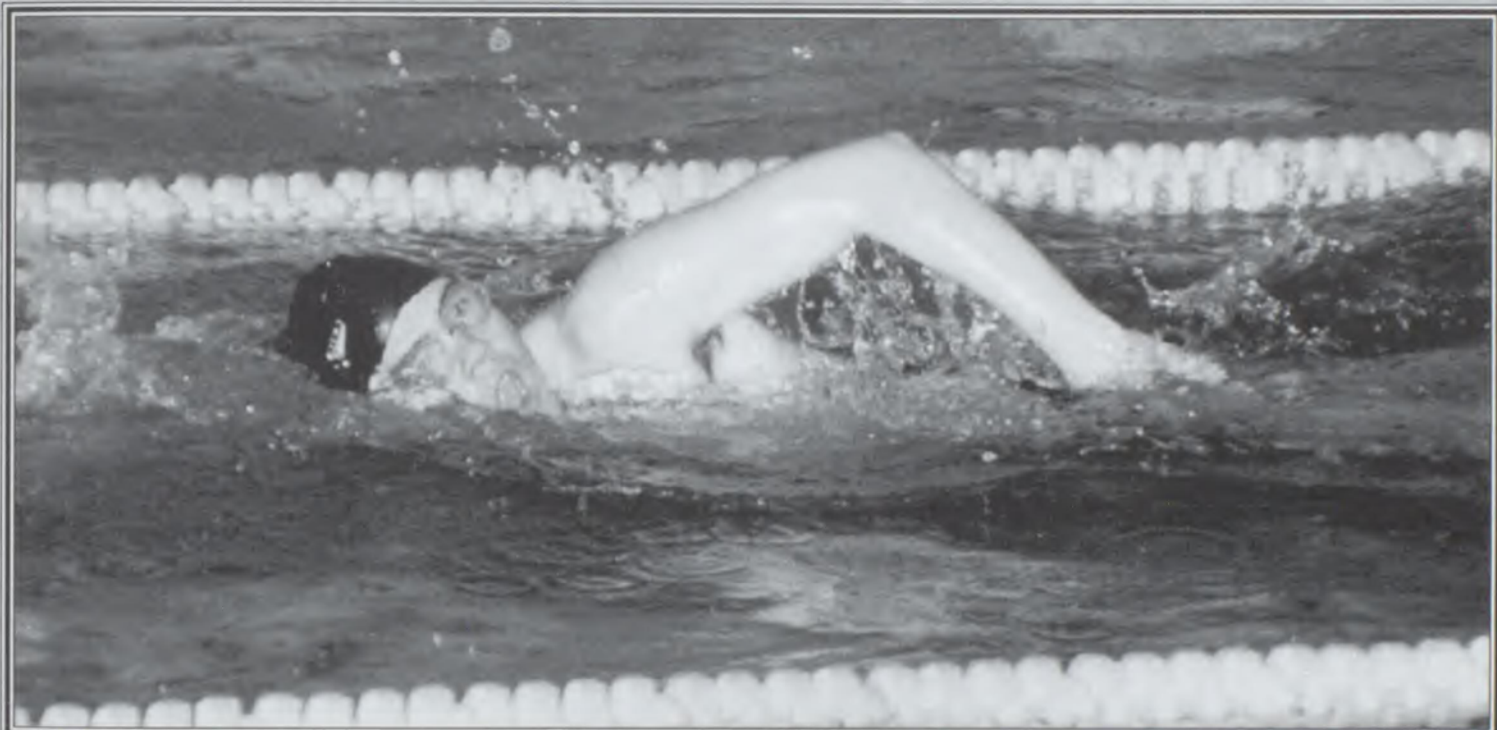

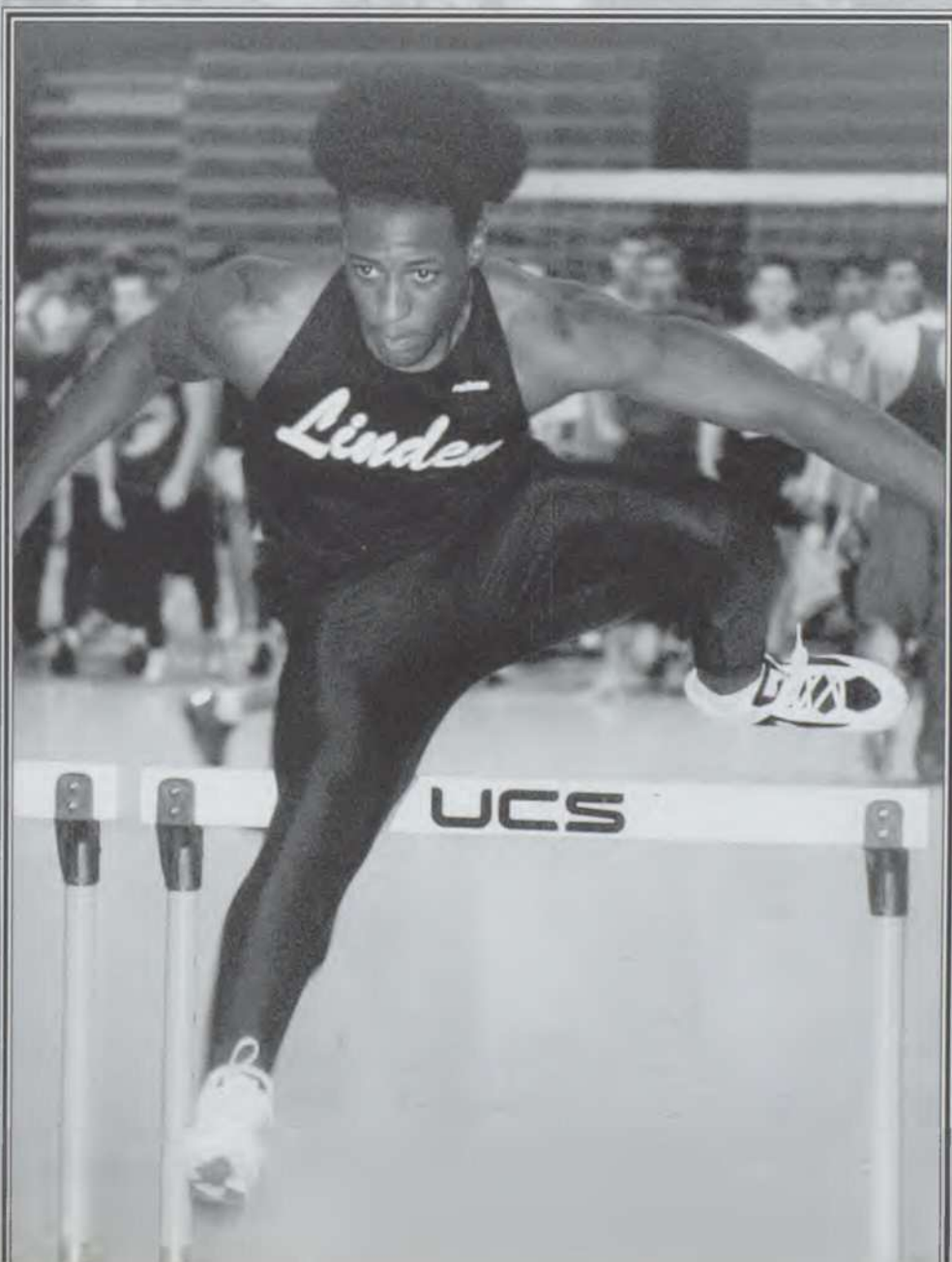

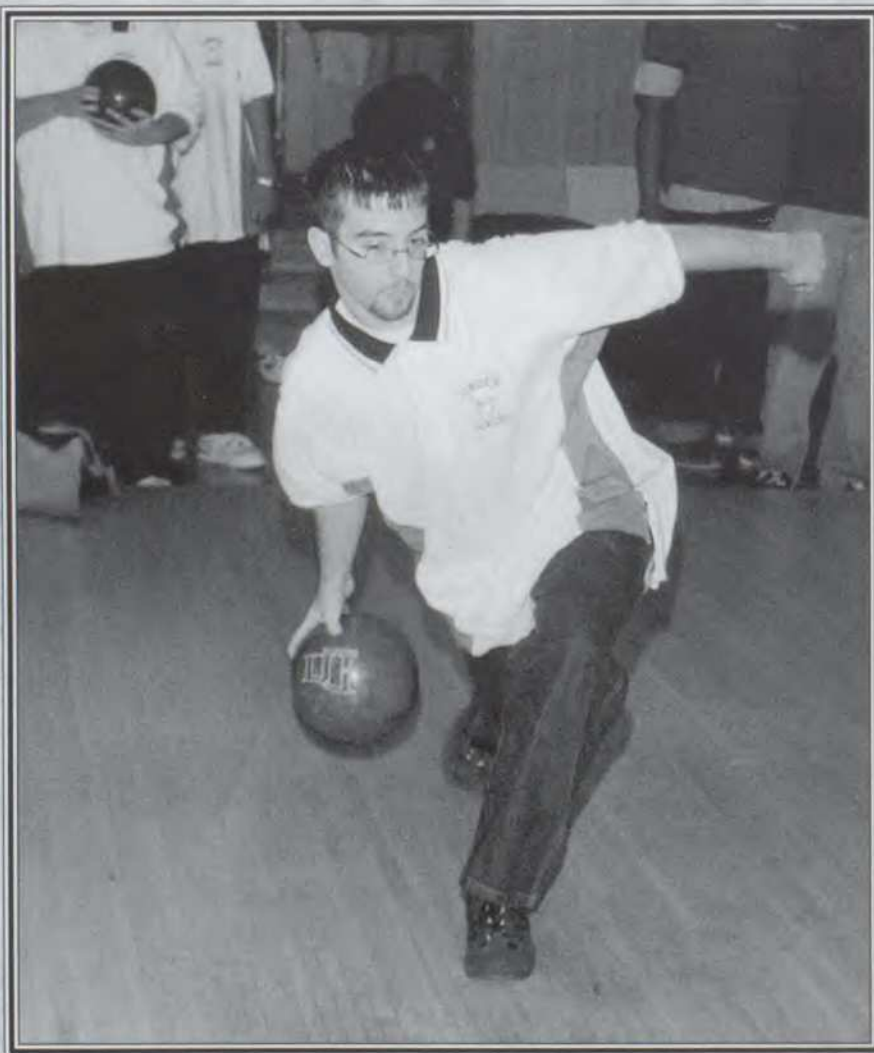

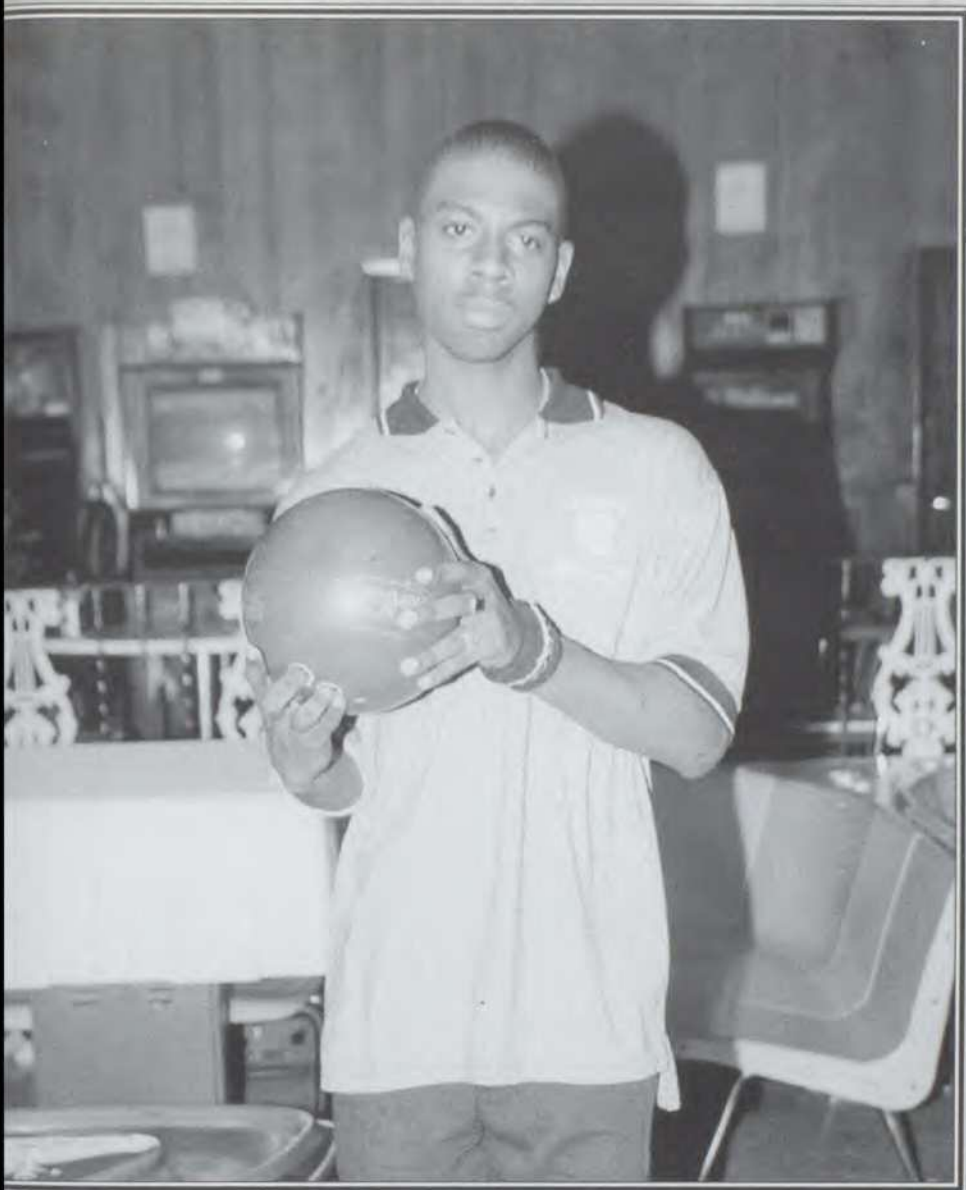

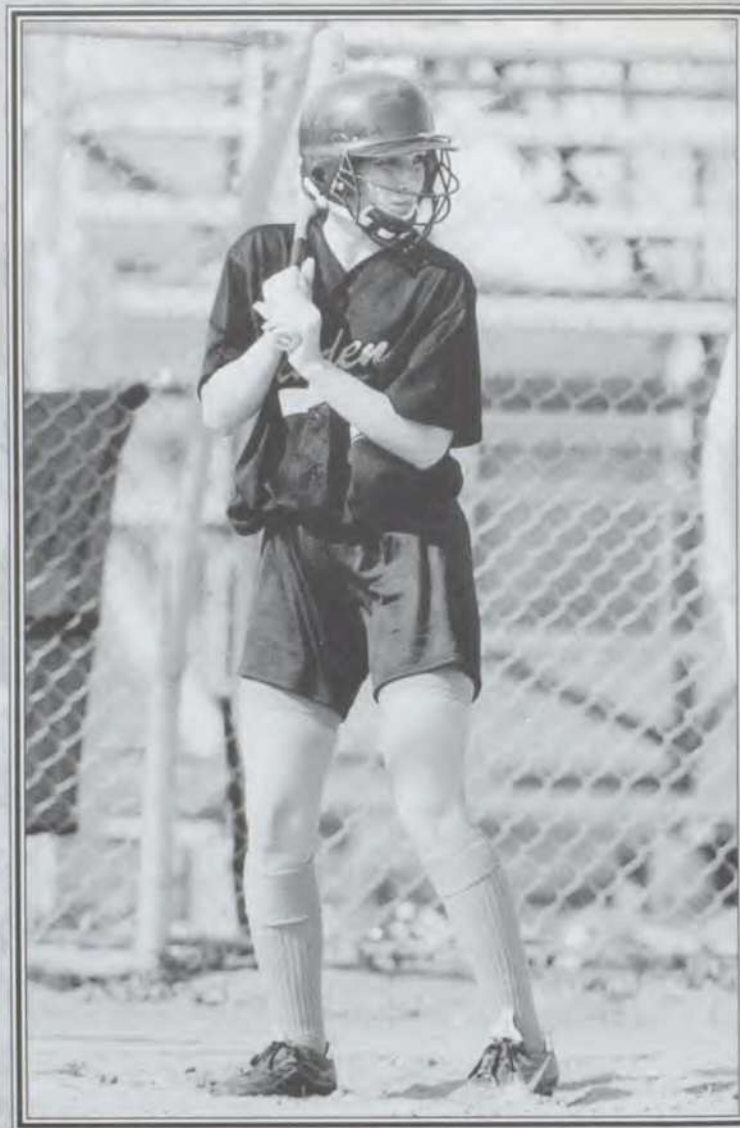

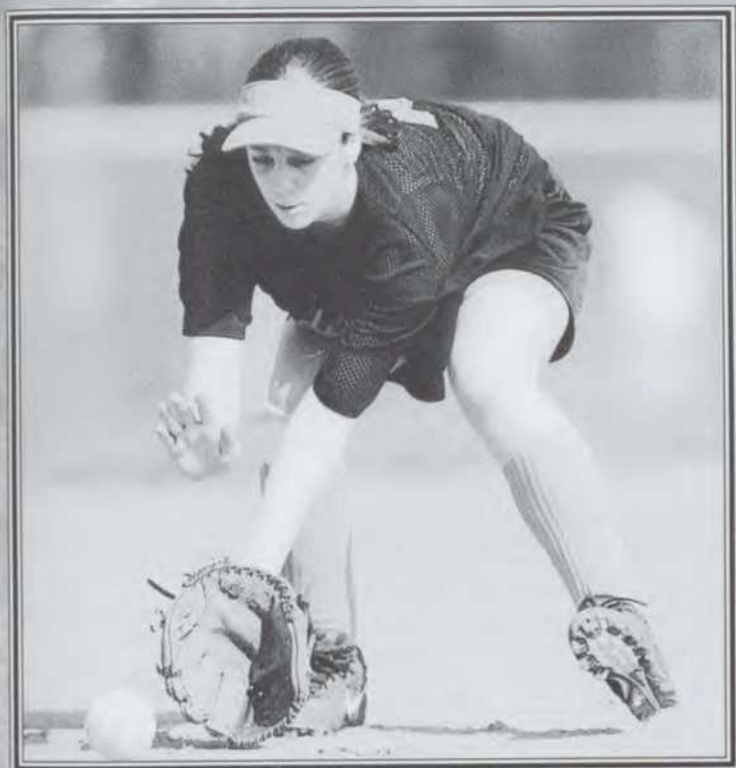

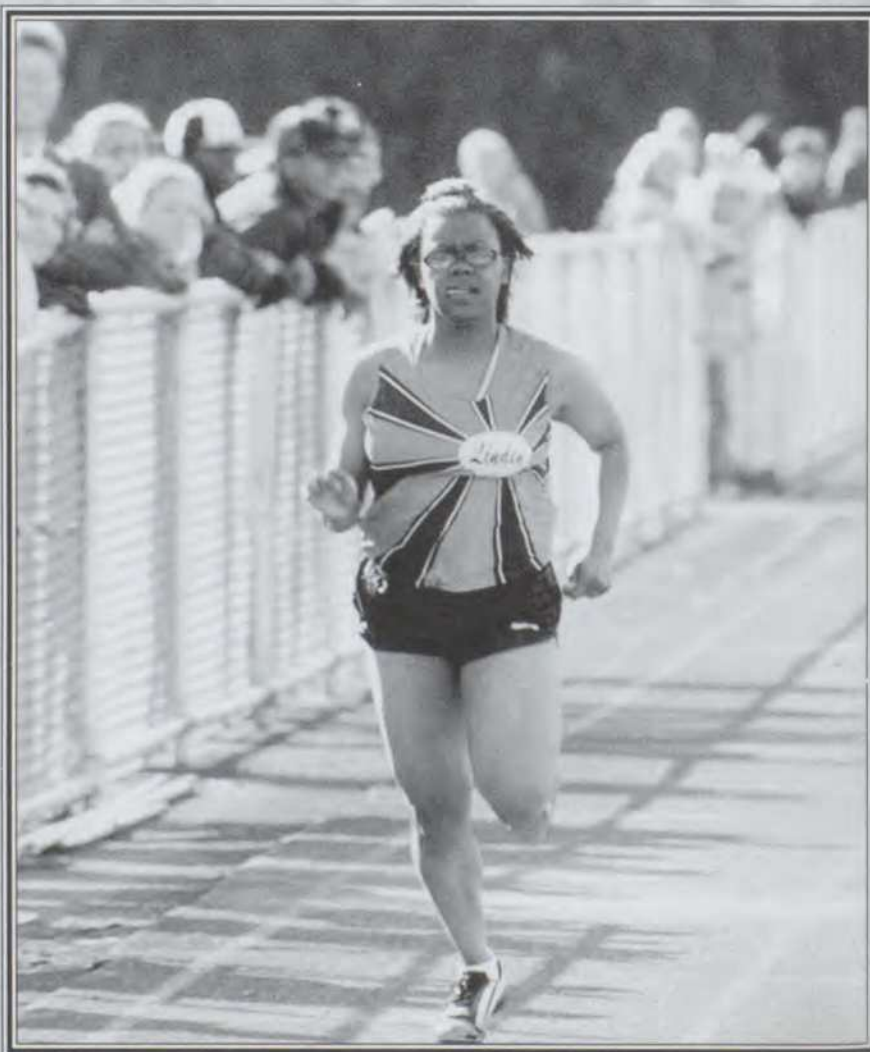

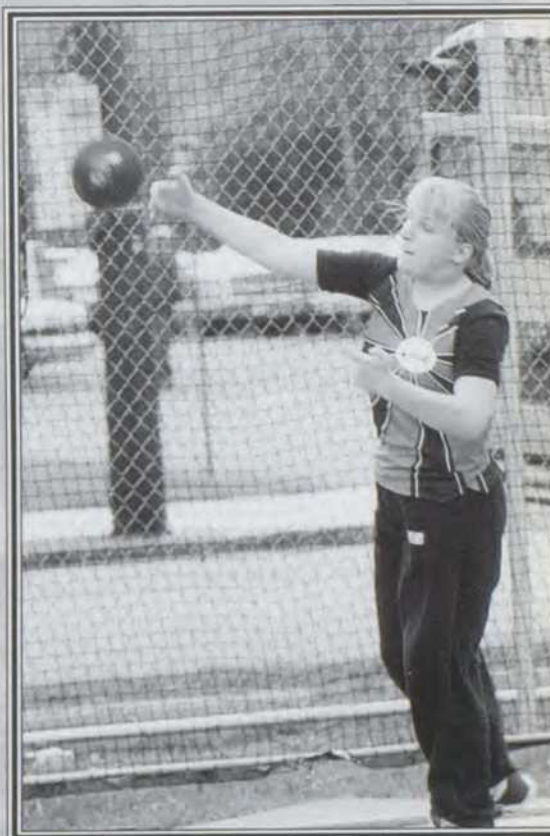

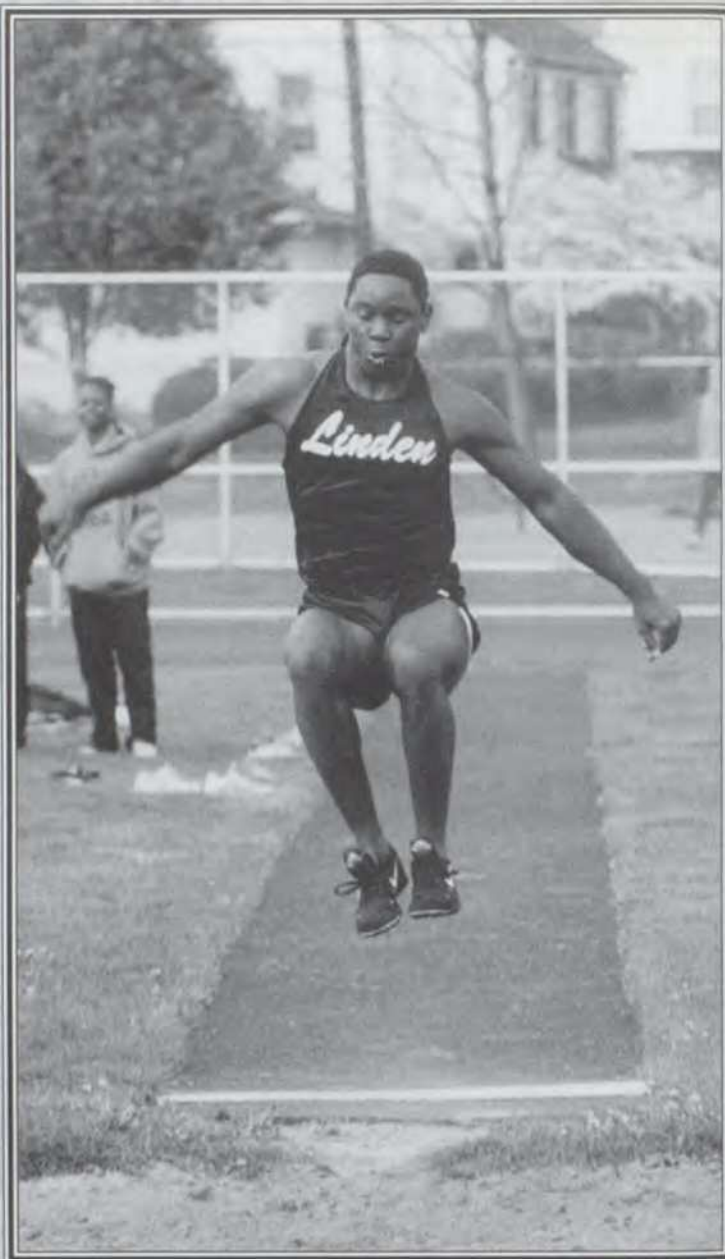

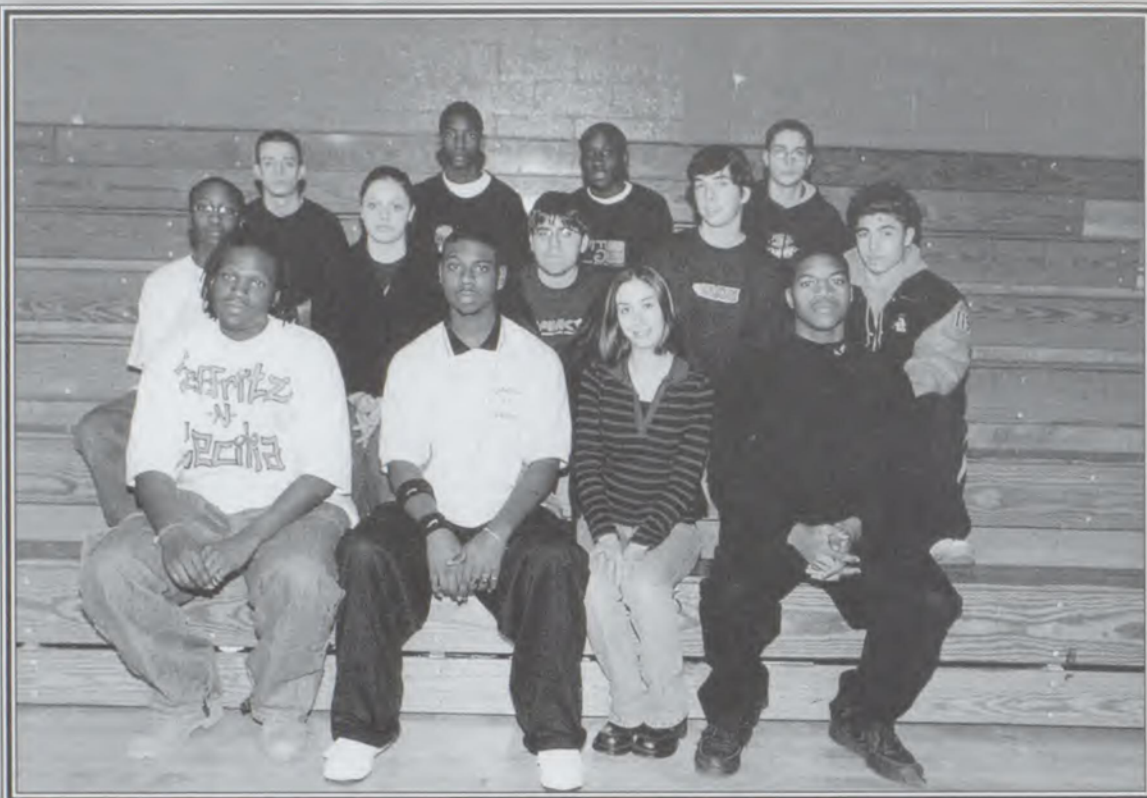
## TV/VIDEO CREW

They videotape school sports events, Board of Ed. meetings, and All City Concerts, and air them on TV 36; as well as participate in many competitions.

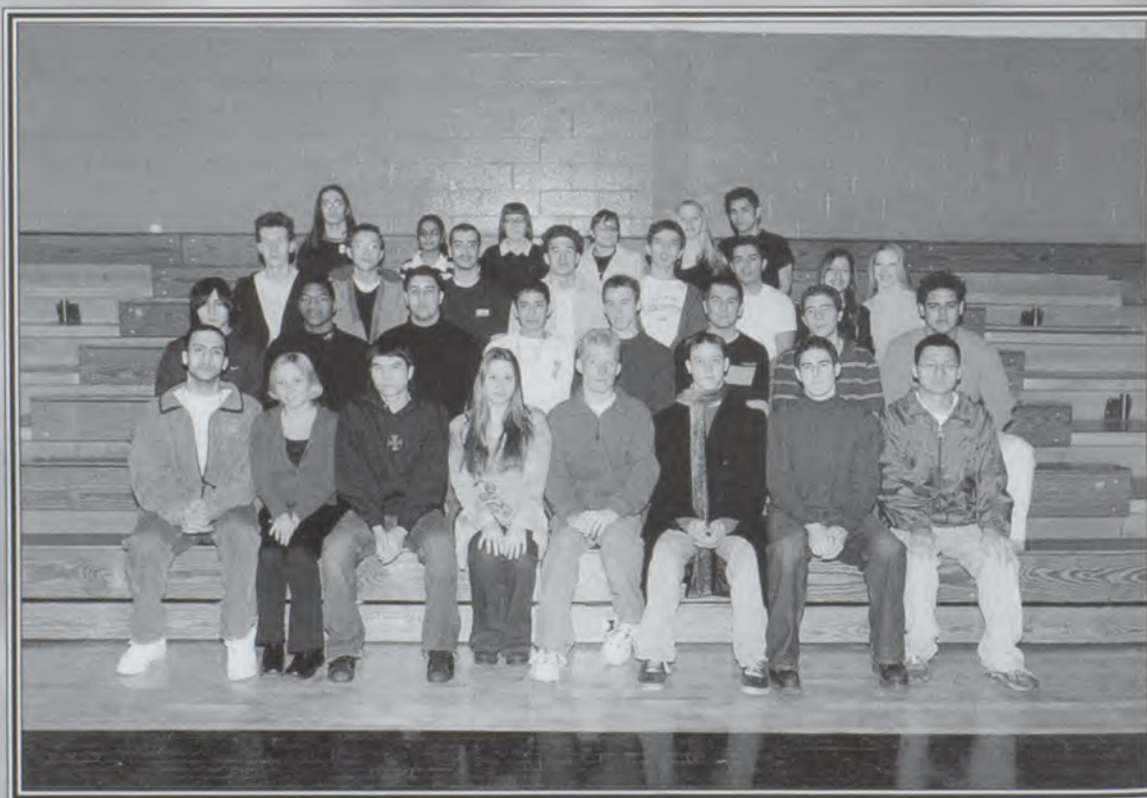

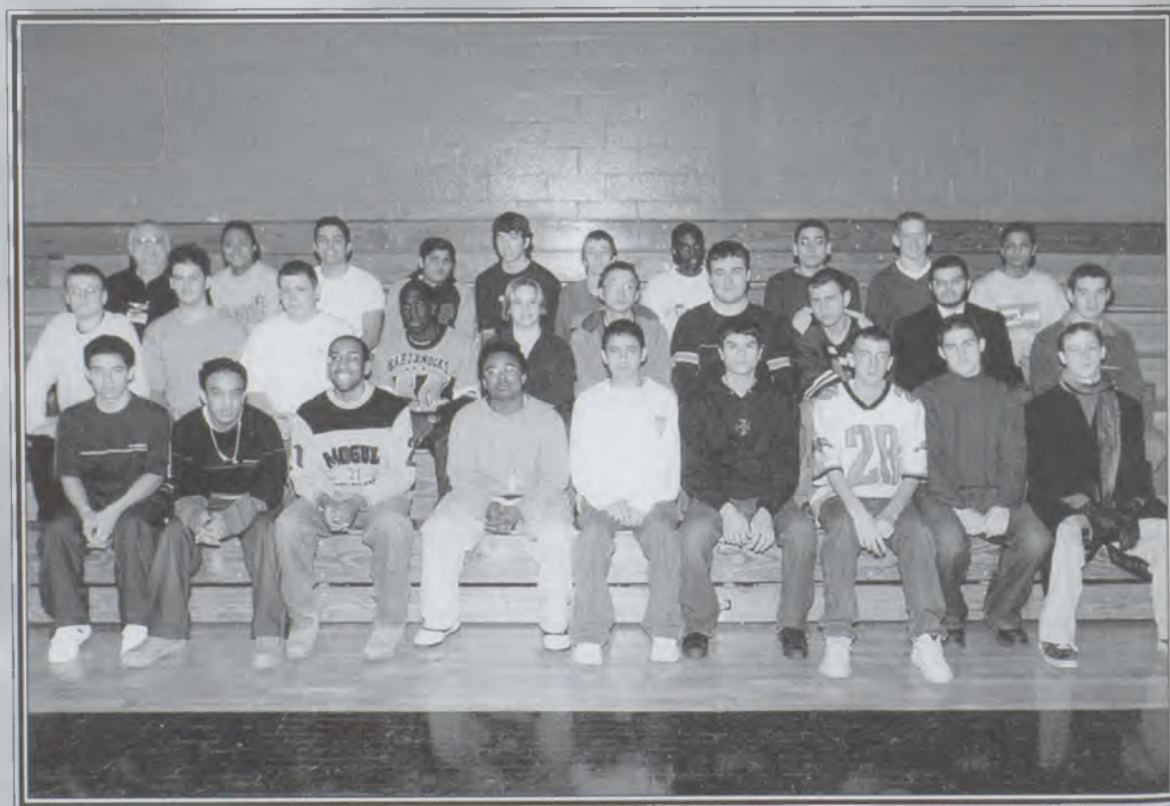
