# Class History

# 1959-1960

A bevy of apprehensive smiles entered the halls of Columbia on that bright September morn in 1959. Our sophomore year was filled with many new sights and impressions. # 1960-1961

However, our inflated egos were depressed when confronted with the P.S.A.T.'s, a forecast of future problems. But our worries were temporarily cast aside as our Junior Night production overshadowed all the other exciting events of our intermediate year. Cowboys and Oklahoma belles, bedecked in shirts with stenciled surreys, trooped up to Gruning's en masse at dawn. The lucky few who had their licenses obligingly piled the poor pedestrians into their cars and drove through the town honking and singing. More and more of us received our licenses, permitting us to progress to our senior year even faster if not more safely.

# 1961-1962

Although we didn't feel different or look different when we graduated in June, we were different. We will always remember and be grateful for the wonderful times, the friends, and the knowledge we acquired at Columbia; and we will travel on, bent on bigger but never better things.






