Included in the study of a foreign language, however, are not simply the basic fundamentals of grammar, but rather a thorough examination of the people themselves and their culture, both economic and social.

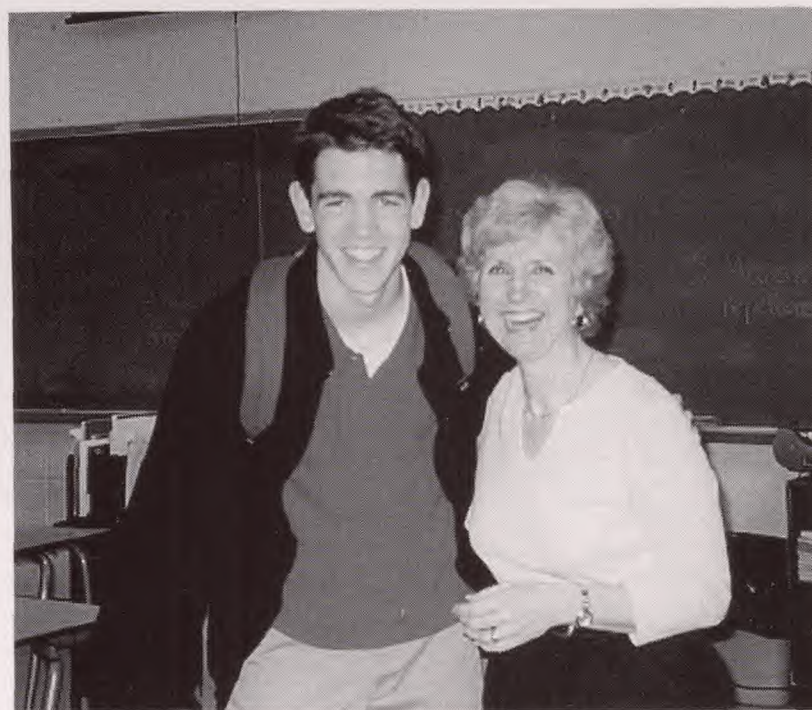

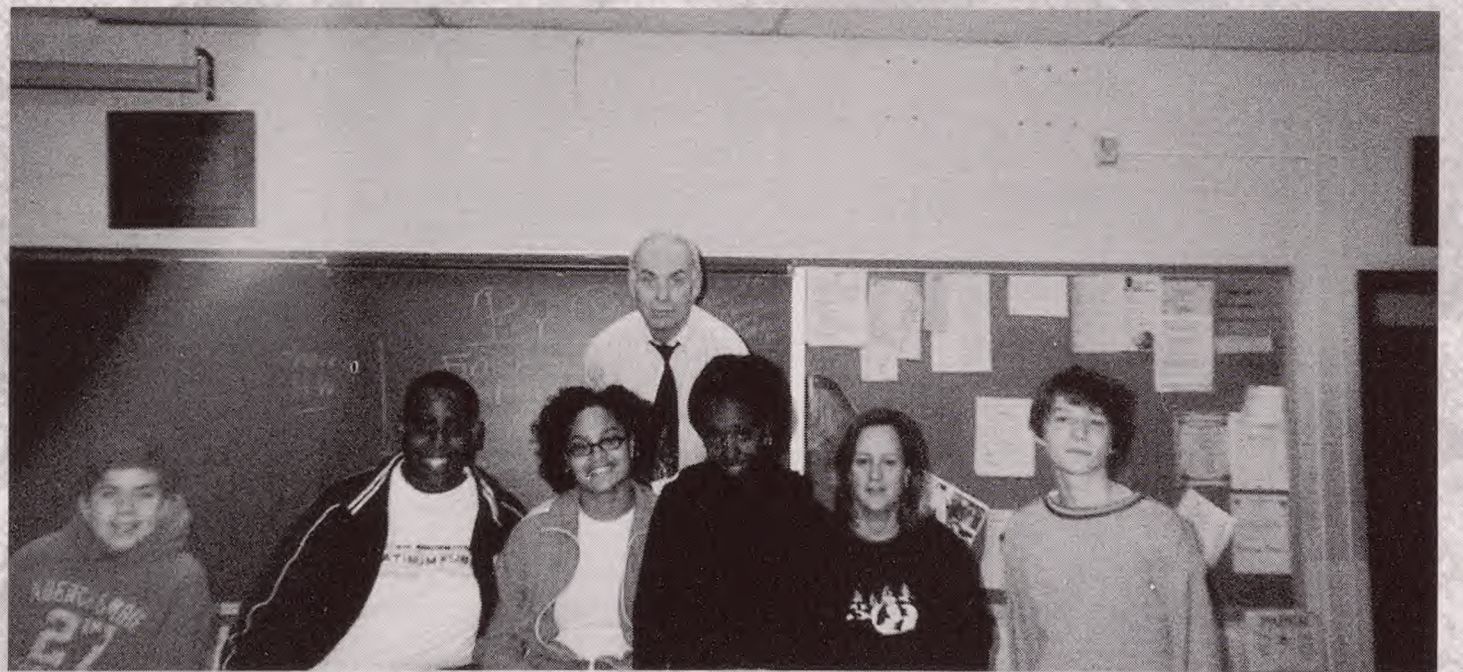
American Civil Liberties Union

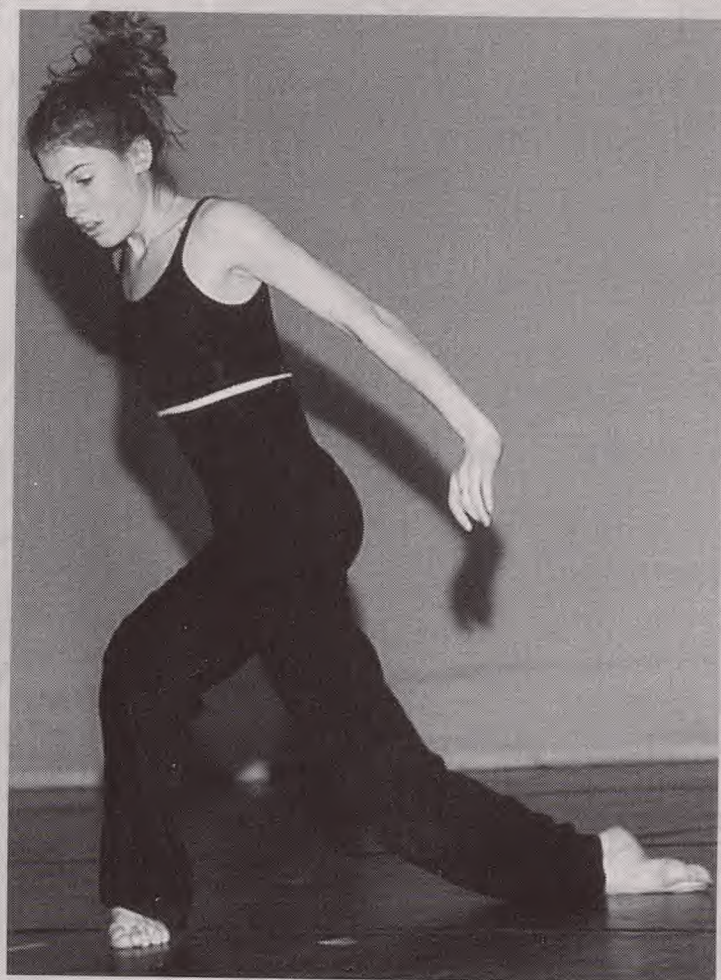
Special Dance: "Contrast"
