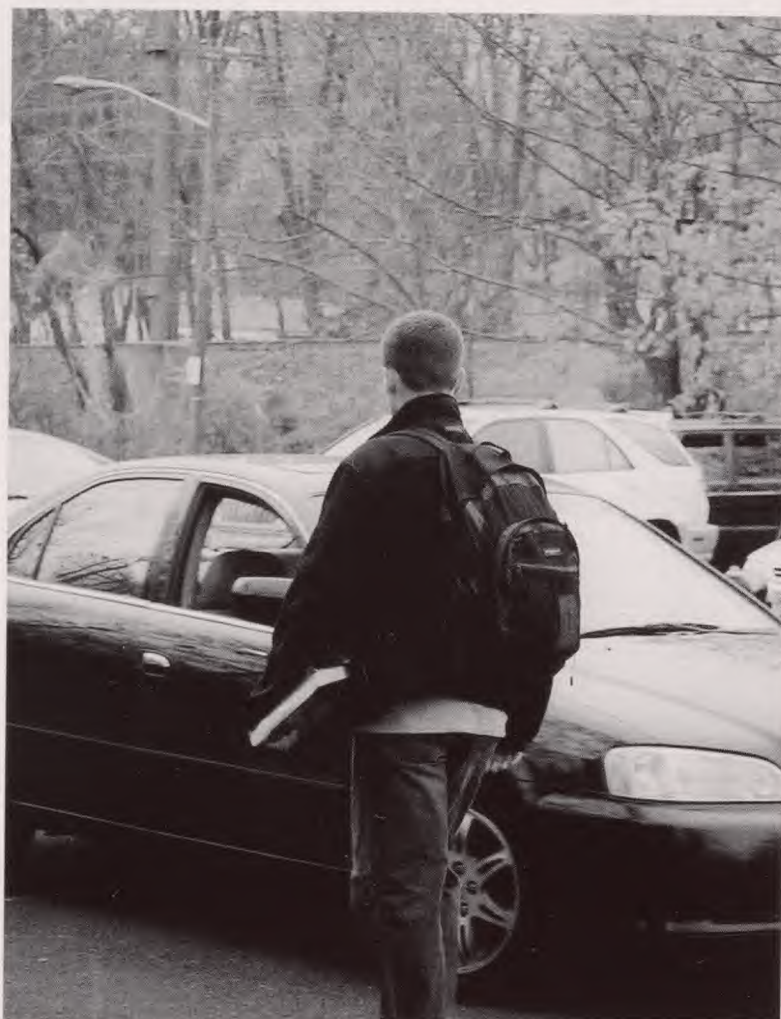

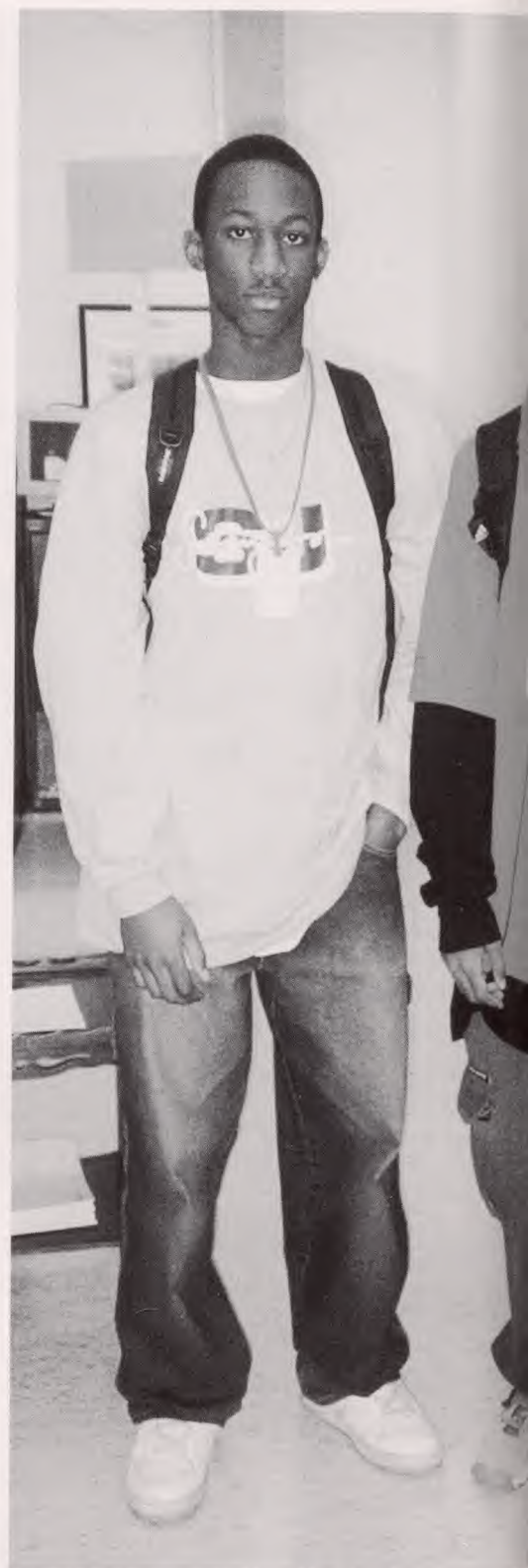
While some people in the community feel it was a necessary measure to protect Columbia's students and staff, others think it is unnecessary and cumbersome to have

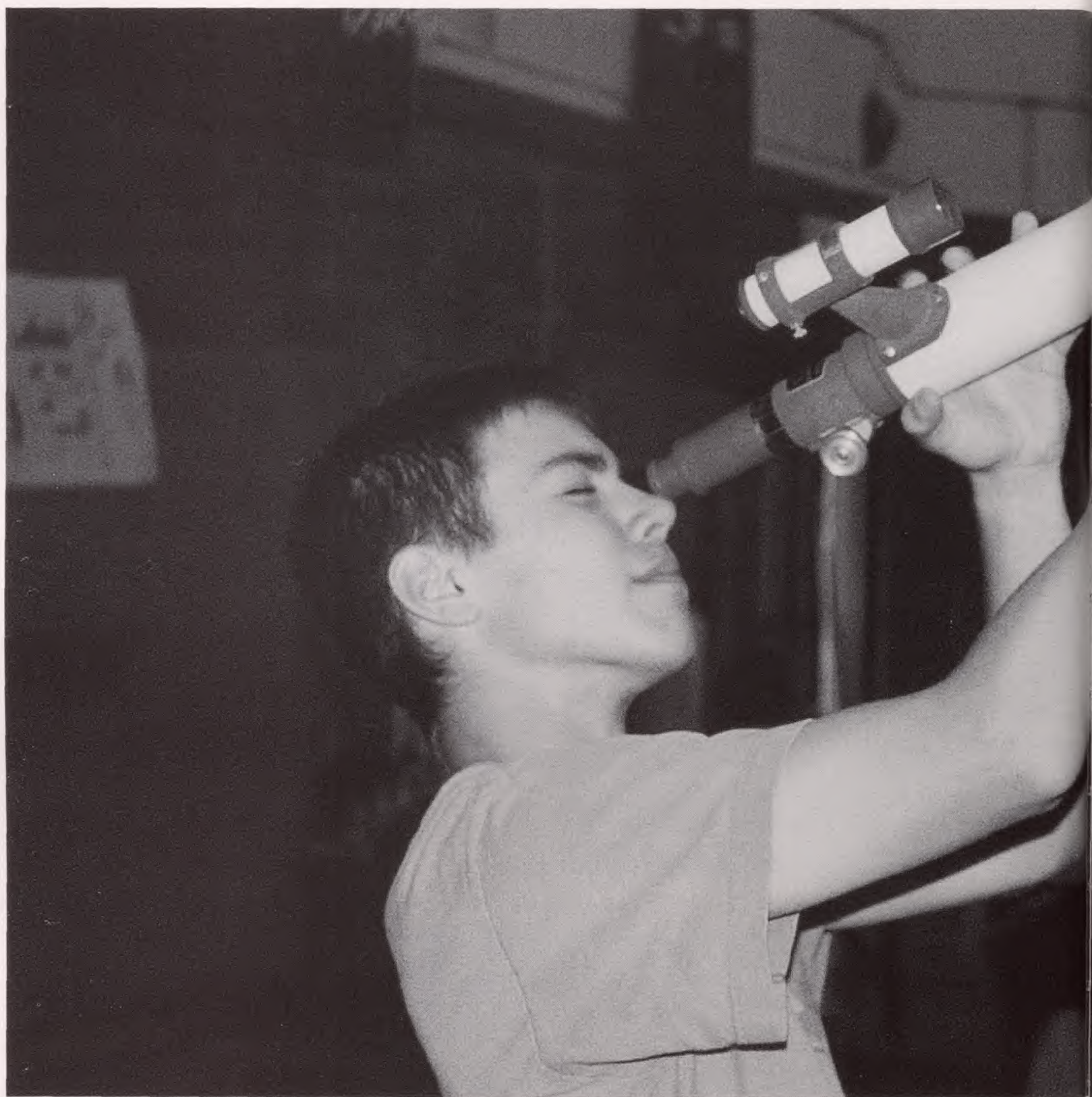




Orchestra

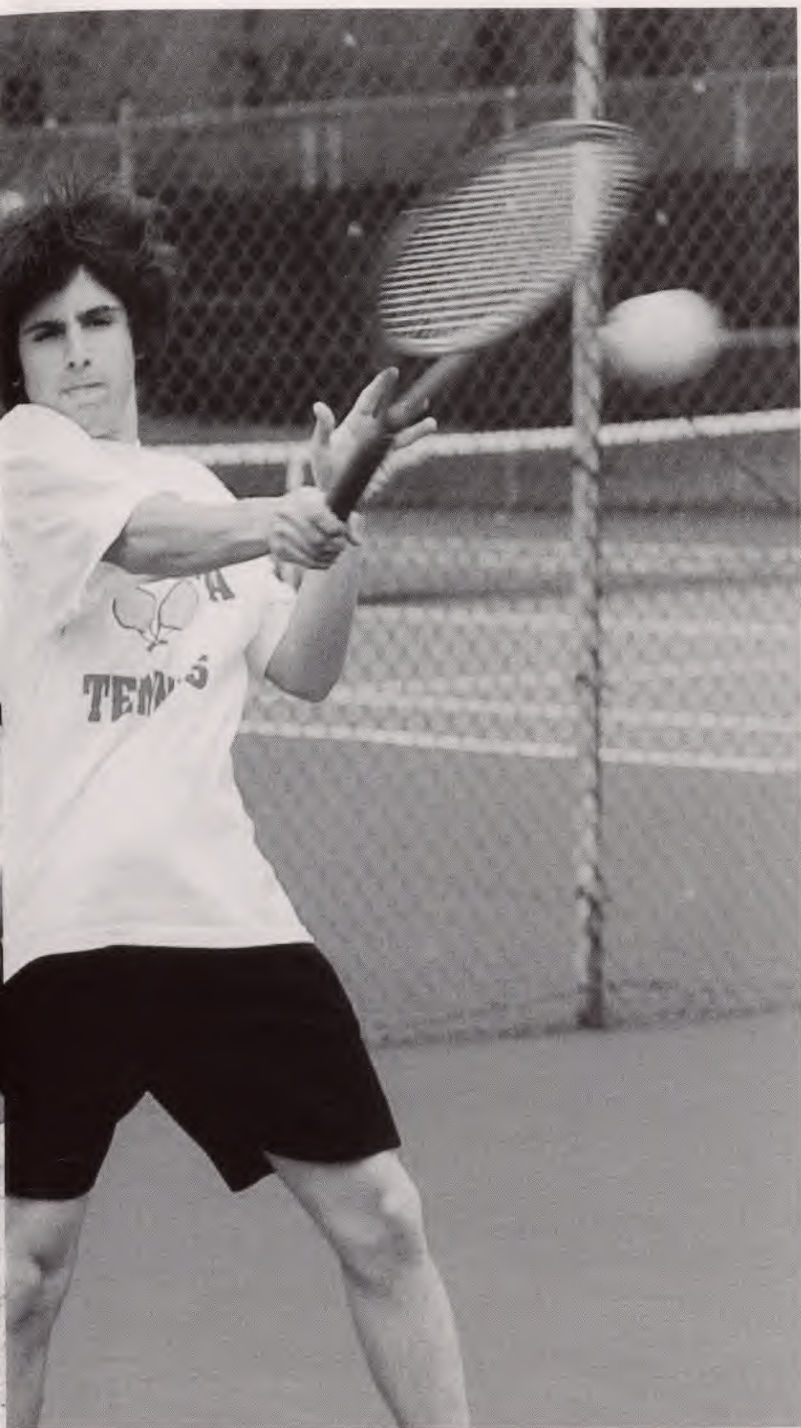

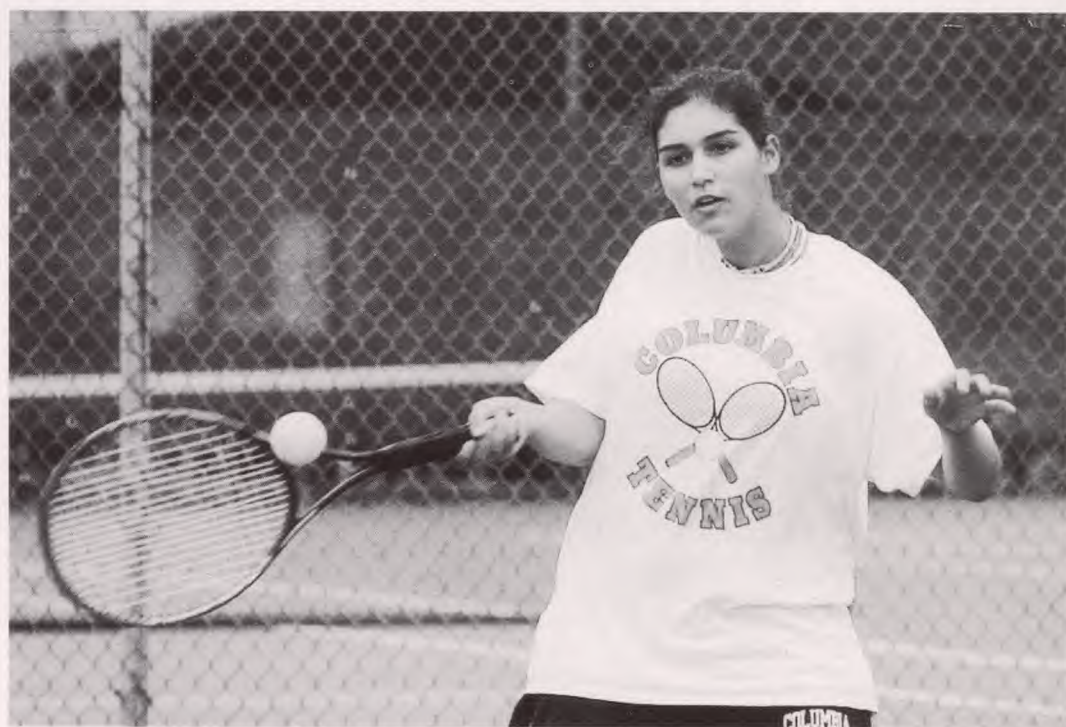

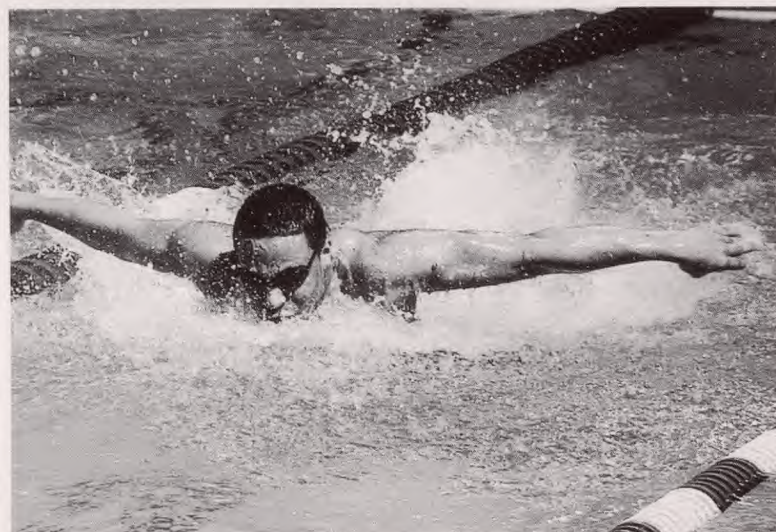
