How they lure him into visiting them is a problem, especially when Jane Rogers, a chic reporter, appears on the scene. However, her appearance is only a temporary hindrance.

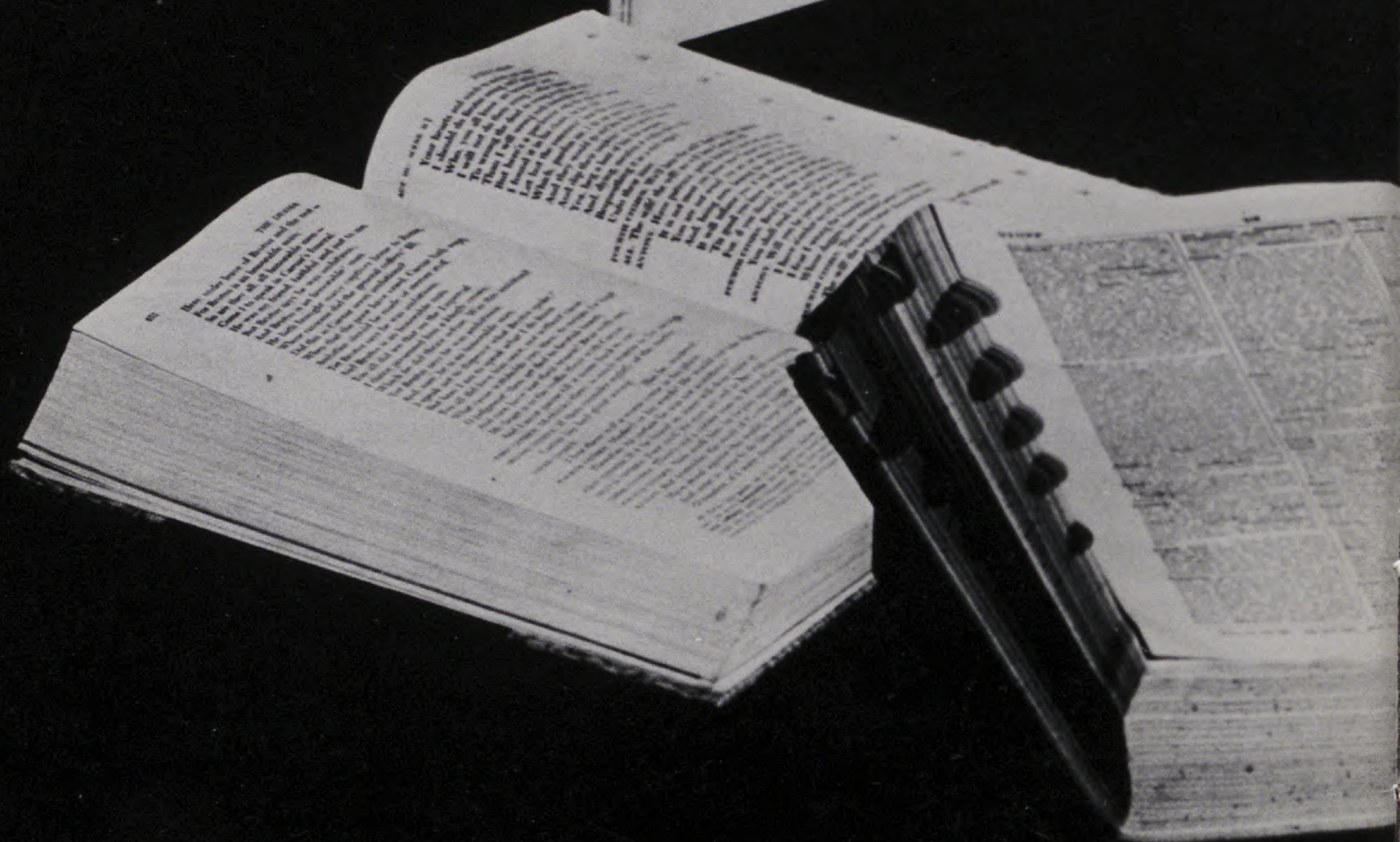
