



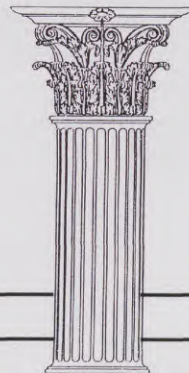

How about traffic signs? We would drive around crashing into each other without "STOP", "YIELD", "DO NOT ENTER", or "ONE WAY" signs.

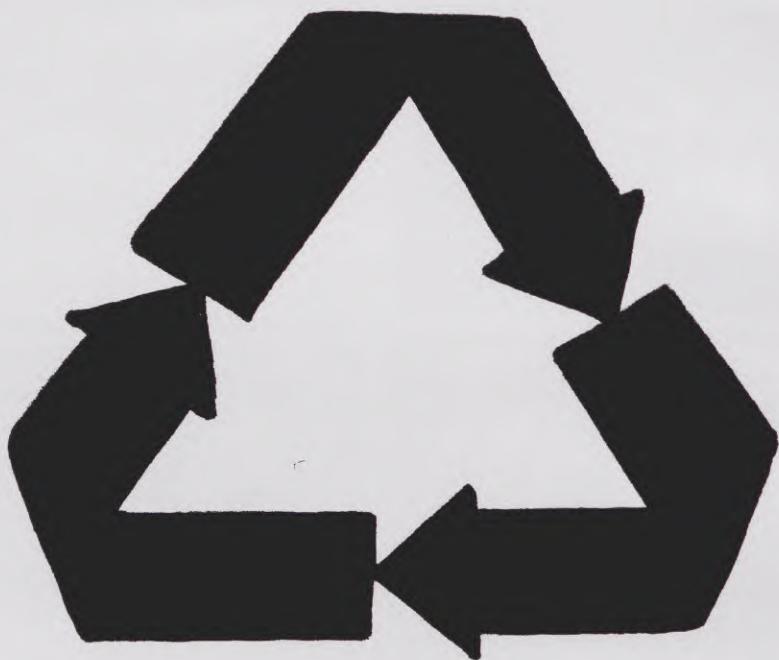
There are also your average superstitious signs. This

News



On August 19, 1991, Mikhail Gorbachev was placed under house arrest. This action started a chain of events that culminated with the end of both the Communist Party and the Soviet Union.

The August coup failed, and when Gorbachev returned, many new reforms took place. Among these were both the dissolution of the KGB and the end of the Communist Party in Russia. Soon all of the Soviet provinces, such as Georgia and Byelorussia, wanted independence. Freedom soon came as The Ukraine, along with the rest of the country, dissolved into their various states, each with its own government. The Soviet Union was officially no longer, and the world is watching to see the fate of its newest countries.

A sealed structure of steel and glass will be "home" for two years to four men and four women. The structure, Biosphere 2, is the size of 2 1/2 football fields and contains all the necessities of life. For two years, nothing will be introduced from the outside.

In addition to eight humans, Biosphere 2 houses 3,800 species of animals and plants and five ecosystems.

Both participants and backers of the project maintain that despite criticism, Biosphere 2 will provide significant data.



Terry Anderson emerged on December 4, 1991, from the dark hole of 6 1/2 years of captivity in Lebanon, thus ending a brutal hostage ordeal for both himself and the United States.

Asked what had kept him going in captivity, Anderson credited his companions, his faith, and his stubbornness.

Anderson, the longest-held Western hostage, came to personify the long-running hostage ordeal. His freedom marked the end of a hostage saga that haunted two American presidencies.

On November 7, 1991, Earvin "Magic" Johnson announced to the world that he had tested positive for the AIDS virus and was retiring. He made his announcement at the Forum, where he had played 12 stellar seasons with the Los Angeles Lakers.

Johnson proclaimed his intentions to become an AIDS activist and to campaign for safe sex. Johnson, whose retirement took immediate effect, summed up his feelings saying "I plan on going on."

On July 11, 1991, the moon slipped over the sun in the celestial ceremony of the eclipse, turning day into night for thousands of viewers and scientists.

The eclipse stretched 160 miles wide and was seen from Hawaii to Colombia and Brazil. This was the first time an eclipse path of totality passed over a major observatory. Scientists plan to use knowledge acquired during the eclipse to learn more about the sun's temperature and atmosphere.
