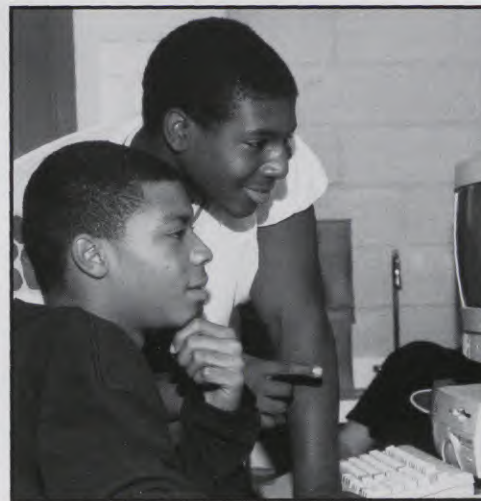
hard to remember all the characters you meet as you wrap yourself in the plot.

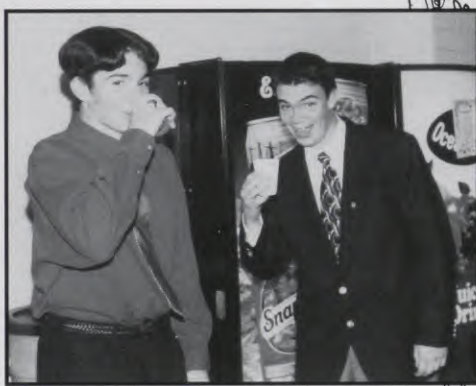
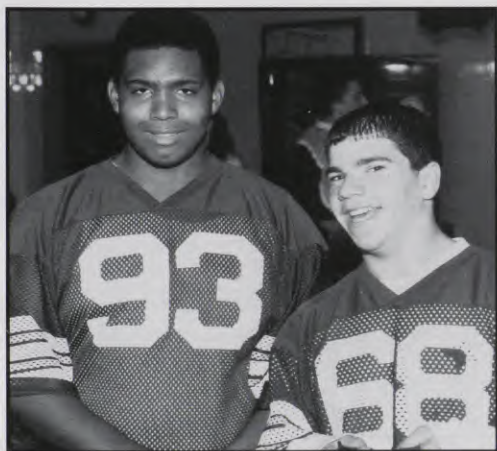
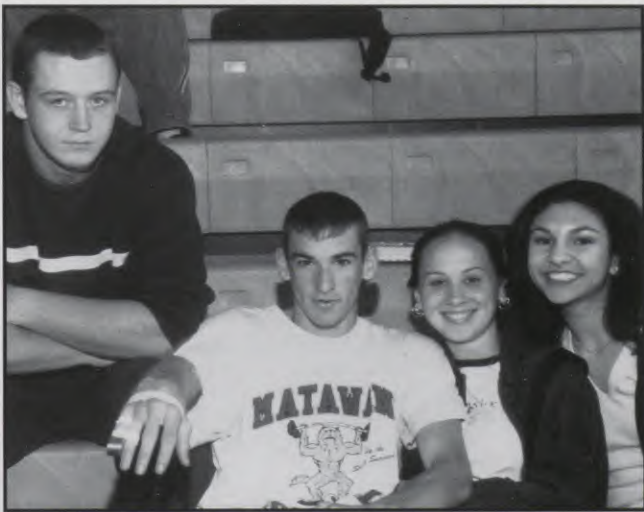
Matawan Regional High School can be just as enticing as an exceptional novel. With every day

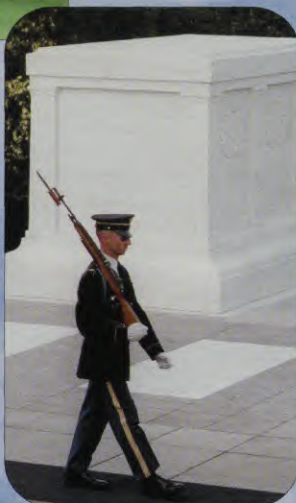

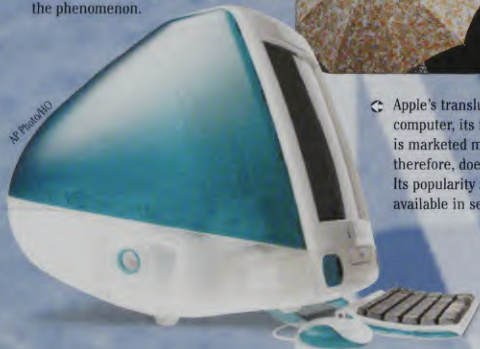

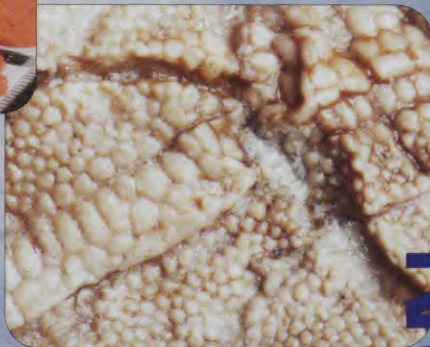

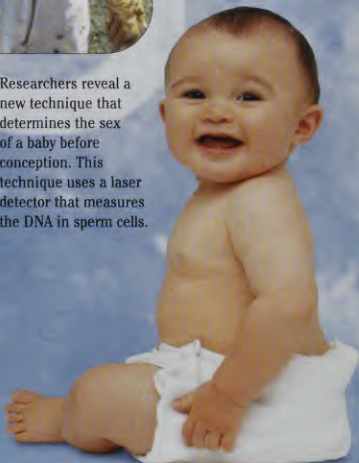

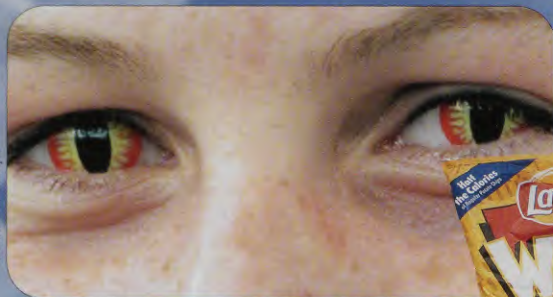

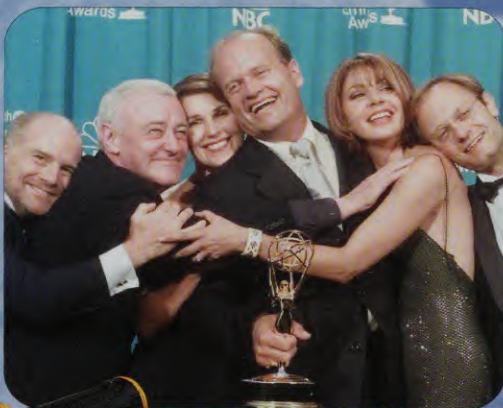

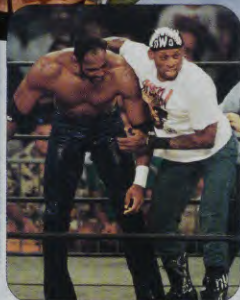

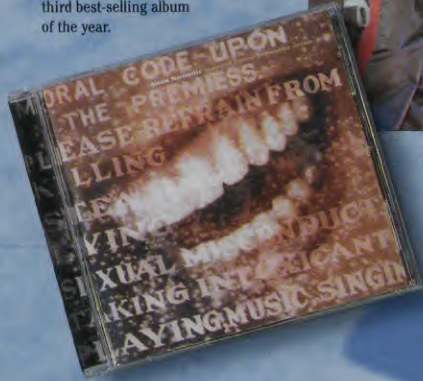

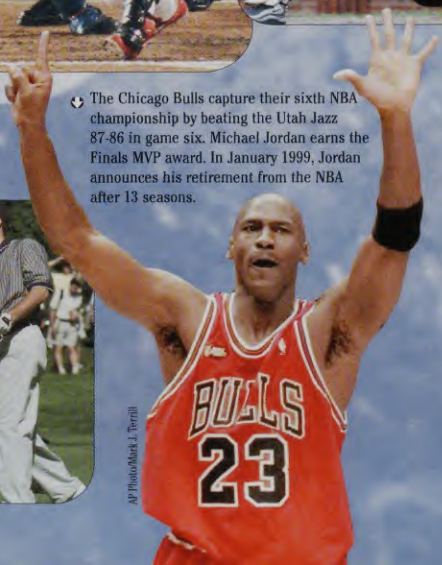
