#### THE MATAWAN FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRST AID SQUAD

In the early part of 1933 at a regular meeting of the Matawan Fire Department the need for a First Aid Squad in the Borough was discussed. The sentiment being favorable, a committee was appointed consisting of members from each fire company to consider the formation of such a squad.

The organization was soon started and a class of twenty-three men from the four fire companies began to receive instruction from William E. Greene, an approved American Red Cross instructor from the Keyport First Aid Squad. During the Summer, the classes were suspended and it was not until Fall that the group, then reduced to eight men, resumed classes. Their progress was rapid and satisfactory and in Dccember they were examined, all passing the course and receiving First Aid cards from the American Red Cross,

W.th this nucleus, the Squad held its first regular meeting on January 8, 1934, selecting as President, Andrew J. Hulsart, who had been instrumental in starting the Squad, and as Captain, E. Story Hallock, who had had practical experience as a member of the Keyport First Aid Squad. Other officers selected were: Andrew J. Boice, Vice President; John Tourine, Secretary-Treasurer, and as Lieutenants, Clarence Stultz and Robert Colot.

In March, 1934, ten new members were admitted to the Squad and a new class of ins ruction started. Their progress has been so rapid that they will be examined this month. At the same time examinations will be held for the original members who are now taking an advanced course.

The instruction received by First Aid men conforms to the requirements of the American Red Cross and includes the theory and practice of resuscitation, checking severe bleeding, the splinting of fractures. treatment of wounds, burns and poisons, handling and transportation of the injured and the emergency treatment of all types of injuries.

Starting with no equipment, the Squad, through the generosity of the Borough Fire Companies, the local Red Cross Chapter and many local people, has gotten together two emergency kits with all the necessary first aid dressings, bandages and splints. Just recently a new Cunningham ambulance was purchased. This is of modern design with a long wheelbase to insure safe and comfortable transportation of the ill and injured. The interior is furnished with a roller stretcher, a folding attendant's seat and the necessary first aid supplies. The ambulance has already been used for several calls since its arrival.

The policy of the Squad is to render first aid treatment wherever and whenever called upon, and no charge is, or can be made for such treatment. The Squad has also decided to provide free transportation of maternity cases to hospitals in this vicinity. For non-emergency transportation the ambulance is available but it is necessary to ask a donation based upon mileage to provide for the cost of its operation. It is, however, a cardinal principle that the Squad is ready and willing to help anyone at any time without regard to race, color or financial condition.
