REV. HERICK, JOHNSON, D. D., of Chicago, has written to a New York paper that the high license law has closed only four hundred saloons out of thirty-seven hundred in Chicago, thus leaving thirty-three hundred for daily service. There may be suffering for want of beer and whiskey, but to cut off four hundred saloons is something. It is better than the impossible scheme contemplated by the legislature. License was granted to the saloons, and the saloons are better. The temperance men are doing some good as chemists. They have learned the actual ingredients of London gin to be "alcohol, water, malt, acid, sugar, oil, and a little of oil of turpentine." It does little harm. It would say all who drink it were not that the tartaric acid destroys the bad effect of the maltic acid, the acetic acid in turn overcomes the fatality of the tartaric element, the ether water, and the sugar, and the oil of turpentine, in its work of dissipation, then there are overtones by the oil of juniper and at last the man is left to die of the turpentine. Good spring water is a much better drink than gin.
