SHOT ON THE WAY FROM CHURCH.
A Chicago Banker Probably Murdered
by His Sister.

CHICAGO, Oct. 17.—Mr. Stephen W. Rawson, a well-known banker of this city, and connected with the Union Trust company, was fatally shot at noon yesterday near the Third Presbyterian church, at the corner of Ashland and Madison streets, by his sister, Ralph W. Glynn. The shooting occurred on the steps of the church, where the Rawson family were gathered for a religious service. Mr. Rawson, who had attended service at the church, emerged from the south entrance as the great organ was still thundering its finale, and started directly across Ashland avenue on his way to his residence at 866 West Monroe street. Glynn, who had been listening in the vicinity of the entrance, saw his brother as he came, when he saw Rawson come forth, ran along the avenue and fired a shot at him. The bullet struck him in the chest, and he fell. He drew a large nickel-plated revolver from his pocket, and fired a second shot, grazing the handle of the weapon with both hands, fired into the back of the helpless man, who fell forward upon his face. The bullet was lodged in his body. The young banker was taken to the hospital, where he died after a long and painful illness. The police are investigating the case, and have arrested Glynn on the charge of murder. Glynn is a well-known figure in the banking world, and his death is a great loss to the community.
