Those who expect the American idea to be interesting to know that a batch of five foreign professors will very shortly land in this country to take their chairs in the new Roman Catholic university at Washington. The professors will come from Italy, France and elsewhere.

The Nicaragua Canal. Each month records some additional progress with this great enterprise. Preparations are now making to dig from both the Atlantic and Pacific sides of the isthmus. On the Pacific side the work has been completed for some time. The canal will be completed by the first of January at least. The two sections of laborers will work towards each other and meet. On the Atlantic side it is a question what the name of the entering port will be called. The natives call it San Juan de Nicaragua, but a good while ago some Englishman called it Greytown. Whatever we call it, however, property is advancing in value within its limits already. The fact that the canal will be completed is a record that the American company who are constructing the canal take care of the health of their laborers and pay them with good food and pure water. The canal will not be finished till 1934 or 1935.

Union Soldiers' Pensions. Mr. George L. Kilmer gives in The Century a summing up of facts in regard to army pensions. In 1898 328,338 soldiers received pensions. In 1927 217,890 received from \$5 down to \$10 monthly. If an enlisted man is incapacitated for general labor by reason of war service, \$8 a month is allowed to him. The sum was fixed in 1915, when the price of food was 10 cents. It is now that it was deemed a sum might live comfortably on this sum.

There are 32,007 pensioners who receive \$8 a month or less. Only 64,400 of the pensioners receive more than \$10 a month. The sum annually paid for pensions of \$8 a month and under amounts to \$13,888,000. Among these receiving pensions above this sum are included invalids and pensioners.

Pensioners paid out now, of all classes for three years, amount annually to \$66,707,922.93. During the last year there were 6,000,000 cases of wounds and disease. Apart from the money paid for pensions, the sum annually paid for pensions of \$8 a month and under amounts to \$13,888,000. Among these receiving pensions above this sum are included invalids and pensioners.

It is estimated that there are now 1,300,000 Union soldiers alive, of all ranks, of whom 400,000 are over 30 years of age. The committee on pensions passed a resolution recommending Congress to enact a law giving to every surviving Union soldier who served in the war a pension of \$10 a month. This would be an additional one cent a month for each day's service beyond 30. This, if it became law, would increase the annual pension outlay to over \$150,000,000.
