















CARE OF CHILDREN'S TEETH.

Dental is Very Apt to Attack the Teeth When the Child is Young.

There is no reason why the appearance of the teeth should cause any serious derangement of the system, but owing to some neglect of the general laws of health at the time the teeth are first formed, at times infantile teething becomes aggravated to a serious disease. The first teeth that appear are the two upper and two lower incisors; after these the teeth on either side appear, and the molars, and last of all, the canine teeth. The child now has twenty teeth. It is not until the child is two years old that the nurse may begin to use a soft brush. When the child is two years old the nurse should be very attentive of the teeth; these teeth the child should be taken to a dentist, who will put in a soft temporary filling, which is done so easily that it will cause no special inconvenience to the child, and will save it from that excruciating pain of childhood—the toothache. It will also insure the permanent teeth coming in in a satisfactory manner, providing the child's mouth remains good. It is of the greatest importance that the child's teeth should be kept in good condition, as all intelligent dentists agree, until the permanent teeth appear. The permanent teeth will not come in until the child is six years old, and it is at this time that the nurse should be very attentive of the teeth, and keep them in good condition. In this way all the teeth, if kept sound and healthy, will fall out in their proper time with little or no pain or loss of blood.

The writer has seen a child taken to its dentist with its teeth. The teeth were so sore and painful, that the nurse had completely absorbed by the permanent teeth which appeared beneath them. The first permanent teeth to appear in a child's mouth come in about the sixth year of the temporary teeth. They do not appear until the child is six years old, and are taken for temporary teeth and neglected. Important as it is to have temporary teeth, it is doubly important to have these permanent molars, as they are intended to last a long time. It is of the greatest importance that the child's teeth should be kept in good condition during childhood, for progress far more rapidly than it does in later life when the teeth have become more hardened.
