

ENGLAND MUST WAKE UP

Patience Ceasing to Be a Virtue in the Behring Sea Case.

REPRODUCED BY HARRINGTON.

It is requested to send a Party Agent to the President's Commission on the Behring Sea Case.

WASHINGTON, March 17.—During the morning hour in the senate Mr. Stewart, of Nevada, gave an illustration of what he considered a little matter which it would not take long to consider by calling up under the three minute rule a bill to appropriate over \$1,000,000 to reimburse California, Oregon and Nevada for expenses incurred during the war. Messrs. Allison, Sherman and Cockrell manifested opposite different opinions as to what constituted a trifle, and the bill went over.

The senate also received itself into executive session and the Wood case and discussed it until adjournment.

The senate in executive session confirmed the nomination of Mr. George H. Chase, of Georgia, as interstate commerce commissioner to succeed the late Commissioner Briggs.

In the House, the debate on the tariff was continued, Mr. Sawyer, of Texas, and Mr. Bryan, of Kansas, being the only two speakers.

The speech of the latter occupied two hours and was closely listened to by the largest number of members since the tariff debate began. Upon its conclusion he was loudly applauded, and was the recipient of numerous congratulations.

Wharton Fonda Transferred.

WASHINGTON, March 17.—An unusual step in diplomatic correspondence, which emphasized the critical nature of the relations between the United States and Great Britain on the question of jurisdiction in the Behring sea, was taken by President Harrison yesterday. He instructed Mr. Wharton Fonda, acting as secretary of state, to inform the British minister, to inform Sir Julian Pauncefote, the British minister, that it is necessary for the United States to receive, without further delay, a reply from Lord Salisbury, the British premier, to the last communication, written by the president himself, notifying the British government that the government of the United States would not consent to a refusal to renew the modes of the treaty to the killing of whales and that it would assert its rights in Behring sea with all the resources at its command.

Why Salisbury Delays.

This notification was sent to the British government through Minister Pauncefote on Tuesday last week, and to reply has as yet been received. There has come, however, an intimation that Lord Salisbury would prefer to renew the modes of the treaty, which has for its object the preventing of pelagic sealing, or in other words, the preservation of the seals, provided that the United States would guarantee to pay any damages which the owners of the Canadian pelagic whaling vessels would suffer because of an enforced suspension of their efforts. To such a proposition, of course, the United States would never agree, and Lord Salisbury has not yet ventured to suggest it.

This notification was sent to the British government through Minister Pauncefote on Tuesday last week, and to reply has as yet been received. It was rumored today, "an excellent authority very close to the cabinet," that a communication from the Russian foreign minister would be laid before the foreign relations committee of the senate, protesting in vigorous terms against any arbitrating of the Behring sea question.

The rumor states that the attitude of the story, at present, is the effect that when it is said Alaska and the Behring sea possessions to the United States it is a proposition which is viewed with suspicion, and that any movement on the part of the United States to arbitrate must necessarily serve to cast a shadow on the good faith and the validity of Russia's original title to the possession of the Behring sea.

The case particularly reveals, says the story, the attitude of the Russian cabinet, and above all, Great Britain, to put his government in the unfavorable attitude of having to stand as a friend of the United States, territory and waters which his government has no right to claim, and to whom whose territory it could not guarantee.

Our Relations with Italy.

WASHINGTON, March 17.—Indications are that a resumption of the diplomatic relations between the United States and Italy, which were interrupted by the withdrawal of Baron Fava from Washington, at the time of the massacre of Italian at New Orleans, will shortly occur. It is not known that Baron Fava will return to the United States, but it is believed that he will be sent to some other post. The report that Minister Fava had received instructions to return to his post in Rome cannot be confirmed as the state department is not in a position to make any statement in fact it is rather denied them, but the details are assumed in some circles to be purely diplomatic.

The question remaining to be settled before the embassy cordials between the two nations is completely restored, that of damages to the families of the victims of the New Orleans outbreak. It has been suggested that an appropriation to enable the state department to make a payment on this behalf be inserted in the congressional bill for the relief of the Italian victims.
