Wigilant Health Officials Bar Dread Cholera's Progress.

NEW CASES IN NEW YORK CITY

New York, Sept. 3.—The black plagues of cholera hanging over the waters of New York Bay appears to be lifting. Another day seems to be yielding to the efforts of the health officials in the harbor to keep the scourge out of the city. Death did not claim a victim among the unfortunate on the shipwrecked schooner at the lower end of the harbor. Neither was there a death among the patients in the hospitals on Swinburne Island. The sunlight of hope which on Wednesday was fairly seen to break through the clouds of sorrow now seems to have fairly broken its way through.
