Gunboats and Soldiers Menace the Sinks at Hull.

THE STONE MEANT FOR BALFOUR.

LONDON, April 10.—The steamship Melville has been put out from the Hull docks and anchored in the Roads, so as to be able to take their crews at a safe distance from the shore. The crews of the Melville, armed with rifles, formed on both sides of the crews about two hours later and refused them to the teachers. Minister and Embassadors. The reading of Ministers' Preamble of England and Patente of France to the full rank of embassadors by their respective governments is significant of the growing conservatism felt for the government by the nations of Europe. It is likely that Germany, Italy, Austria, Russia and Spain will follow suit. The reading of the preamble at Washington to the rank of embassadors. In the etiquette of the diplomatic service there are three general classes of accredited agents to a foreign country—Minister, Minister Plenipotentiary, and the charge d'affaires. The Minister is the highest, representing not only the government but absolutely the person of his sovereign at a foreign capital.

It is a fact that hitherto the governments of Europe, while they sent embassadors to the other's capitals, sent only Minister Plenipotentiary to the United States. One chief diplomatic representative in Europe therefore took the rank of minister also and fell into the second class of diplomatic agents. The Minister Plenipotentiary to the United States, however, has the honor of being the first American diplomat of the highest rank.

Biennial Legislative Sessions. In Massachusetts old time tradition adheres to this day to the annual election of both governor and members of the legislature. The legislature of this state meets every two years. The legislature of the state differs according to their own sweet fancy in this matter. A majority hold elections for both governor and legislature biennially with annual sessions of the latter body. Probably common opinion favors this system.

In the New England Magazine Mr. Raymond writes in the latest issue of his magazine of a government, but also the legislature every year. Truth compels an unreserved observation to say that his reasons for the annual legislative sessions are stronger than those for the annual elections. One point which he mentions is that the rural inhabitants would be satisfied with a meeting of the legislature every two years. They are quietly and simply. It is the cities that require annual sessions. New needs constantly arise. The cities are growing, and the needs of the cities are becoming more complex. To mention only one or two instances, whenever a discovery like the telephone or the electric light and electric transit is put to general use, a multitude of laws must be made to fit the new needs. It is the same old story. The law of development requires that the old should be wiped out, the new made place for. Then, too, in our new countries the mistakes of law makers are something prodigious. As a witness to this, the mistakes of doctors are hidden underground; those of the lawyers and lawmakers bodies are in the air. When a legislature has made a bad break, it must come together as quickly as possible and mend the break.

There is another reason Mr. Raymond might have brought forward, but he does not, in favor of annual sessions. In this country every man is a sovereign, and all citizens ought to be kept in touch with the times and governing laws as well as with the governing body and laws. This can be accomplished by no means so well as by annual legislative sessions.

NEW RACE OF WOMEN.

THE CHANGE THAT HAS COME OVER SOCIAL CONDITIONS.

How Modern Education and Enterprise Have Altered the Relative Position of the Sexes in the Matter of Finances.

It was a famous saying of Lord Brougham—though attributed by him to some body else unknown—that it was the whole of king, lords and commons, and not the whole machinery of the state, to bring 12 good men together in a jury box. In a similar way it was once said by an experienced American lawyer that the most important result of all the great recent changes in the position of women in our laws, new reforms, new professions—would be found in the creation of a race of business women. It is inevitable that this result must in some degree follow. A race of women brought up to read, write and cipher, to handle books and accounts, to follow steady constitutional law and political economy, to sit on court committees and charity boards, to manage their own money, to practice law and medicine and make their own wills, cannot possibly remain in that state of passivity which was once the only natural condition of their sex. The fact is that in the past few years, the position of women in our society has changed so much that it is not possible to find a trace of the old condition in all these things in person, or indeed any of them; the most secluded woman still feels the effect of the general change as the disturbance of the central waters of a lake finds its way at last, though far off, to the remotest islands. The social alteration is in the air, in the newspapers, in the whole of the life of the people. The philanthropist in a city of 100,000 inhabitants once called my attention to the fact that the number of women who were devoted to the great religious work of the last few years had increased so much that the leading charitable associations of that city had more than their officers who were now chiefly carried on by women, even the office of treasurer being now in female hands.

And certainly the change has come none too soon. It is painful to think how large a part of the impoverishment of women once comfortably established has come not from any conceivable domestic cause, but from the fact that they have been so much more than their husbands. Brothers, husbands, grandfathers, fathers have often been the very source and origin of their woes. Treated with too implicit confidence, able to receive the sting of any conceivable domestic pressure or oppression without complaint, they have been exposed to temptation too great to resist in those of financial pressure and of promising speculation. With the best intentions in the world they have been treated as trust money as if it were their own. All that was left, the object of their trust might be lost, and the woman left with nothing. Cases have been known where the loss of the husband's character, philanthropist of the highest class, and whose name alone has been found at death never to have made any distinction whatever between trust funds and their own estate, so that it was with the greatest difficulty that the trust funds have been replaced by the executor, who the trustee has been left with no pension. The more prosperous such people are, the greater this danger. The inevitable, the wife must know.
