This Evening.
New York, May 2d, (Special.)—At 10 o'clock this morning the official thermometer registered 75 deg. At the same hour on last Sunday it registered only 71 deg.
May 2 in last year did not compare

The warmest May 23 was in 1886, 85 deg. was registered.

The thermometer was at the freezing point at North Platte and Dodd City, Kan. The heat-wave at present with us will practically remain till the end of August. It is the first real sign of Summer. The official temperature at 11:20 o'clock this morning was 81 deg., and at noon it was 84 deg.
