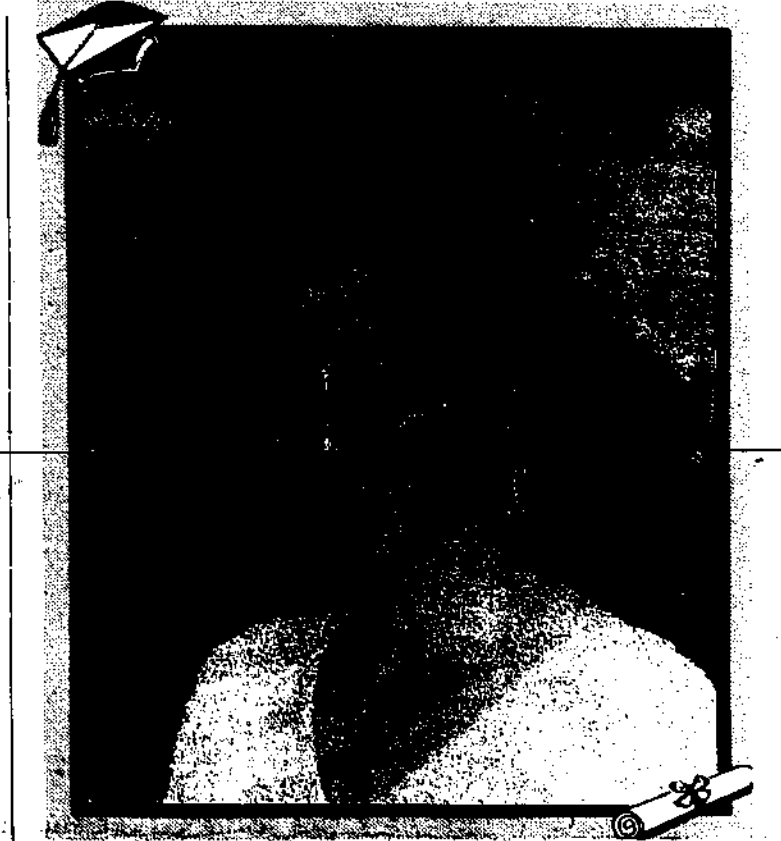

Fritz Sales chalked up a 5-4 victory over Country Squire behind the pitching of Craig Halleck who struck out eight batters.

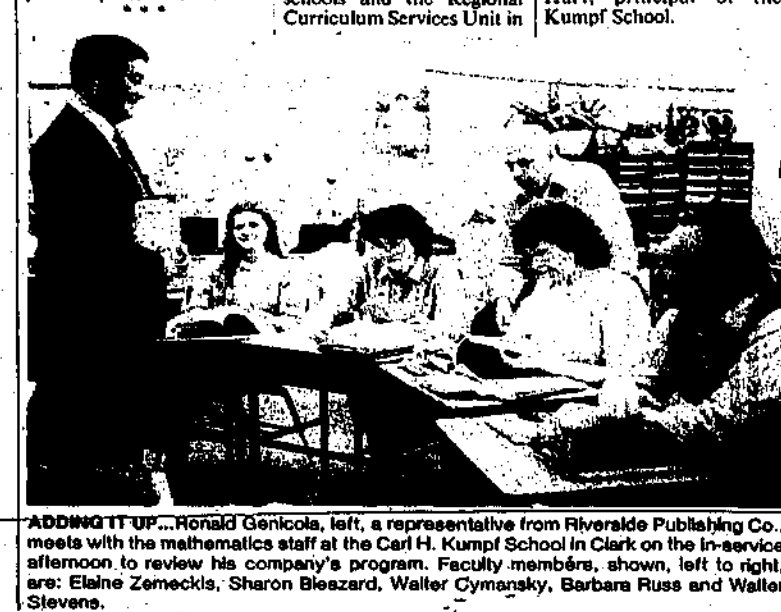
George Visconti pitched an excellent game in defeat for Country Squire, and Art Williams blasted a triple, his third of the year.
