WHAT A CENSUS SHOWS

Every ten years the government of the United States counts and estimates the people of this country and then makes up various census reports which are published just about the time that it is time to take the next census.

The people generally care nothing, and know less, about the condition of the country as shown by the census than the people do not read the reports it is perfectly safe to go making them.

It costs the people about ten million dollars to take the census. In European countries like England, France and Germany, it costs nothing and is done in one night.

Yet all these years the government reports were denying every report of the census and showing that intelligent men who would take the trouble to read, that in 1900 the agricultural wealth produced in that country was only \$391 per worker.

If all the eighteen billion dollars of wealth produced in the United States in 1900 had been evenly divided there would not have been one family in this country well enough off to afford a piano.

So in 1900 this country instead of bursting with wealth and prosperity actually produced but enough to support properly clothed and fed its inhabitants even if a strictly per capita division had been made.

That making a living was a difficult proposition in 1900 is indicated by the fact that out of all those who worked, more than one-sixth were women and girls.

You get another glimpse as to how things stand when you compare the figures of average wages and average product per capita as determined by two censuses five years ago.

Though average wages seem to have doubled, they have actually fallen in purchasing power. The average worker produces four times as much as the average worker fifty years ago, but instead of getting four times as much for his labor he gets only twice as much in money as the worker in 1850.
