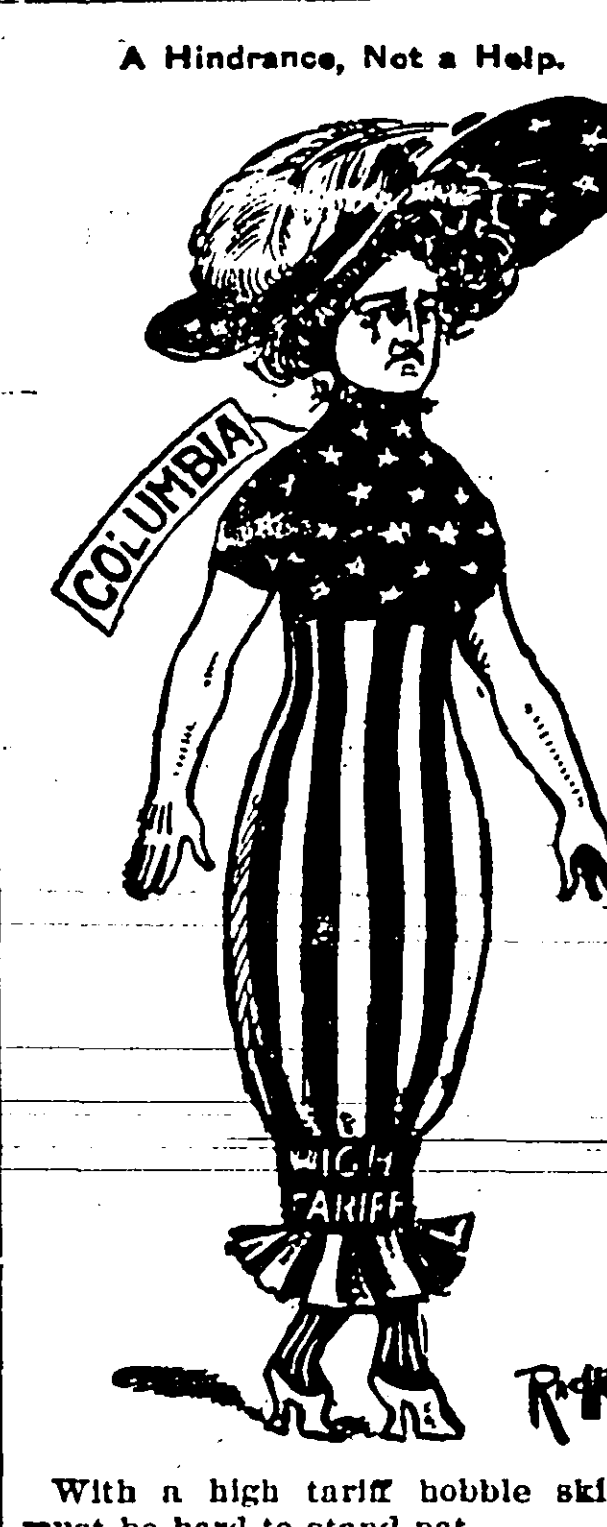

TAX ON CLOTHING

Costs the Average Man Twenty-six Dollars a Year

HOW THE TARIFF PINCHES

Striking Illustrations of the Effect of High Protective Duties on the Cost of Living—Manufacturer, Not the Government, Gathers the Profit.

How much does the tariff cost a man on his clothing in the course of a year? The tariff committee on wages and prices of commodities has in its report compiled a table which shows approximately that a man earning \$1,000 a year might be expected to pay for a year's clothing, etc., about \$20.22 of which no less than \$20.22 would go to tariff taxation.

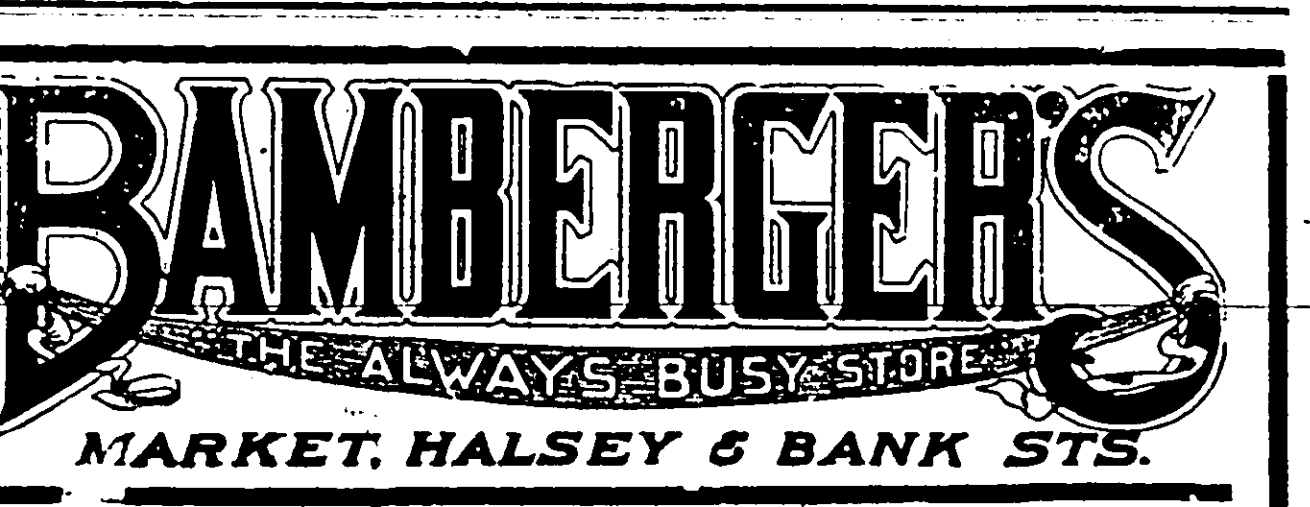
