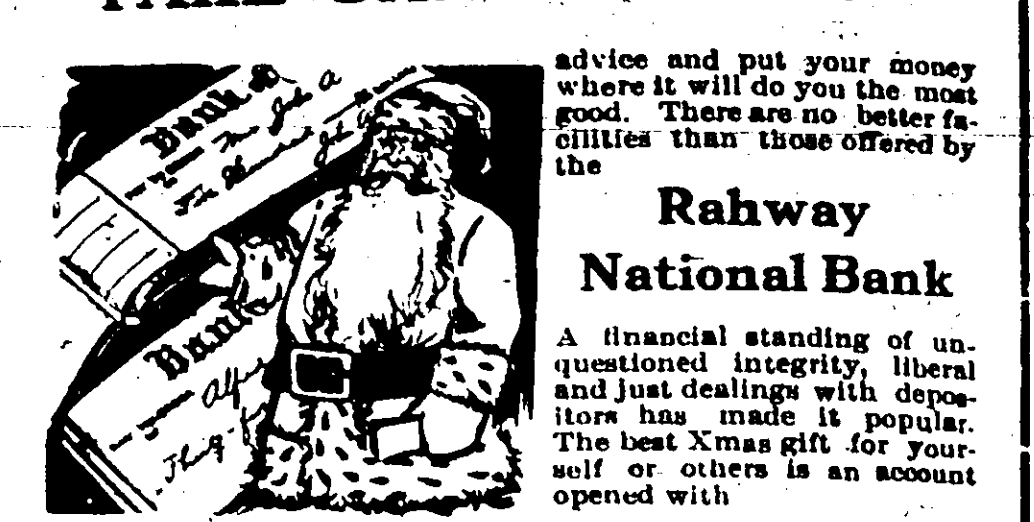
A Touch of Family Life. When the country youth proposed to the city girl he revolved the conventional assurance that she would be his sister.
