

When, if ever, before did a member of Common Council argue publicly in favor of retaining the services of an official of the opposite political faith because of efficiency rather than to appoint a politician named by the boss, as at the organization of the new Council on New Year's day? When, if ever, did a member of Council stand forth and plead for the retention of the Council on the same basis as one would operate a private business? Does it occur to the readers of the News-Herald that the plea set forth in Council chambers on New Year's day was almost word for word the plea that the News-Herald has been making from its very first number? Does it occur to our readers that if the same plea had prevailed last year the Water Board would have been composed of the members of the present Council, who have made an enviable record. The record Mr. Kirtland has been able to make has resulted partially from the good condition in which he found the office when he took charge, which was very largely the work of his predecessor. The News-Herald urges the retention of Mr. Kirtland on the ground that faithful public service should be rewarded the same as faithful service for a private business, and while we were unsuccessful at that time in our plea to the Board, we feel gratified that the public opinion has been awakened sufficiently to bring about the condition which now prevails and we shall hope to see the day when control of public office, and by the control of public business, shall be placed upon the same plane as the control and operation of private business. The News-Herald is working for there are now several men prominent in the public life of Rahway who have either committed themselves in their public acts or who have worked privately to secure the disavowal of politics from the operation of our municipal affairs. Such men should receive the support of every right minded citizen and especially when to take such action required that they should leave the request of the bosses who have been instrumental in securing their election.

That the day of the boss is rapidly passing no one can doubt who makes the least pretense to keeping informed upon the questions of the day, and the News-Herald takes no little pride in the fact that the citizens at large are giving this old paper the support it is entitled to in the changed sentiment which now prevails. When all of our appointive and elective officials shall have secured their positions because of their ability and willingness to give value received for their salaries rather than their ability to control votes by buying or other processes not less reprehensible, shall have made a step in advance that will mark Rahway as a city of progress.

The News-Herald is in receipt of a communication from a musical enthusiast complaining of the lack of interest in things musical among the Rahway people generally and of the antiquated type of instruments in most of the churches. He urges that organs should be installed by those churches of wealth who could thus establish a permanent memorial to some member of the family who has passed away. The News-Herald is unable to publish the entire communication because of its length, but can heartily endorse the idea of memorial organs rather than shafts of granite to express one's love for the departed. Money invested in musical instruments is tied up for all time, to be of no use to the donor or the one in whose memory it is erected. Money invested in memorial organs, children's playgrounds, or Y. M. C. A. endowments is permanently beneficial to the community and keeps alive a grateful remembrance of the giver as well as the one in whose memory the investment is made. The millions upon millions of dollars invested in shafts of granite would wipe out all the poverty of the world today. Memorial hospitals and model tenements are much to be preferred to memorial granite.

There are fourteen bills before Congress calling in one form or another for a parcel post. This subject has been before Congress for a number of years, but opposition from various sources has smothered it. The parcel post rate is 12 cents a pound, the limit of weight being four pounds, but by international agreement the rate for such mail destined for foreign destinations is only 10 cents a pound. Twenty-nine foreign countries enjoy this reduced rate and, besides this rate, if you are sending parcels abroad, you are not confined to a four-pound limit but may go as high as twenty-four pounds. Nearly all foreign countries have parcel post, with reduced rates and reduced weight of articles to be sent, and the people of our country, especially the rural population, are asking for such laws.
