In the first place, equal suffrage came to Colorado in peace and perfect amity. The pioneers, by virtue of that freedom from conservatism won by life in the open, gave the ballot because they deemed it their duty and woman's right. As far back as 1870, Cerritorial Governor Edward McCook bodied these words in a message t legislature: "Our higher civiliztion has recognized woman's equality with man in all respects save one-equal suffrage. It has been said hat no great reform has ever been made without passing through three tages---ridicule, argument and adopon. It rests with you to say whether Colorado will accept this reform in its first stage, as our sister territory of yoming has done, or in the last; whether she will be a leader in the novement or a follower; for the logic of a progressive civilization leads to the inevitable result of an equal suf-
