"Wherever Roosevelt addressed an audience of 10,000, mostly men of foreign birth, in Chicago on Washington's birthday, The Chicago Record would say:

"In his address at this meeting which was designed primarily as a word of counsel for the foreign-born citizens of Chicago, the former President took occasion incidentally to announce himself as an advocate of woman suffrage."

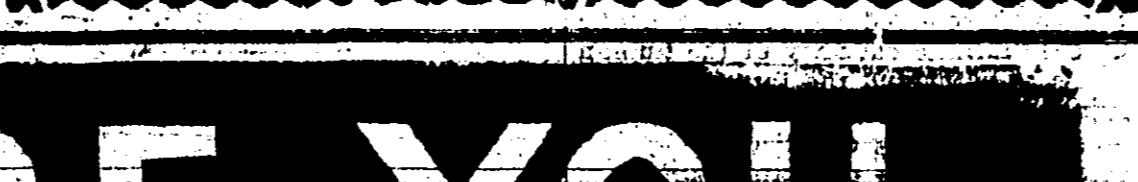
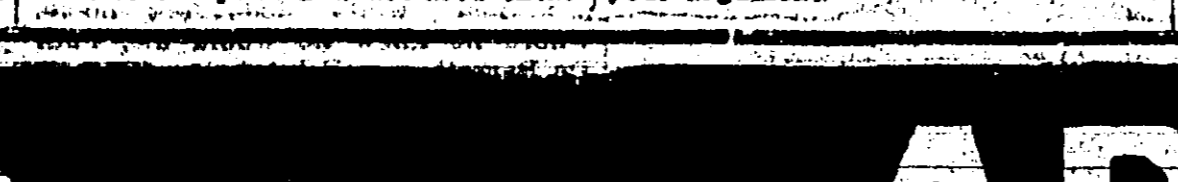
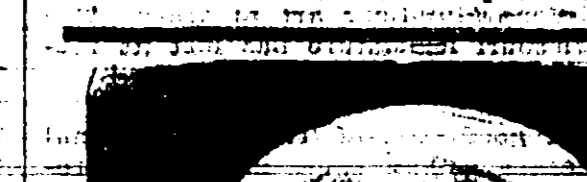
