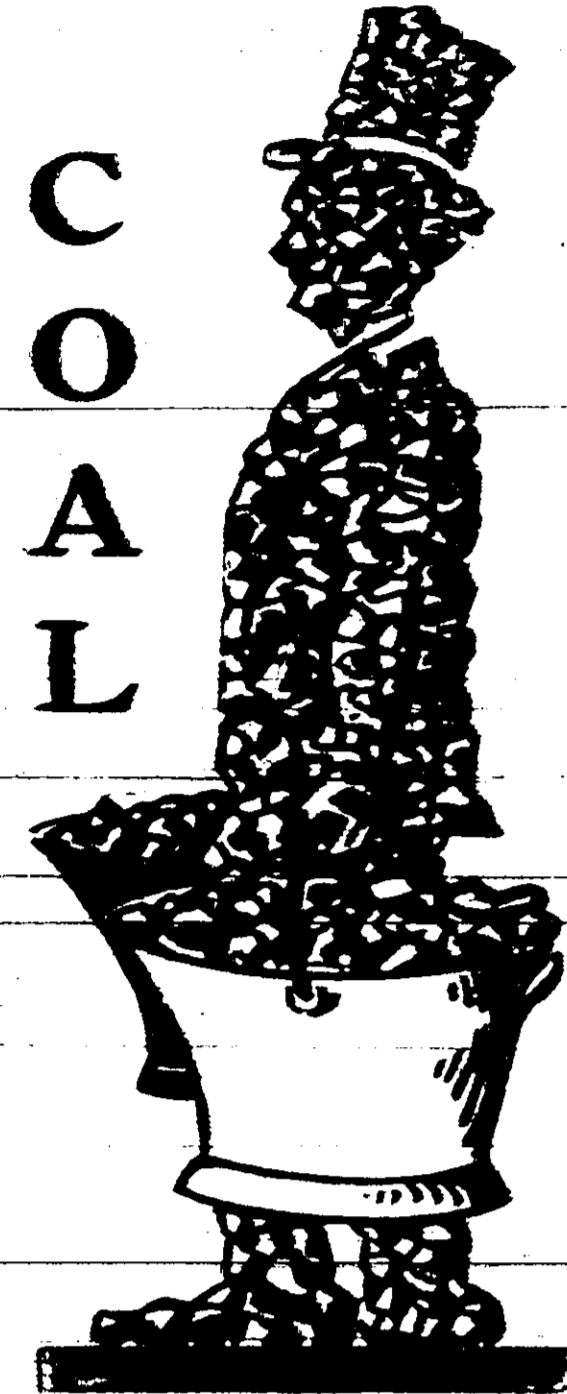

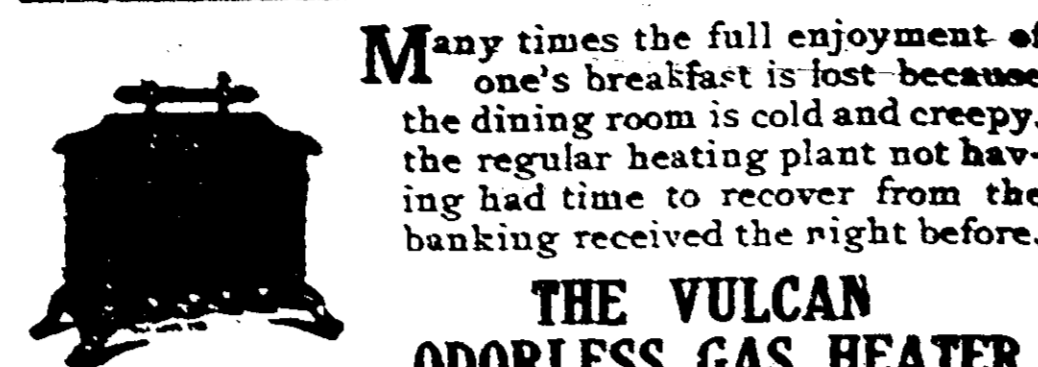

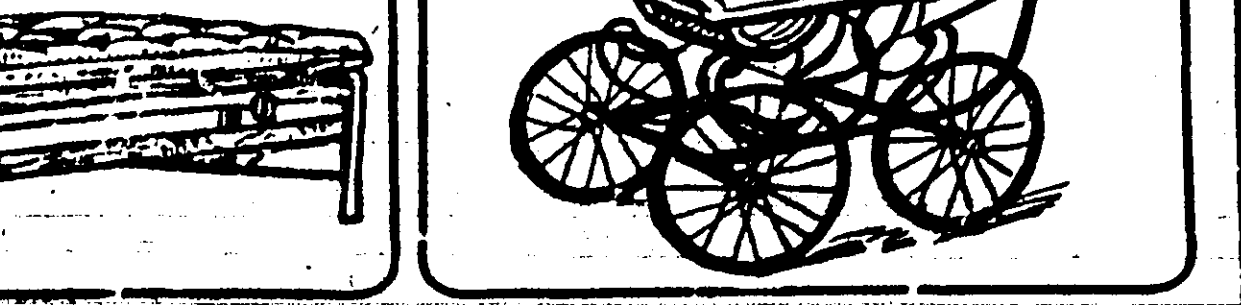

RAHWAY WATER SAFEST IN STATE

(Continued From First Page.) that which you are treating. River of all preventable pollution is out there still remains the considerable surface washing, tending to pollute the water. At this season, with the ground frozen, the first warm rains carry into the stream the accumulated debris of the winter.

Despite the unsatisfactory condition of the river water, the work of the filters has been of uniform excellence. Not a single positive coliform has been recorded, although definite the fact that on twenty-two days all five tests of the river water were positive, and on five other days four out of five.

The average removal of bacteria has been from 5,479 to 12 or 95.75 per cent. The highest number of bacteria found on any single day was 27. The removal of it. coli, the index of pollution has been 100 per cent.

I have no hesitation in stating that there is not a safer water in the state and this is a condition of affairs which is amply reflected in the health of the community. mittee has been actively engaged in procuring information in connection with the installation of a new pump. It was deemed advisable to secure the services of an expert engineer; accordingly arrangements were made with Prof. J. E. Deaton, of Stevens Institute. Two of your committee, in connection with our Superintendent and Engineer, spent a number of hours with Prof. Deaton at the pumping station, and later he spent several days making tests. Unfortunately, Prof. Deaton's health gave out, and he was unable to complete the work.

Upon his recommendation we have employed Mr. Charles R. Hague, a consulting engineer. He has met with your committee at the pumping station and has also made a careful study of the situation at our works, and as one of Prof. Deaton's and his own tests, has presented the accompanying report. The report submitted by the consulting engineer, relating to two styles of pumps, one costing more than the other, but with possibly for giving better satisfaction and having considerably greater capacity. The better type of pump was recommended by the engineer as being more suitable for Rahway's requirements, and after discussing the matter it was the opinion of the water board that it would be the wisest plan to adopt the recommendation, provided there was sufficient funds available to warrant the investment. It was argued that the pump would pay for itself in a comparatively short time. The matter was referred finally to the finance committee.

In a communication the Twin State Realty Company and Rahway Garage, asked for an extension of the water mains on their premises. A representative of the company was present and attended the board the one house was already in course of construction, and that others were contemplated. A 400 foot extension was required. The representative of the company was willing to share the expense of laying the water pipe, and the Board agreed that the company had already expended about \$500 in digging and filling in trenches for a previous extension, from which the city would get the revenue, and that he felt the water board should consider that expenditure and the benefit to be derived. That the company did not feel that it ought to be made to pay for the improvement now asked for. The matter was referred to the committee on Extension, with power. In a communication J. M.
