(From Boston J. Hendrick's article in the very latest issue of the National Initiative and Referendum and How Oregon Got Them.)

The movement was a popular one in every sense of the word. In the view of present-day discussions of the success of women for public affairs, it is interesting to note that, in accomplishing this the most revolutionary reform—a social document that has been a landmark in the history of the century, women played a conspicuous part. As a result the State capitol will be turned over August 22 to a commission of five members, headed by the Mayor, in whom will be merged the powers and duties of all the present municipal boards except the Board of Education. The new rulers of the city will be subject to recall if they fail to satisfy the electors, and the citizens will obtain direct participation in their own government through the power of initiating action on any subject, a referendum with respect to laws, and a recall which they may exercise at will.

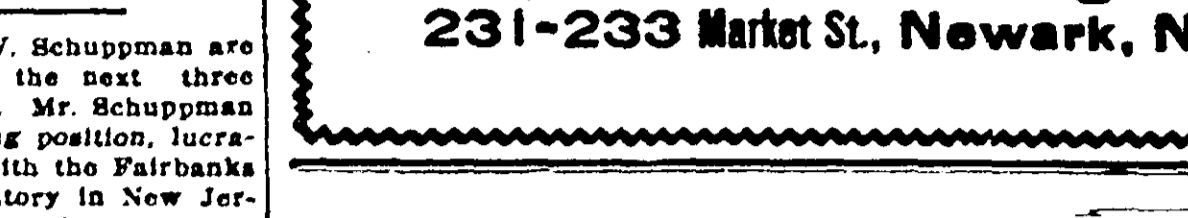

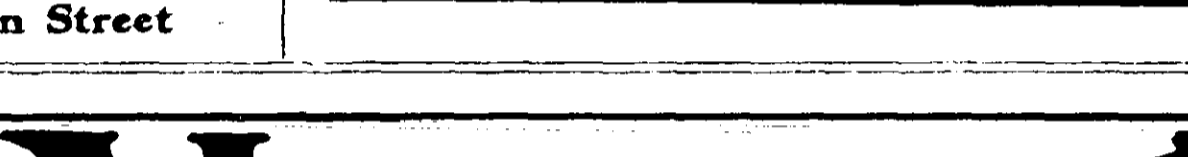

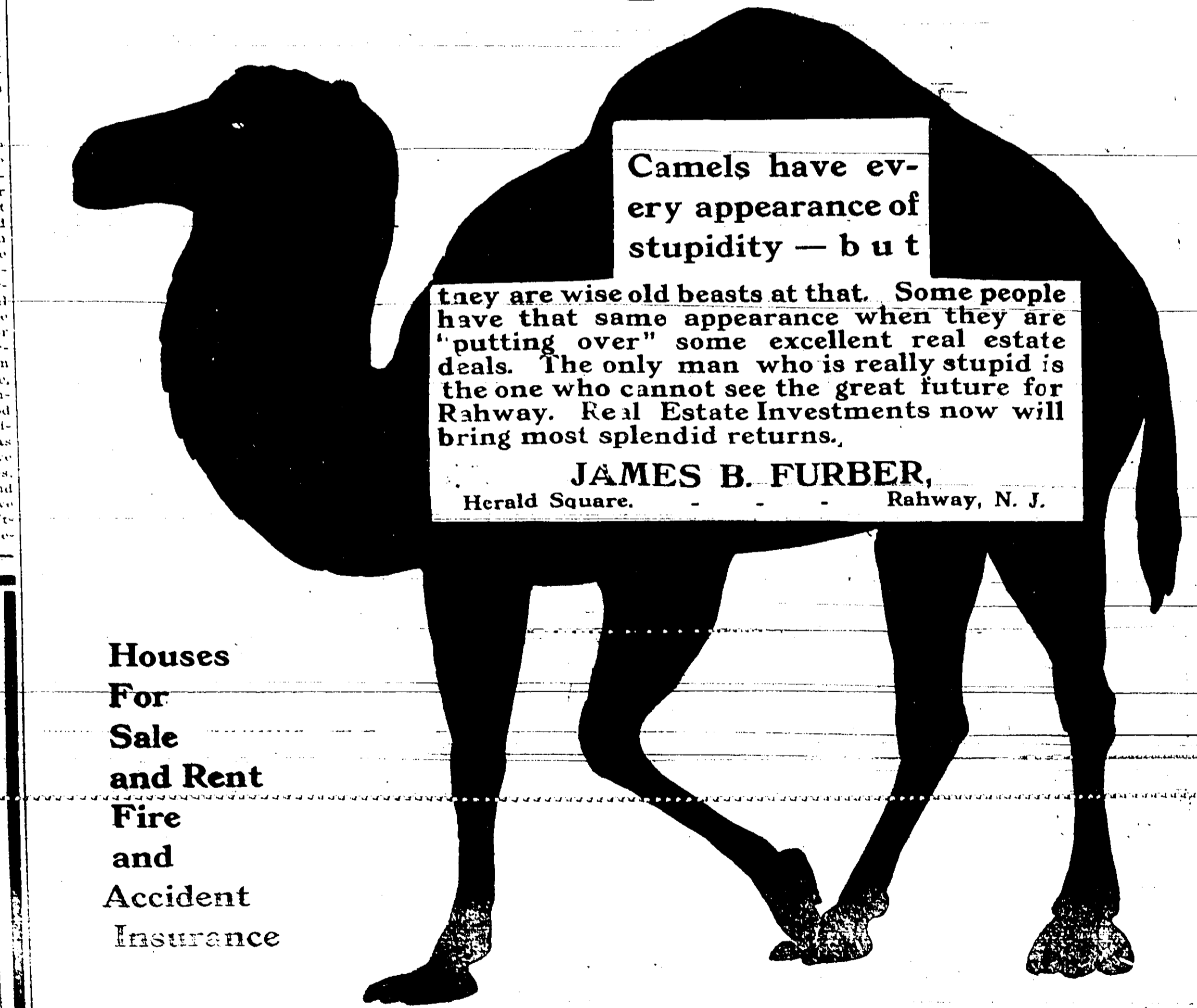
