UPPER RAHWAY NEWS One of the most beautiful sections in Upper Rahway, today, is that at Union and Whittier streets, since the macadamizing of the two thoroughfares, and along which the sidewalks are being laid, curbing straightened, gutters being cleaned, gutters put in shape, residences painted, old shade being torn down, sticks burned up, rocks covered up in the ground, trees trimmed and gates rehung. The original thoroughfares, called Whittier street, in that section still has an unique and interesting history attached to its former days.
