TEN REASONS Why You Should Vote For Commission Government

- 1-Because it is in force in over 175 cities in the United States, and in every case the people of those cities are getting better results than under the old form of government. 2-Because you elect those who manage the affairs of your city at large, and they represent all citizens, instead of only a ward. 3-Because those you elect are given power and authority to accomplish results, which is not now the case. 4-Because city government is properly divided, with a responsible head to each branch, and citizens know to whom to look for results. 5-Because the Commissioners you elect have power to appoint all necessary officers and employees, and to get efficient and economical results. 6-Because it replaces an obsolete method of handling city affairs with a modern, and puts it up to the voters to elect good Commissioners. 7-Because franchises and bond issues cannot be issued to the people's detriment without the people's approval. 8-Because with the recall, any Commissioner who is not serving you properly can be removed. 9-Because city improvement will be intelligently planned with a system for the whole city, and not merely for wards. 10-Because no change is made affecting the rights of citizens—you elect your own Commissioners, only they have power and authority which is now sub-divided.

A DIGEST of chapter 221 of the laws of 1911, relating to, regulating and providing for the government of cities, approved April 25, 1911, and generally known as the Commission Government Bill, as it affects the city of Rahway.

Under this Act, the City of Rahway can adopt an entirely new system of government. Procedure Necessary. Twenty per cent of the legal voters, voting at the last general election must sign a petition or request for a special election to adopt the provisions of this Act.

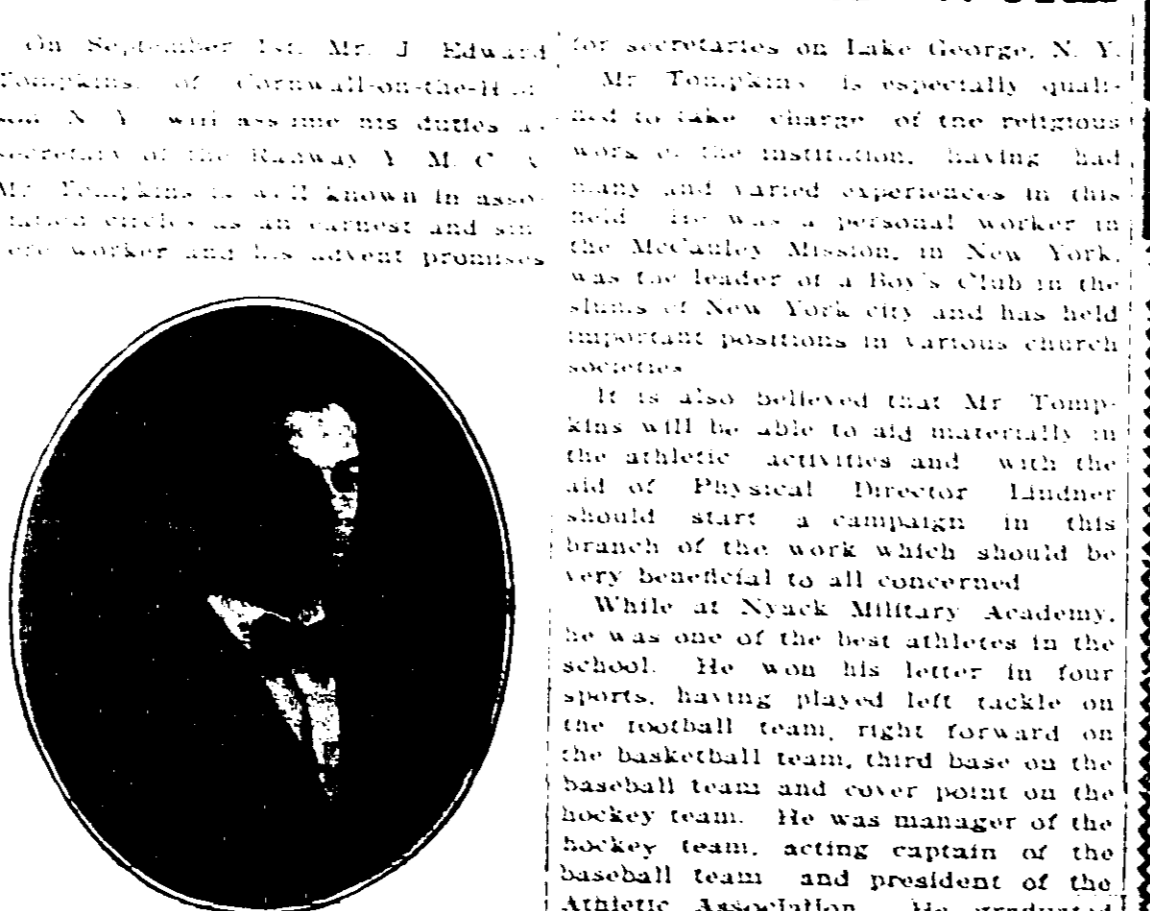
